They just require less commitment. Competition students are only excused from 3 classes per semester since we need an equal level of dedication from each member of the team. *

Solo, duet, trio choreography is available for competition students and high school seniors for \$50.00 a month September through May for a total of \$450.00 a year which would be divided between the members of a duet or trio. Private lessons can be scheduled for any students if they fall behind on choreography if time is available. Private lessons are \$30.00 for 30 minutes.
