AKC Ring Stewards 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

4-6 Month Puppy vs. Regular Conformation

- There is only one class for each breed/variety and it includes male and female dogs.
- There are no 1st through 4th placements for breeds, only Best of Breed/Variety and Best of Opposite Sex.
- Each Group is judged immediately after all the breeds in that Group have been judged.
- Ring Stewards must enter winners not only in the Ring Steward's Book but also in the Judge's Group Book and the Judge's Best Puppy in Show Book.

Ring Steward Duties

- Distribute armbands to exhibitors.
- Check off picked-up armbands in the Steward's Book.
- Call dogs into the ring.
- Let the Judge know if there are any absent dogs.
- Pull ribbons needed for the dogs in the ring.
- Write the armband #s for Best of Breed/Variety and Best of Opposite Sex in the Steward's Book in the appropriate spaces.
- Write the armband number of the Best of Breed/Variety winner for each breed in the *Judge's Group Book*.
- Write the breed and armband # of the 1st place winner for each Group in the Judge's Best in Show Book.
- If a dog makes a mess in the ring, provide cleaning supplies to the exhibitor. (The exhibitor should clean up the mess but the steward can help by holding the dog's leash.)
- Set up, or have someone set up, the table or ramp when needed.

4-6 Month Puppy Ribbons

Breed/Variety

- Best of Breed Orange
- Best of Opposite Sex Lavender

Groups

- Group 1 Rose
- Group 2 Brown
- Group 3 Light Green
- Group 4 Gray

Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show

• Pink & Green

There is also often a toy or treat for each puppy entered.

Breed Judging

Note: Dogs and bitches are judged together in one class for each breed.

- Hand out armbands and mark the Steward's Book as usual.
- Call the breed/variety into the ring for judging.
- Pull Best of Breed/Variety and Best of Opposite Sex ribbons.
- Write the armband # for Best of Breed/Variety and Best of Opposite Sex winners in the appropriate spaces in the Steward's Book.
- Write the armband # for Best of Breed/Variety winner in the Judge's Group Book on the line for that breed/variety.
- Make sure each puppy gets the toy/treat provided.

Group Judging

Note: Each Group is judged as soon as judging for all the breeds in that Group is completed.

- Call the dogs into the ring.
- Pull 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place Group ribbons.
- Write the breed and armband # for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place in the appropriate spaces in the Steward's Book.
- Make sure the winners get any appropriate prizes.
- Write the breed/variety and armband # of the 1st place winner in the Judge's Best Puppy in Show Book.

NOTE: Do NOT abbreviate breed/variety names when you write them in the Judge's books.

Best 4-6 Month Puppy In Show

- Call the 1st place winners from each Group into the ring.
- Pull the Best Puppy in Show ribbon.
- Write the breed/variety and armband # for Best Puppy In Show in the appropriate space in the Steward's Book.
- Make sure the Best Puppy In Show gets the appropriate prize.
