MILLCREEK TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. FEBRUARY 20, 1980-11

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON, OR PERSONS, FROM LOAFING, LOUNGING, LOITERING, COLLECTING OR CONGREGATING UPON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLCREEK

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisor of the Township of Millcreek, County of Lebanon, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Any person, or persons, who shall loaf, lounge, loiter, collect or congregate upon the foot pavements, or sidewalks, upon the street corners, in any public grounds, at the door or any part of a private residence, store, shop, church or place of public assemblage, factory, or any other premises within the limits of the Township of Millcreek shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.

Section 2. Section 1 of this Ordinance shall not pertain to, nor prohibit, a lawful public meeting, or assemblage of citizens, nor shall it restrict lawful and peaceful picketing so long as one-half (1/2) of the width of the sidewalk is kept clear by the pickets for pedestrian travel.
