Overview

- This is a general user guide aimed at providing important tips on how to correctly ulletuse Cord Tech Tidy Straps.
- This guide is not intended to be an exhaustive list that caters for every possible • situation, it aims to provide some guidance on topics which would allow for safe use of your product.

1 Important Warnings

Tidy Straps should be treated with care, there is some general and important guidance which you should always follow when using these products.

- Keep away from high temperature objects and surfaces.
- Not for use on moving parts.
- Not for use inside electrical or electronic devices.
- Suspending valuable items is done at your own risk.
- Always thoroughly assess the suitability of the product for your desired environment or application before use.
- Repetitive use will reduce the grip strength of the surfaces, replace when needed.
- Repetitive use will reduce the elasticity of the products, replace when needed.
- If damaged discard and replace.
- Always store in dry locations.

2 Tips

ADHESIVE TAPE:

Some products are supplied with adhesive tape.

- It is important to note this adhesive tape will not stick to ALL surfaces.
- This adhesive tape is not intended to be a permanent adhesive. Over time with the movement of the surface, heating and cooling, as well as other factors the adhesive will begin to lose its grip. A quality product has been provided for the best possible opportunity of adhesion.
- It is recommended that you first clean and thoroughly dry the surface you intend to attach to.
- Use a small test area to confirm adhesion before proceeding.
- Note: removing adhesive tape from surfaces can leave some residue or remove some of the paint or coverings.
- Do Not overload overloading will stress the adhesion and can cause premature failure.



Tips Cont.

GROMMETS:

Some products are supplied with a circular grommet.

- These grommets are useful for suspending from hooks or mounting to surfaces (illustrations below).
- Be careful not to damage the grommet by overloading or over tightening. •
- *If damaged or rusted be mindful about the continued integrity of the grommet damage is* • likely to compromise it's ability to manage forces applied to it.



PERFORATED TAPE:

This reusable tape comes with small perforations every 60mm – tear off the desired length and use for multiple applications.





STRETCH STRAPS:

Several products are made from an elastic material.

- *Excessive force or stretching will compromise the elasticity of the material.*
- Repetitive use will have an impact on the elasticity over time. When needed discard or replace.

3 Maintenance

Caring for your product is important and should be done on a regular basis.

- Metal or stainless-steel parts can rust over time, inspect regularly and discard or replace when needed.
- Keep product surfaces clean and dry for best long-term use.
- Do not use liquids, abrasive chemicals or detergents for cleaning.
- Check regularly for damage, if found discard or replace.
- When not in use always store in a dry location.

Disposal

When your product is no longer used or required it should be disposed of with household waste. We recommend completing this in the most environmentally friendly way. Please recycle where facilities exist in your local area. Check with your council authority for recycling advice.

Recycling of packaging materials reduces the need for landfill. Please recycle packaging where possible. Check with your local council authority for recycling advice.



DISTRIBUTED BY:

Products are protected by warranty for a period of 1 year from date of purchase against manufacturing defects in material and functionality. Should a product fail to perform as described within the warranty period, return to the original place of purchase and provide a copy of the proof of purchase for warranty claim.
