TEAM 2021: OWN THE MOMENT!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for successfully completing the season. Eastview Wrestling season's motto was: **Own the Moment**. Team 2021 experienced an unbelievable amount of adversity while successfully demonstrating a great amount of flexibility, agility and resilience throughout the season. Maximizing the limited amount of off-season training programs, Team 2021 participated in wrestling training sessions, super group, fall training sessions and pre-season zoom workouts of strength training and wrestling skills & drills. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the leadership by the seniors and the ability to **Own the Moment!**

The Eastview wrestling team worked hard to establish a **Competitive Mindset** and participated in mental skill development throughout the season. Mindset topics included Teamwork, Communication, Confidence, Self-Talk, Focus, and W.I.N. – What's Important Now! These sessions allowed the wrestlers to develop a Predator Mindset and establish a tunnel vision to attack their opponents. Below are a few highlights of the 2021 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 6 freshman and 13 middle school wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Trained and competed at the Junior Varsity and Freshman levels.
- ◆ Had 7 wrestlers compete with varsity and earn a roster spot on the section team.
- ◆ Earned 130 match wins, 696 team points, 98 falls, and 198 takedowns all at the Junior Varsity level.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 24 dual meet wins and placed 2nd in the South Suburban Conference.
- ◆ Trained and competed at the highest level accepting all challenges along the way.
- ◆ Had 10+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.
- ◆ Earned 205 match wins, 1117 team points, 159 falls, and 301 takedowns.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.75.
- ◆ Earned 18 hard fought victories competing at the highest level including 5 conference wins.
- ◆ Had 3 wrestlers earn All-Conference and 7 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed 10 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals with 5 placing in the top four & 12 earn Academic Recognition.
- ◆ Had 5 State Qualifiers with 1 All-State Wrestler competing at the State Championships.
- ◆ Had 25 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 12 wrestlers earn at least 10 wins.
- ◆ Earned 261 match wins, 1386 team points, 146 falls, and 317 takedowns.

The **Class of 2021** includes 7 wrestlers who lead the team with a single-minded focus it takes to be successful in wrestling. The senior class will leave having earned 341 wins, 192 falls, and 1796 team points. To each of the seniors, we thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. We wish you the best of luck in your future endeavors and we hope that the Lightning Pride you developed over the past 4 years stays with you forever.

As we begin preparing for next season, the **Senior Class of 2022** must ask themselves - How good do I want our team to be? The leadership the seniors provide over the next 11 months will ultimately determine Team 2022's success! **Being the Best** is a common goal that championship teams work together toward! If teammates are not putting forth consistent effort, we need to pick them up and encourage them to carry on! If teammates are having poor attitudes, we'll be there to pump them up and give our support. **Section 2AAA** is consistently the top achieving section in the state. In order for Eastview to raise the bar and achieve more, each of us must commit to make the need changes. 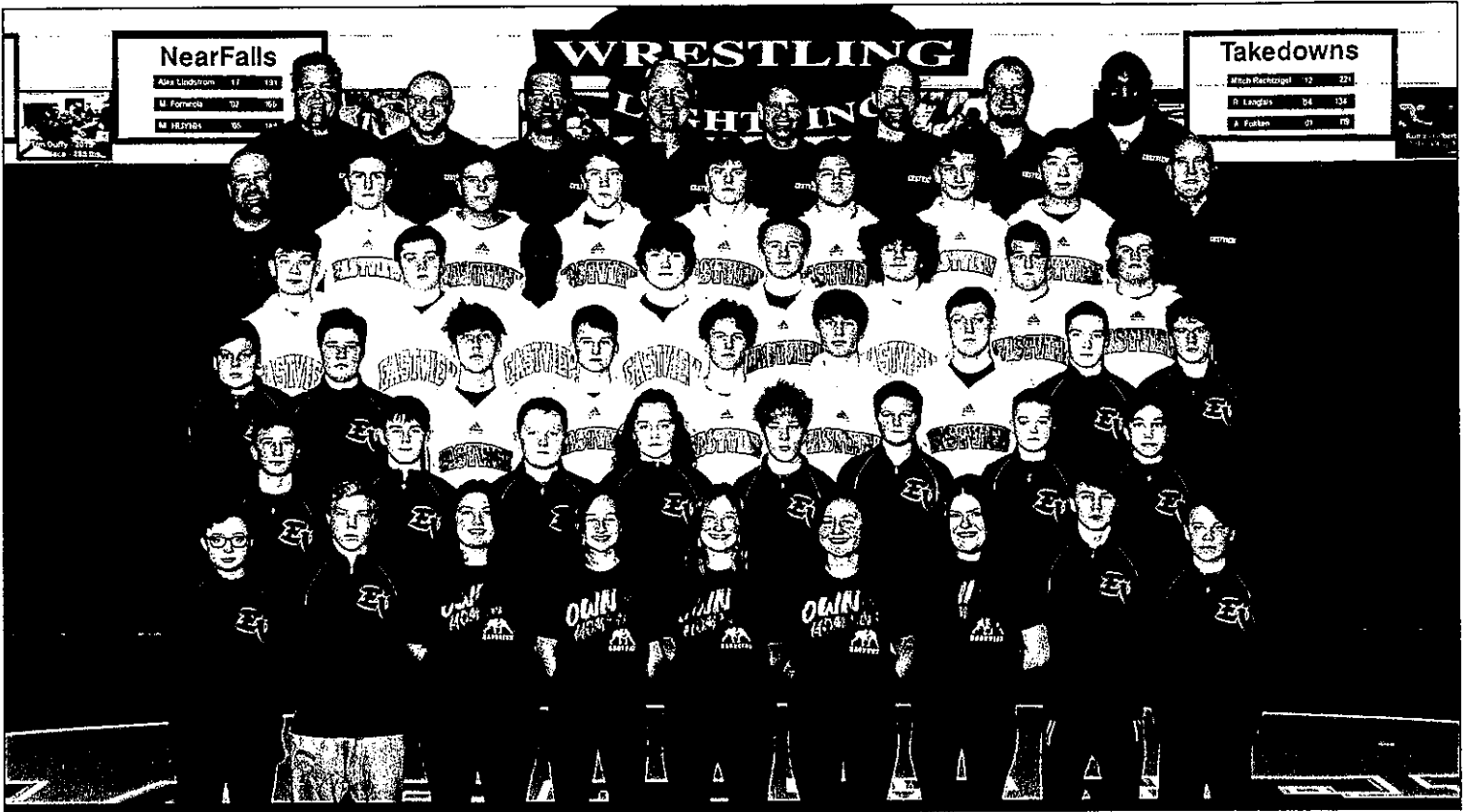

Who can forget the 2000 Olympic Wrestling games? The Russian Greco-Roman undefeated Superheavyweight Aleksandr Karelin was in the finals versus the United States Rulon

Gardner. Karelin was UNDEFEATED for 13 YEARS prior to this match up. He did not give up a point in 6 years leading up to this bout. Gardner was an All-American for Nebraska in college. During the match, one of the old rules in Greco-Roman wrestling after inactivity was to put both wrestlers on their feet in a clinch (over under with hands locked). They would wrestle from there trying to score points. HOWEVER, if anyone breaks their grip a point was awarded to their opponent. Gardner fought and Karelin's hands became unlocked for an instant... point Gardner. Rulon battled and staved off attacks from Karelin as time expired, beating the unbeatable to become an Olympic Gold Medalist. He truly *Owned the Moment!*

There are many more instances showing athletes Owning their Moment — the 1980 Olympic Gold Medal Hockey Team, or quarterback Tom Brady stepping in for an injured Drew Bledsoe in the 2001 season and never looking back.

We know life will present challenges, some we have control over and others we do not. We must adapt and take advantages of those things that we can.

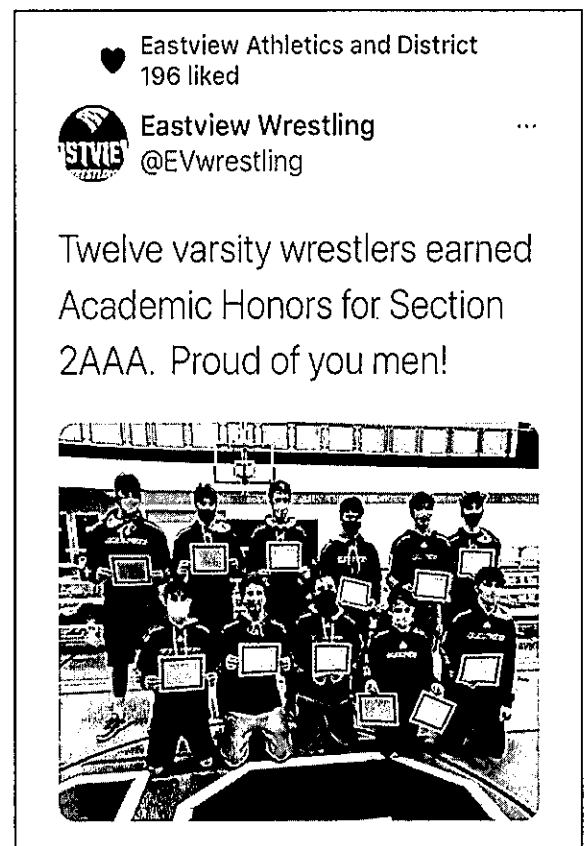

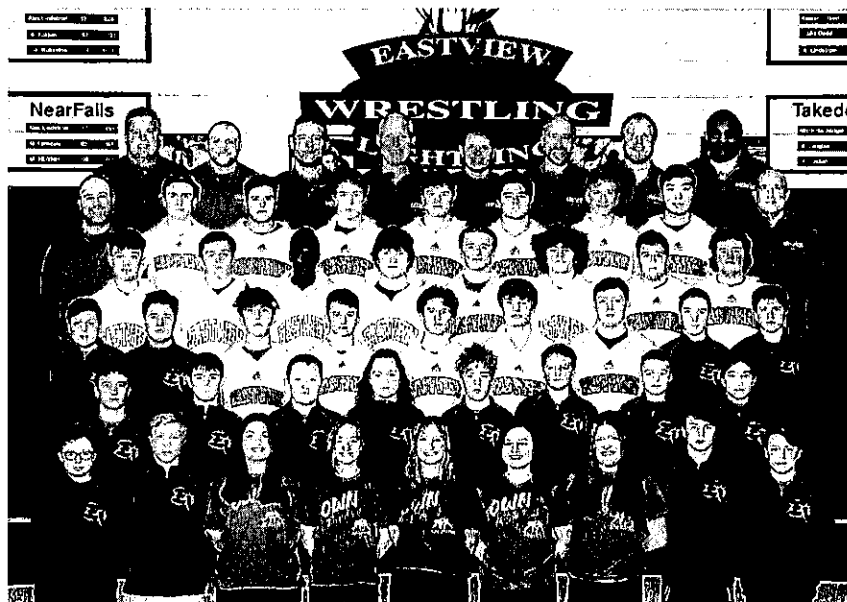

- Kellen Stewart advances to the MN State Wrestling Championships.

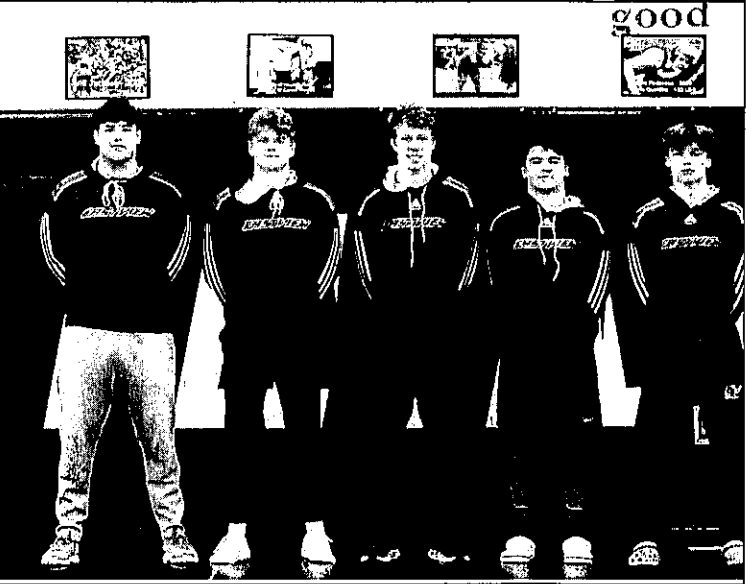
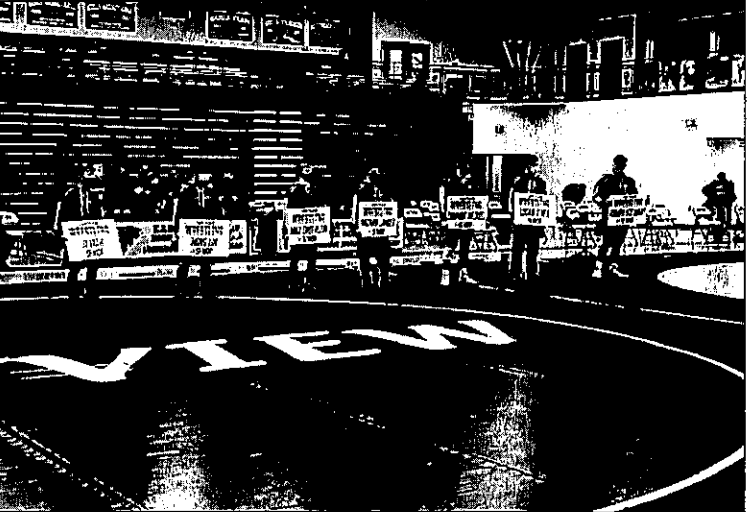
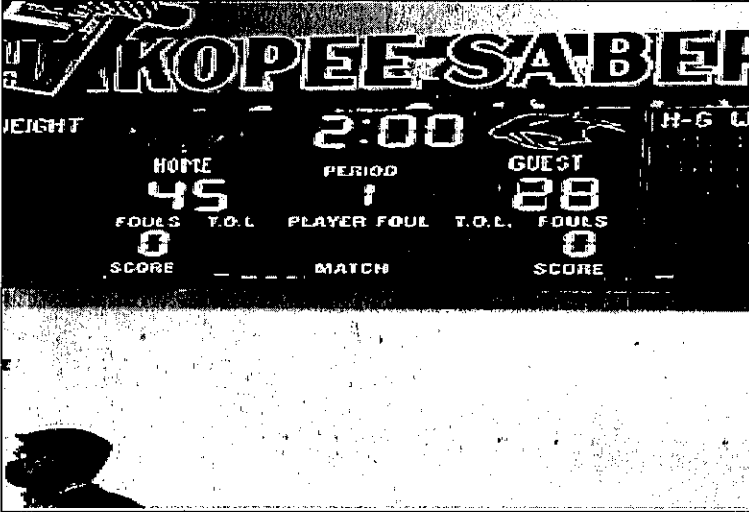
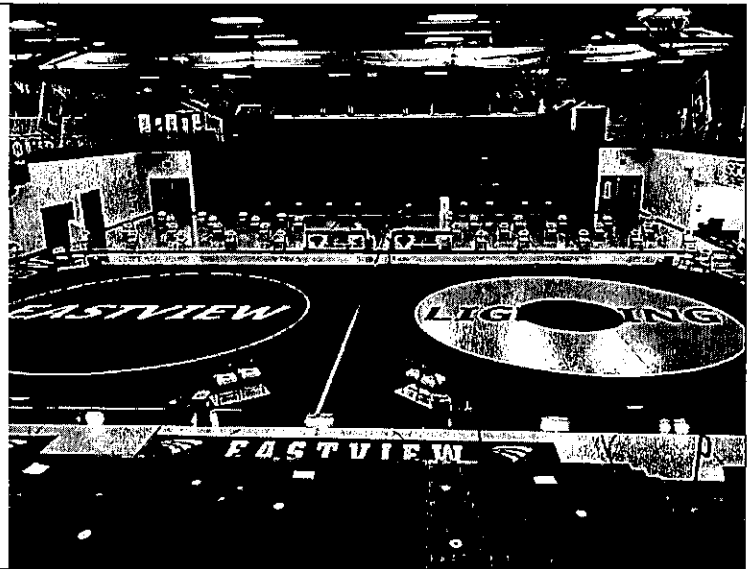

Jore Volk, a 2020 state champion from Lakeville North, earned a spot in the quarterfinals of the state wrestling tournament, as did Panthers teammate Zach Hanson.

They are among the qualifiers in the Class 3A individual tourney, which starts at 2 p.m. Thursday at St. Michael-Albertville High School. Also advancing are two wrestlers from Eagan, two from Farmington and one each from Eastview and Lakeville South.

Thursday's individual tournament is a single-day, three-round event with no wrestleback bracket. Because of COVID-19 considerations, each weight class in the finals has eight wrestlers instead of the usual 16 to reduce crowds at the tournament site.

Farmington High School was one of four sites for Class 3A individual state preliminaries on Saturday. Wrestlers from Section 1 and Section 2 gathered there, with the top two from each weight class moving on to the state finals. The semifinals at the "super sectional" were roughly equivalent to the round of 16 in the traditional state meet format.

Volk, who won the Class 3A championship at 106 pounds last year, is ranked first by the [quillotine.com](http://thequillotine.com) at 120 this season. He's 29-1, with the only loss coming to For-
