S.W.A.T. Takes Proactive Response to Fentanyl

On February 7, 2019 more than 30 members of local Special Operations Teams attended training focused on preventing exposure to fentanyl.

These men are specially trained for high risk entries but now have another risk to contend with, Fentanyl. Amounts of fentanyl as small as a few grains of salt can be lethal. Unintentional contact is not their only concern.



Weaponized Fentanyl and Criminal Destruction

These heroes aren't the only ones who know fentanyl is lethal. A legitimate concern is fentanyl being used as a weapon against them! A suspect could intentionally throw the fentanyl at the team or attempt to destroy evidence, causing catastrophic exposure and cross contamination. Now they have a deterrent to prevent the incident called the BLOC™ Encapsulation Device.



BLOC™ Encapsulation Device

Team members were introduced to the BLOC™ Encapsulation Device, a handheld containment unit which can be deployed in seconds and is immediately effective in preventing inhalation of fentanyl. Once deployed the team members can safely complete their necessary tasks. They were relieved to hear BLOC does not preclude laboratory or field testing of suspicious powders.
