


















Guy Manos


Greg Smrz

Norman is quite simply the most famous aerial shooter in the world, best known for freefalling with thirty-six pounds of camera equipment mounted on his helmet. Norm serves as the team's director of photography on the ground, principle helmet- cam flyer in the air and as a design captain during prep.

Mike Smith, originally from Houston, TX, started his multi-sport athletic career early. He grew up a lifelong

practitioner in various martial arts, riding horses and motocross.

Mike became one of Hollywood's hottest stunt doubles making Mel Gibson, Ethan Hawke, Christian Bale, David Duchovny and many other leading men, look damn good. He's been James Bond, Batman and countless heroes driving fast cars, riding wild horses and braving 100ft falls.

Soon after transitioning into the world of stunt coordinating and 2nd unit directing Mike was asked to be a member of one of Hollywood's most prestigious groups, Stunts Unlimited, and has served on the Board for multiple terms. Stunts Unlimited has produced such elite action directors as Hal Needham, David Ellis, and Scott Waugh among others.
