Application process

Step 1: An applicant form may be obtained at a general meeting, CDADF website, or from a member in good standing. The first reading of a completed application, which includes 2 sponsors and a payment in the amount of first year's dues, will take place at the next general meeting.

Step 2: All applicants must meet with a member of the Membership committee prior to the application vote. This can be done in person, virtually by video teleconference or by hybrid formats as may be designated by Membership chair.

Step 3: After the second reading of the application and two events have been completed, a vote will take place at next month's General meeting by the membership in attendance.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will encourage high standards of sportsmanship by my behavior, and I will not engage in malicious or intentionally misleading or exaggerated statements about other breeders, their dogs, or their breeding practices.
- I will help educate the public in the accepted standards of care and breeding practices.
- I will maintain high standards in the care of my dogs.
- I will not sell any dog without true and full representation, nor intentionally use misleading or untruthful statements in selling or advertising.
- I will not breed dogs for the purpose of donating or selling to commercial dog wholesalers or pet shops.
- I understand that indiscriminate breeding may lead to overpopulation and contribute materially to the deterioration of my breed.
