## <u>CREATING BETTER IMAGES OF YOUR ORCHIDS</u> <u>BY TOM KULIGOWKI</u>

Ever wish you could take better photos of your orchids to share with friends? Join us August 9, 2023 for a special treat. Professional photographer Tom Kuligowski will show us how to do it. He has been an official photographer for American Orchid Society and takes many of the awarded AOS orchids you'll see in Orchids Magazine. We are using his photo of Phal bellina for this year's Show Poster.

Tom was bitten by the "Orchid Bug" 23 years ago while photographing a neighbor's orchids, documenting the progression of growth through the blooms on the mature plants. He soon started his own orchid collection, incorporating his artistic abilities with various mediums, combining his photographic skills to create beautiful photographs of his orchids.

"You don't necessarily need a wealth of knowledge to capture images of your orchids. Many of today's cameras can do the thinking for you." With this in mind, Tom teaches orchid hobbyists how to take better pictures of their own orchids. Whether you use a smartphone, pointand-shoot camera, or digital single lens reflex camera, everyone can

#### AUGUST GROWING FROM DR MOTES

#### **PROGRESS OF THE SEASON Rain, Rain and More Rain**

July and August are the two most similar months in South Florida. Most of the advice on watering, disease and pest control in last month's calendar still apply but subtle changes are taking place. Although it may not seem so, as temperatures climb into the low nineties most afternoons, summer is in retreat: each day a little shorter, each night a little longer.

With shorter days the importance of watering as early in the morning as possible comes to the fore. With less hours of sunlight to dry the plants, extra care should be taken in choosing when to water. **Back to the basics of the classic saying If a Vanda looks like it needs water, water it; If a Cattleya or Oncidium looks like it needs water, water it tomorrow. If a Paph or a** 

**Phal looks like it needs water, you should have watered it yesterday.** If plants retain water even from an early morning watering, allowing them to dry a bit harder before the next watering is always a good idea. An extra day of drying rarely does harm.

August should provide numerous opportunities to dry each orchid to its desired level of dryness. Take the opportunity to dry your orchids "hard" at least once but preferably twice in August. This will give your orchids a leg up on their mortal enemies, the fungus, before the drizzle of September switches the advantage to our adversaries. August is definitely not the month to over indulge in water. September, the soggiest of months, is next up. The corollary to this calculated drying is the concept that when watering in August above all water thoroughly. If watering is necessary be sure that the roots and medium are totally saturated with the application. The drizzling rains of September are so detrimental precisely because they keep the foliage of the plants wet unduly long. We want our plants which are still growing to receive plenty of water but also plenty of drying time.
