TEAM 2018: TRUE GRIT!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for successfully completing the season. Eastview Wrestling's season motto is: "**True Grit**". Team 2018 committed to several off-season training programs including attending freestyle practices, participating in wrestling training sessions, super group, and attending the Augsburg Team Camp. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the leadership by the seniors and their ability to show "**True Grit**"!

Eastview wrestling shifted their mindset from winning to being **aggressive and relentless!** When being aggressive and giving a full effort becomes more important, winning will occur a whole lot more. Eastview wrestlers are asked to live, train, and compete based on four **Mindset Principles**: 1 - *I am thankful for the opportunity to wrestle.* 2 - *I am aggressive and relentless.* 3 - *I have no fear of losing or making a mistake.* 4 - *I never ever give up.* The senior class and captains did a great job leading by example, promoting a solid work ethic, and promoting the mindset principles. Below are a few highlights of the 2018 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 15 freshman and 5 middle school wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Earned 9 dual meet victories including a 6th place finish at the Region 2 Tournament.
- ◆ Earned 2nd place at the Eastview Duals & Qualified for the 9th Grade State Team Tourney
- ◆ Had 8 wrestlers place at the Region 4 state qualifier tournament.
- ◆ Earned 108 match wins, 589 team points, 67 falls, and 117 takedowns.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 15 dual meet wins and placed near the top in the South Suburban Conference.
- ◆ Placed 1st at the Eastview Duals and 6th at the JV Conference Tournament. (Gold Division)
- ◆ Several individuals were able to participate in varsity tournaments during the season.
- ◆ Earned 156 match wins, 829 team points, 115 falls, and 262 takedowns.
- ◆ Had 10+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.6.
- ◆ Earned 9 hard fought victories placing 1st at the Eastview Duals & 3rd at the Mound-Westonka Invite.
- ◆ Had 2 wrestlers earn All-Conference and 2 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed all 9 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals with 6 placing in the top four.
- ◆ Had 1 State Qualifier and 5 Wrestlers earn Section Academic Recognition.
- ◆ Had 22 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 9 wrestlers earn at least 10 wins.
- ◆ Earned 226 match wins, 1113 team points, 105 falls, and 441 takedowns.

The **Class of 2018** includes 9 wrestlers who lead the team with a single minded focus it takes to be successful in wrestling. The senior class will leave having earned 573 wins, 59 falls, and 573 team points. To each of the seniors, we thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. We wish you the best of luck in your future endeavors and we hope that the Lightning Pride you developed over the past 4 years stays with you forever.

As we begin preparing for next season, the **Senior Class of 2019** must ask themselves - How good do I want our team to be? The leadership the seniors provide over the next 12 months will ultimately determine Team 2019's success! **Being the Best** is a common goal that championship teams work together toward! If teammates are not putting forth consistent effort, we need to pick them up and encourage them to carry on! If teammates are having poor attitudes, we'll be there to pump them up and give our support. **Section 2AAA** is consistently the top achieving section in the state. In order for Eastview to raise the bar and achieve more, each of us must commit to make the need changes. 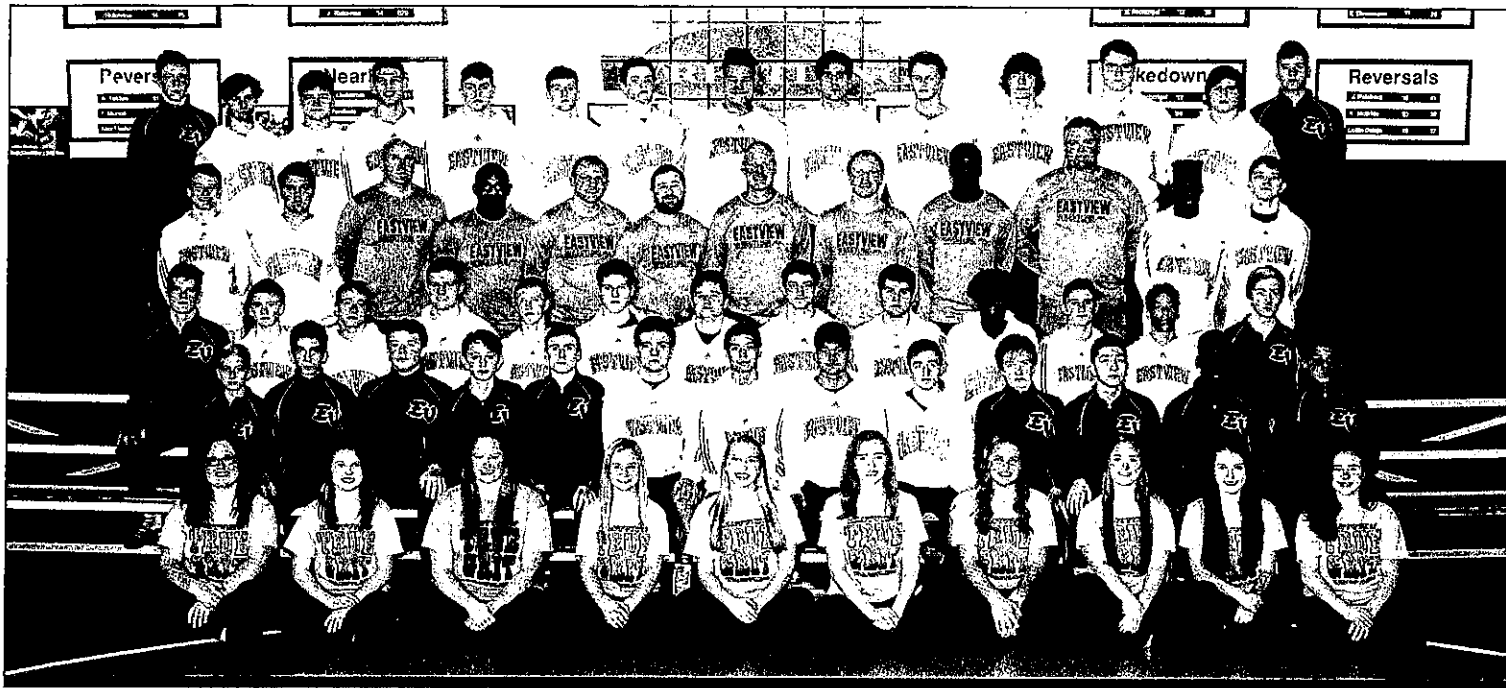

True Grit

2017-2018 Eastview Wrestling



Wrestling requires a determination and self-reliance not found in other sports. It is one-on-one and a true test of toughness and skill. Grueling practices; the running, the weights, the drilling, the cutting weight—all for 6 minutes of intense competition. There is nothing quite like it. *True Grit* is this season's wrestling quote. What does this mean? How does this

apply to wrestling and our athletes?

We asked our Eastview wrestlers, "What does *True Grit* mean to you?"

- "Working hard when nobody is watching."
- "Overcoming obstacles."
- "Learning from losses and working harder than anyone else in the room."
- "Be confident when things don't always go right."

Our young men are on the right track in their thinking of *True Grit*.

David Yukelson, the Ph.D., Coordinator of Sport Psychology Services for Student-Athletes at Penn State University lists seven attributes of Developing Mental Toughness, which is synonymous with TRUE GRIT:

Developing Mental Toughness/TRUE GRIT

1. Starts with the right attitude and state of mind (know what your core confidence is all about).
 - Confidence comes in knowing your are prepared and having an unshakable belief in your abilities to reach intended goals.

2. Program your mind for success ahead of time with positive affirmations and expectations.
 - Expect the best from yourself; affirm what it is you are going to do to be successful.
3. Routinize Your Behaviors: Develop a systematic pre-performance routine that clicks on desired mental-emotional state of mind (practice, pre-game, competition)
 - Practice – commit yourself to giving it everything you have the entire practice. This includes making a commitment to listening, learning, executing skills/drills with precision and full focus).
4. Poise and Composure: Learn how to let go of mistakes quickly if things do not go the way you want.
5. Take Control of Negative Self-Talk: Reframe negative talk into positive task oriented suggestions.
 - Starts with awareness of situations that cause you to get frustrated, rushed, intimidated, lose focus — then reframe the negativity into positive, mentally tough self-suggestions.
6. Look at failure as a stepping stone for future achievement:
 - Champions approach to overcoming adversity: Play to win as opposed to fear making mistakes.
7. Be a difference maker, step up and have a peak performance when it matters the most.

If our athletes develop these seven attributes, and fully buy in to the *True Grit* motto; this season will be a success!

Gable Steveson could complete one of the most dominant chapters in Minnesota wrestling history at this weekend's state high school tournament in St. Paul.

Steveson, Apple Valley's decorated heavyweight, will take a 167-match winning streak into the state tournament, where he is heavily favored to win a second consecutive championship at 285 pounds and a fourth overall (he won state titles at 220 as a freshman and sophomore).

The reigning Junior World champion at 264 pounds, Steveson has rarely been challenged at the high school level the last four years. His last loss was to Justin Cumberbatch of Alexandria in the state Class 3A championship match at 195 pounds in 2014, when Steveson was an eighth-grader.

This year Steveson is 35-0 with all but two of his victories by fall. He takes a 206-3 career record into the state tournament.

Going into this season, 24 high school wrestlers from Minnesota have won at least four state individual championships, including five from Apple Valley.

Steveson is one of eight Apple Valley wrestlers to qualify for the state individual tournament, and they should have additional incentive after the Eagles were unable to reach state as a team for the first time in 35 years. Shakopee defeated Apple Valley 34-30 in the Class 3A, Section 2 team final.

Class 3A individual first-round matches will begin at 11 a.m. Friday at Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul. Competition concludes Saturday with third- and fifth-place matches in all classes at 4 p.m. and championship matches at 6:30.

Other storylines to follow:

- Lakeville South sophomore Willie Bastyr won his way into the state tournament by defeating two-time state champion Alex Lloyd of Shakopee 7-5 in overtime at 152 pounds in the Class 3A, Section 2 finals. The loss was Lloyd's first of the season.

Bastyr (30-5) is ranked fourth in Class 3A at 152 and could meet Lloyd again in the state semifinals if he wins his first two matches. The other half of the 152 bracket has undefeated (45-0) Anoka senior Tyler Eischens.

- Egan coach Chad Gage has five wrestlers in the state individual tournament, two of whom are his sons. Kaden Gage, a senior, won the Class 3A, Section 3 championship at 126 pounds and Ty Gage, a sophomore, was runner-up at 132.
- Farmington junior Trayton Anderson (35-4) is looking to medal at the state tournament for the third consecutive year. He is the Section 1 champion at 126 pounds. He placed second at 113 in the 2017 state tournament and fourth at 106 the year before. Anderson is ranked second in his weight class; the No. 1-ranked wrestler, Patrick McKee of St. Michael-Albertville, also qualified for state.
- Lakeville North junior Bryce Benhart takes a 39-5 record into the state Class 3A tournament at 285 after finishing runner-up to Steveson in Section 2. But wrestling might not be in his future long-term. Benhart, an offensive lineman for the North football team, already has received a number of Division I offers.

If you have a true commitment to excellence you will give up anything that does not help you become better as an athlete or a person. Don't be content with mediocrity- strive to live up to the greatness within you.

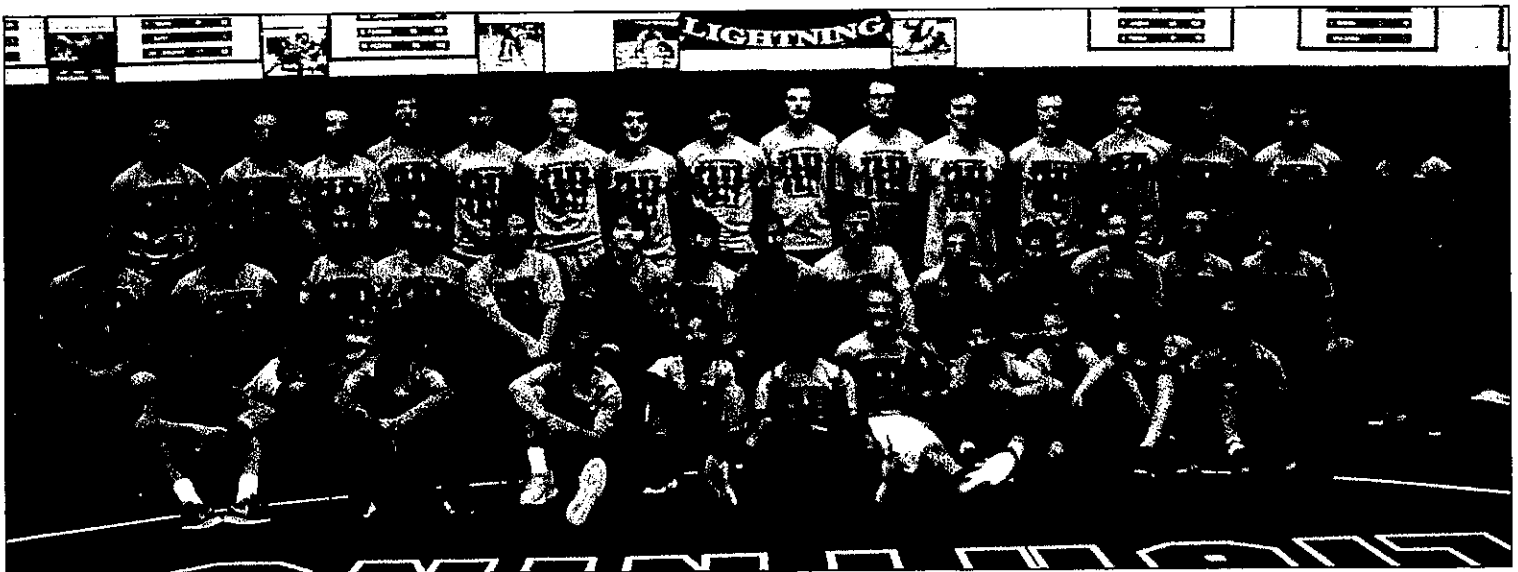

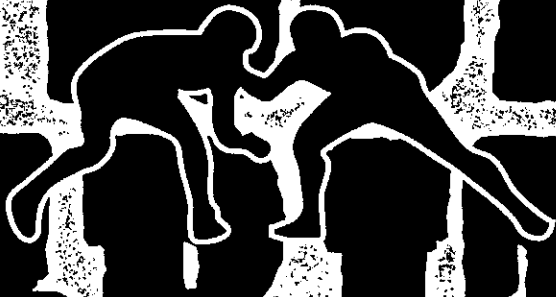
