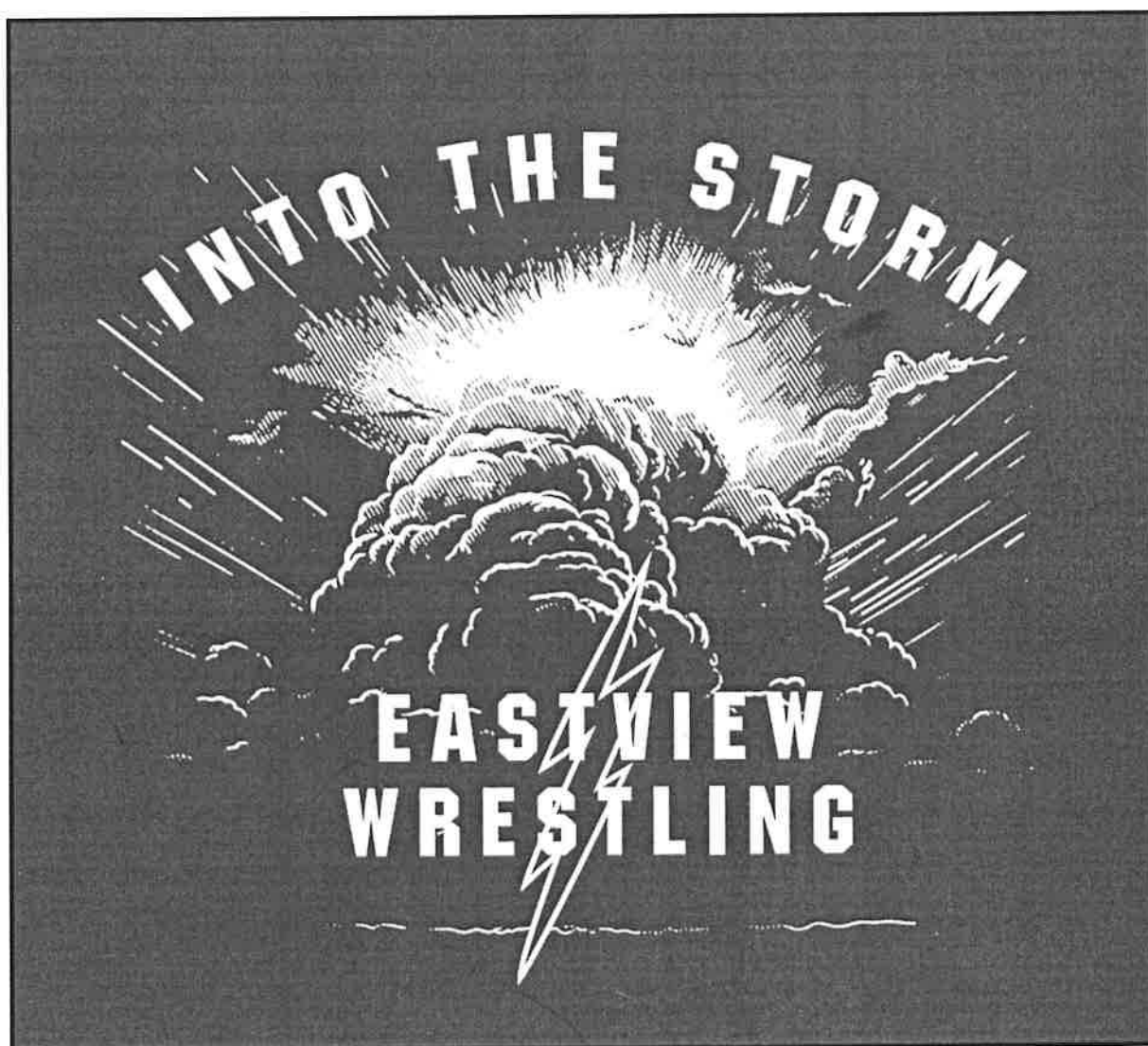

TEAM 2024: Into The Storm!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for successfully completing the season. Eastview Wrestling season's motto was: **Into The Storm!** Team 2024 focused on the process of tackling our adversity head on together as a team! We also embraced a "taking the stairs" approach where we do the difficult things now which will make life easier in the long run.

Team 2024 participated in wrestling training sessions, super group, attending the Augsburg Technique, Nebraska Team Camp. Many wrestlers attended camps or clubs outside of Eastview. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the hard work of our athletes as they strived to continually improve.

The Eastview wrestling team embraced the motto Into The Storm. When a storm approaches, cows tend to flee in the opposite direction, seeking safety and avoiding the adversity. On the other hand, the majestic Bison charges directly into the storm, fearlessly confronting the elements head-on. This symbolism serves as a profound reminder of how we can approach life's obstacles and reminds us of the strength we possess when we face them together as a united herd. Below are a few highlights of the 2024 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 14 freshman and 2 middle school wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Earned 3 dual meet victories including a 5th place finish in the Section 4 Dual Schedule.
- ◆ Competed hard at the Eastview Duals
- ◆ Had 6 wrestlers place at individual regions, 1 wrestler qualify for 9th Grade State with 1 place winner.
- ◆ Earned 72 match wins, 342 team points, 32 falls, and 94 takedowns.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 14 dual meet wins and placed 5th in the South Suburban Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Placed 1st at the Eastview Duals and had 15 wrestlers place at the SSC Tournament.
- ◆ Several wrestlers were able to participate in varsity tournaments and competitions during the season.
- ◆ Had 10+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.
- ◆ Earned 284 match wins, 1522 team points, 206 falls, and 453 takedowns.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.78.
- ◆ Earned 18 hard fought victories competing at the highest level including 5 conference wins.
- ◆ Had 7 wrestlers earn All-Conference and 4 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed 13 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals with 11 placing in the top 6 & 12 earn Academic Recognition.
- ◆ Had 5 Girls at Sectional qualifier with all 5 placing and 2 State Qualifiers.
- ◆ Had 2 girl State Qualifiers with 2 earning All-State honors at the State Championships.
- ◆ Had 27 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 13 wrestlers earn at least 10 wins.
- ◆ Earned 283 match wins, 1632 team points, 169 falls, and 586 takedowns.

The Class of 2024 includes 9 dedicated wrestlers who experienced many successes while living the mottos: Own the Moment, Embrace the Corner, Kaizen, and Into The Storm. The senior class will graduate having earned 142 wins, 47 falls, and 597 team points.

As we begin preparing for next season, the **Senior Class of 2025** must ask themselves - How good do I want our team to be? The leadership the seniors provide over the next 11 months will ultimately determine Team 2025's success! In order for Eastview to raise the bar and achieve more, each of us must commit to make the needed changes. The **Coaching Staff** must provide opportunities and inspire those involved to make the improvements needed. **Wrestlers** need to motivate teammates to work harder, make greater sacrifices, and do all the little things needed to become a champion. **Parents** must continue their commitment and work with the wrestlers and coaching staff to raise expectations. The future success of Eastview's wrestling program is dependent on each of us taking ownership in our roles. Our expectations are high and we are proud to be "daring greatly!"

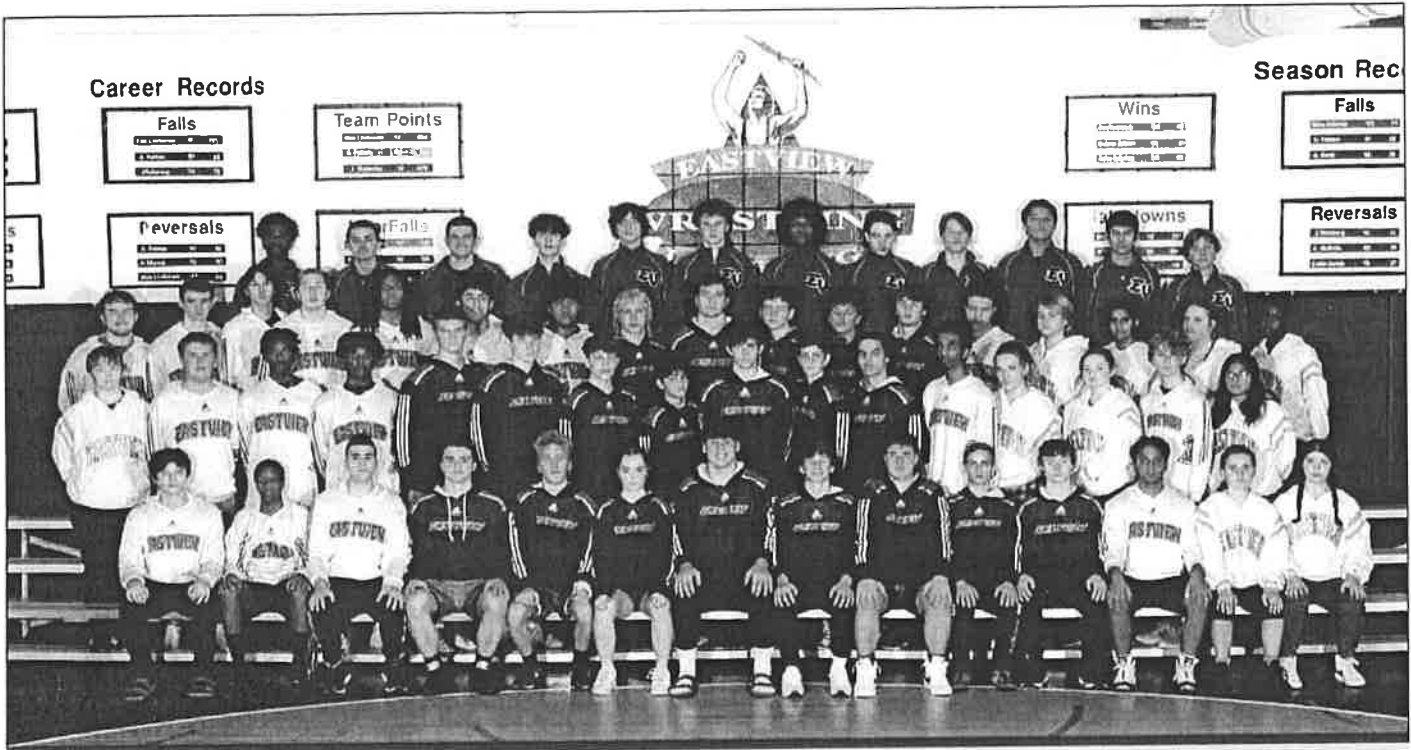

Into the Storm 2023-2024 Eastview Wrestling

The motto for the 2023-2024 Eastview Wrestling team is **"Into The Storm!"** This motto is symbolized by the mighty bison that, when facing a storm, do not run away like its closest relative, the domesticated cow. Rather it confronts the storm directly in its path. We at Eastview Wrestling are like the bison, facing challenges head-on with spirit and intensity.

In wrestling, as in life, we will face many challenges. A big question is how will we react when faced with such events? Will we work hard and be comfortable in our uncomfortableness, or will we shy away from certain conflicts?

Let's look at an example for this idea in the wrestling world. Spencer Lee, the distinguished wrestler from the University of Iowa. Going into the National tournament he was fighting off some knee injuries and surgeries, but didn't let that stop him from being the number one seed at his weight class and dominating the field — until the semifinals. Spencer was wrestling Matt Ramos of Purdue who put the Hawkeye on his back in dramatic fashion and pinned him ending his quest to



become a four-time national champion. During a post-match interview, he didn't shy away, but let the reporters know that he didn't blame his injuries on the loss. "I just got beat." Spencer could have walked away and took a few years off to heal from his injuries, but he did not — he trained and won the Senior Open, prepping for a spot on the United States Olympic team competing in Paris 2024. By the way he took on setbacks or storms in his wrestling life,

there is no doubt he will be representing the U.S.A. on their Freestyle wrestling team.

At Eastview Wrestling we take on challenges, we embrace the hard things. It may be easier to be like the cow, and huddle together or run away from the storms in life, but that's not our way. We accept all challenges and will come out on top. During hard workouts in the wrestling room, or having a tough weight room session, or during a long tough tournament, we accept these contests head-on like the mighty bison, thus growing as a wrestler and as people.

Highlights of the first week of high school wrestling included Eastview winning three matches at its season-opening home quadrangular, including one that wasn't decided until the very end.

Eagan junior Dylan St. Germain defeated Ethan Strack of Scott West 6-2 in the championship match at 114

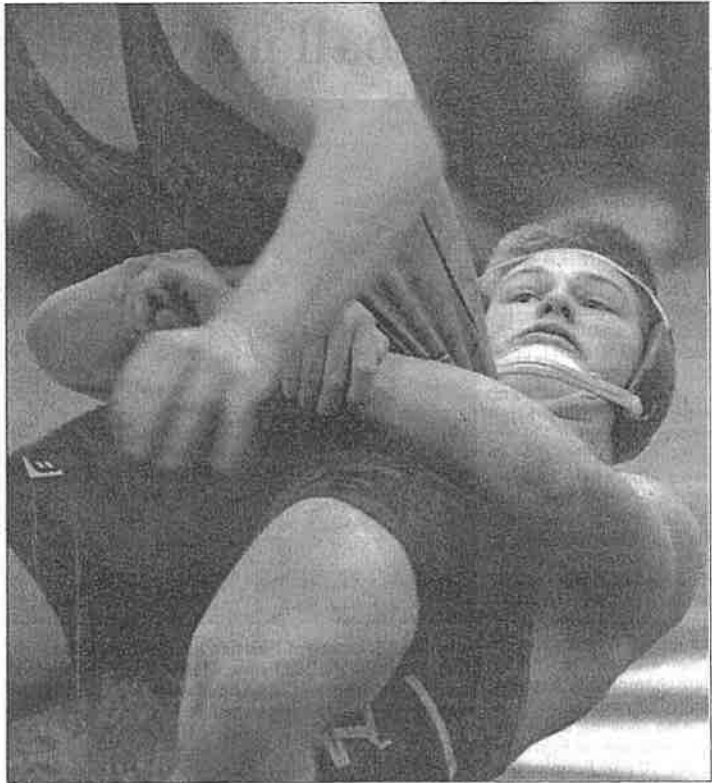

Two Farmington wrestlers take 1st at Christmas Tourney

Eagan, North each take two titles in Northfield

Mounds View established itself as a contender for the state Class 3A wrestling championship after winning the MatBoss Minnesota Christmas Tournament last weekend.

Farmington finished 13th, Apple Valley 18th and Eastview 27th in the Dec. 15-16 tournament at Mayo Civic Center in Rochester. The Christmas tourney is regarded as one of the most competitive during the high school season.

Farmington senior Cole Han-Lindemyer, a returning state Class 3A champion at 182 pounds, won the 189-pound bracket at the MatBoss tournament and remained undefeated on the season. Also winning a first-place medal was Farmington sophomore Davis Parrow at 139.

Mounds View, ranked second in Class 3A by theguillotine.com, had two individual champions and one second-place finisher to score 300.5 points, 25 more than second-place Simley, last year's state Class 2A champion. St. Michael-Albertville, ranked first in Class 3A, was third in the MatBoss tourney. Defending Class 3A state champion Hastings was 10th. Forty teams scored points in the event.

Han-Lindemyer, ranked first in Class 3A at 189, ran his record to 13-0 with the championship at

the MatBoss tourney. He defeated No. 2-ranked Marco Christiansen of Minnetonka 9-5 in the championship match, giving Christiansen, a state champion at 170 last season, his first loss.

Parrow (12-0) outlasted Forest Lake senior Parker Lyden 7-6 for the championship at 139. Parrow is ranked first in Class 3A at 139, while Lyden holds the top ranking at 145. Both wrestlers finished third in their weight classes at the 2023 Class 3A state tournament.

Also placing in the top 12 for Farmington at the Christmas tourney was Edon Davis, who finished eighth at 160.

Apple Valley senior Marcell Booth finished third at 189. Booth, 16-3, lost to Han-Lindemyer 4-3 in the semifinals before defeating Evan McGuire of Mahtomedi 3-2 in a tiebreaker for third place. Booth finished sixth at 170 pounds in the 2023 state tourney.

Apple Valley senior Jayden Haueter finished sixth at 145 and is 15-4 this season. A.J. Garcia, also a senior, placed 12th at 172.

Jack Bauer was Eastview's top finisher, placing 4th at 285. In the third-place match Bauer (10-3) wrestled defending Class 3A champion Will Sather of Eden Prairie, losing by fall.

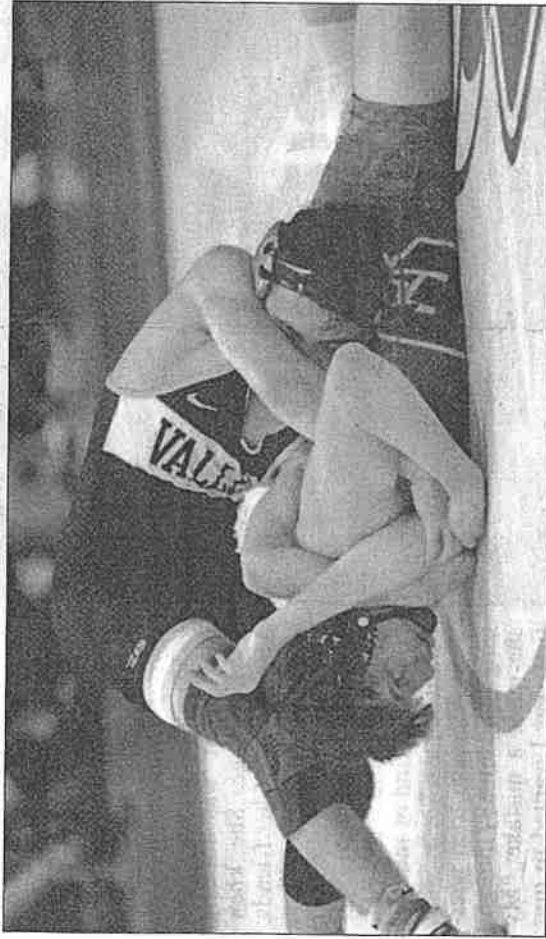

The Eagles are 11th in the most recent state Class 3A rankings published by TheGuillotine.com. The highest-ranked Section 2 team is New Prague at No. 6. New Prague finished second in the 2023 state Class 2A team tour-

wrestle Feb. 14 at Farmington, with the winner advancing to the quarterfinals Feb. 16. The semifinals and finals also will be held that day.

The highest-ranked South Suburban team is league champion Farmington, which was second on the Class 3A list released last week. Shak-

pee will compete in the Section 6 tournament.

Apple Valley and Eastview split the first four matches in their dual before the Eagles took control with four consecutive victories from 133 pounds through 152. Sebastian Castin started the run with a 7-4 decision over Aiden Enderlein at 133. Jayden Haueter, ranked second in Class 3A at 139, won his match by fall, as did Noah Trotter at 145. Tyler Laudendach edged the Lightning's Pierce Lewis 7-6 at 152.

Also winning for Apple Valley were Saitaro Kong by technical fall at 107, Andrew Roskosh by fall at 121, Myles Matthies by major decision at 172 and Marcell Booth by fall at 189. Kong is ranked sixth in Class 3A at 107 and Booth is fifth at 189.

Eastview junior Jack Bauer, who's ranked fourth in the state at 285, won by forfeit against Apple Valley. Also winning for the Lightning were Aryan Karimnejad by decision at 114, Spencer Lee

by 4-3 decision over Tyler Reed at 127, Logan Myers by decision at 160 and Landon Odegaard by fall at 215.

Eastview also competed in the Hastings Duals on Jan. 25, defeating East Ridge 56-9 and losing to Park of Cottage Grove 39-27 and fifth-ranked Hastings 44-22. Hastings is defending state Class 3A champion.

After the Hastings meet, the Lightning were 14-7 overall in dual meets and 5-4 in the conference. Bauer (33-6) is the first Eastview wrestler to 30 victories this year. Reaching 20 victories are Aryan Karimnejad (20-16), Lee (25-11), Enderlein (27-14), Lewis (22-18) and Odegaard (23-11).

Apple Valley will wrestle a dual meet at Watertown-Mayer at 6:30 p.m. Thursday. Eastview will compete in the Robbinsdale Armstrong Duals on Saturday, Feb. 3.

Farmington wrestler wins 139-pound state title

Davis Parrow might be a sophomore in high school, but the body of work in wrestling is already there.

Just last year he went on a run that included championships in freestyle and Greco-Roman at the Minnesota/USA Wrestling state tournament, followed by third-place medals in Greco-Roman

and folkstyle at nationals. Parrow added another line to his resume last week by winning the state high school Class 3A championship at 139 pounds, earning Farmington High School's sixth individual state title.

After rallying to defeat Eden Prairie's Charles Vanier 3-2 in the championship match March 2 at Xcel Energy Center, Parrow described himself as elated but not satisfied.

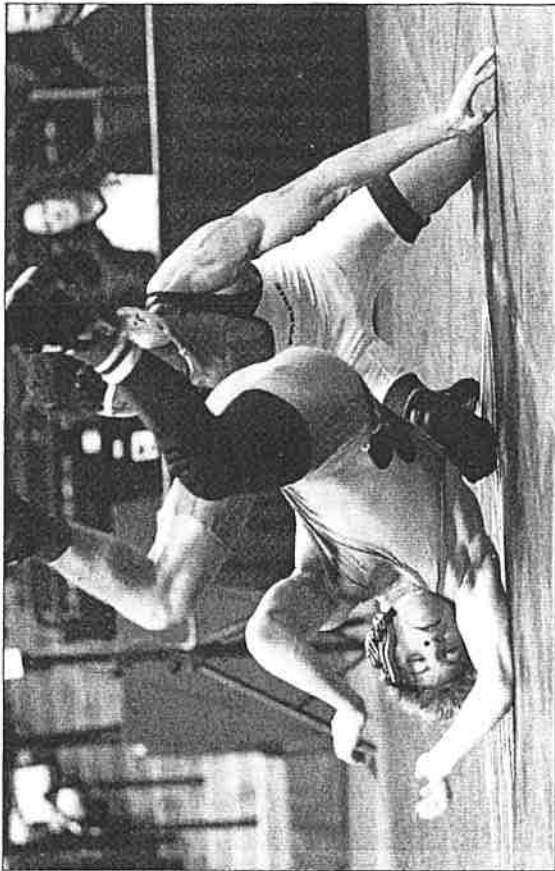
"I've put in a lot of work for this opportunity for a lot of years and the goal was always to get one or two (individual state titles)," he said. "But now

I have a shot at three so that's the goal now, right? It means a lot to be here every single year and get to compete."

Parrow has been knocking on the door of a state high school championship for a while. Two years ago he was Class 3A runner-up at 106 and last year he placed third at 126.

This season he was ranked first for most of the season at 139, regarded as one of the state's deepest, most competitive weight classes. Parrow finished his season 50-1 and was undefeated against

Minnesota competition; his only loss was to Tyler Guerra, a senior from St. Charles (Illinois) East and Indiana University commit.

That's not to say it was easy at state. He drew a tough assignment in the first round against Shakopee senior Connor Warren. Parrow trailed 5-2 after two periods before scoring five points in the final 15 seconds of the third — on a takedown and three-point nearfall — to pull out a 9-6 victory.

Parrow defeated seventh-ranked Parker Lyden of Forest Lake 9-2 in the semifinals to advance to his second championship match in three years. Vanier, who came into the tournament ranked 10th in Class 3A, scored the only point of the first two periods on an escape. Parrow started on the bottom

state tournament.

"It's emotional support, and good training partners," Parrow said. "They always tell you the positives, never the negatives. They're always there to help you."

In addition to winning more state championships and contending for national titles, Parrow has his sights on a long-range goal.

"One day I hope to be in the Olympics," he said. "I feel like that's everyone's goal, but I'm striving to get there."

Farmington senior Cole Han-Lindemyer medaled at the state for the fourth consecutive year, finishing fourth in the Class 3A tournament at 189 pounds. Han-Lindemyer, who won a state championship at 182 last year, entered the state tournament undefeated and ranked first in his weight class.

He reached the semifinals before losing to sixth-ranked Marcell Booth of Apple Valley 5-4 in an ultimate tie-breaker. Booth tied the match with 12 seconds left in the third period when Han-Lindemyer was penalized for stalling.

Han-Lindemyer won his first two matches by technical fall and defeated Sutton Kenning of St. Cloud Tech 5-0 in a wrestle-back match. He lost by fall in the third period to Aydan Carlson of St. Francis to finish 27-2. Han-Lindemyer will wrestle at Stanford University.

Tigers junior Tyler Cheney finished 38-13 after finishing fifth at 114. He was 4-2 in the tournament, including a 6-2 victory over Alex Gau of Champlin Park in the fifth-place match.

Freshman Blake Han-Lindemyer lost his only match at 121 and finished 25-25. Senior Edon

Davis was 2-2 at state at 160 and finished 37-13. Senior Dylan Henrikson finished 15-15 after losing his only match at 285 by a 3-2 decision.

Rosemount

Two Rosemount wrestlers competed in the Class 3A state tournament.

Sophomore Abram Anderson finished 37-8 after winning one of three matches at 127 pounds. His victory was by fall over Mikey Jelinek of Stillwater in the first round of wrestling.

Junior Ty Sauter, ranked sixth in Class 3A at 145, won two of his four matches at state and finished 27-8. Sauter defeated Mounds View senior Brady Swenson 5-4 in the first round. His other victory was by fall over Caden Wong of Wayzata in the first round of wrestlebacks.

Local athletes demonstrate girls wrestling is here to stay

Gonzales, Alagbo, Myers are two-time champions

Seconds after pinning her opponent to win the state championship, Gloriana Vigniavo knelt on the mat and put her head in her hands, as if trying to process what she had just done.

She appeared to be in shock, and with good reason.

"I was in shock," said Vigniavo, an Apple Valley senior who won the girls 190-pound division at the state wrestling finals March 2 in St. Paul. "It still doesn't feel real. Maya (Schmidt of Bemidji, Vigniavo's opponent in the state final) is such a good wrestler. I'm usually a pessimistic person, so I thought it was going to go

all six minutes and there was always something I could do wrong. It just feels crazy that I was able to win."

What was no shock was the success of wrestlers

from District 196 schools at the state tournament, because it's been evident for a while. Nine girls from District 196 schools qualified for the state tournament; all nine re-

dated and four – Vigniavo, Cassandra Gonzales and Grace Alagbo of Apple Valley, and Riley Myers of Eastview – won championships. Apple Valley was the only team with

multiple champions in this year's girls tourney.

Gonzales, the 136-pound champion, went undefeated against girls competition for the second consecutive year. She won a state championship at Shakopee last year before transferring to Apple Valley.

Alagbo (170-pound champion) and Myers (130) took first at the inaugural state high school girls tournament in 2022 and won again this year.

In the first state girls tourney, four wrestlers from each weight class advanced to compete at Xcel Energy Center. The tournament expanded last year to accommodate growing interest in the sport, and now there are eight qualifiers at each weight. A girls team championship is not awarded yet, although Apple Valley was No. 1 in the girls team rankings compiled by theguillotine.com.

According to the Minnesota State High School League, more than 1,000 girls now wrestle for high school programs in the state. Gonzales said that has led to tougher competition and forced her to ramp up her training.

"Compared to last year it was tougher, and I knew it was going to be," said Gonzales, a sophomore who went to Apple Valley to join a program with more girls participating. "We had girls and boys for training partners and it was amazing. You have to wrestle everyone in our room, which is great because you learn so much. Everything you learned there, you could use in a match."

Gonzales finished 30-0 this season. At state, she won her first two matches by fall and defeated Diann Smith of Grand Meadow/LeRoy-Ostrander/Southland by technical fall in

the final.

Vigniavo, who finished third at state at 185 last year, was 30-4 this year. She defeated Folake Olusesi of Robbinsdale Cooper 3-2 in the quarterfinals before pinning her last two opponents.

Alagbo said she was looking for redemption after finishing second at 152 in the 2023 state tourney. She pinned her first two state opponents before defeating Abby Ervasti of Bertha-Hewitt/Verndale/Parkers Prairie to finish 28-1.

"Suffering a loss last year (in the state final) kind of diminished me, but it motivated me to work harder," Alagbo said. "I'm grateful for that loss."

Moments after winning her state championship match Alagbo walked into the tunnel beneath the stands gleefully shouting "Don't play with us! Don't play with us!"

"It's cool to put all my work out there and show people I'm not here to play," Alagbo said later. "It's a blessing because I know a lot of people compete in the state tour-

namment and never get to win a championship."

Eastview's Myers (31-2) won her first state match by technical fall. In the semifinals, Myers and Nora Akpan of Centennial went to overtime scoreless before Myers scored a takedown to win 2-0. She then defeated Minnetonka's Phoebe Kunerth to win her second state championship in three years.

"I've been wrestling since third grade," said

Myers, a senior. "In my college essay I wrote about how I really did struggle a lot in the sport as a child. There were a lot of losses and fourth-place finishes while my brother (Logan, who wrestles for the Eastview boys team) always took home the first-place medals.

"As a kid with those losses, it was hard for me to envision winning a state championship. But when they sanctioned

girls wrestling, it became a goal of mine. All that hard work I put in, it did pay off eventually."

Apple Valley was close to a fourth state championship. Eagles eighth-grader Andrea Quinones and Sauk Centre-Melrose sophomore Lanna Walter put on a back-and-forth battle for the 124-pound title, with Walter winning 10-9. Quinones led 8-6 with less than one minute remaining before Walter scored a takedown and

two-point nearfall to take the lead – and eventually, the victory.

In the semifinals, Quinones (30-5) defeated Rosemount sophomore Kamdyn Saulter 4-2 in overtime. Saulter went to the third-place match, where she defeated Lainey Houts of Northfield to finish her season 12-3.

Apple Valley junior Hanah Schuster, competing in her third state tournament, placed fifth at 112. Schuster lost to Chloe Wehry of Sartell-St. Stephen 9-8 in the first

round, then won her consolation semifinal match 10-1. Schuster defeated Gisele Gallegos of South St. Paul 5-2 in the fifth-place match.

Apple Valley sophomore Esperanza Calvillo was 1-2 in the state tournament and finished fourth at 148. Her 13-4 victory over Bella Carlson of Forest Lake was her 30th victory against five losses.

have an edge when they went into their matches. They knew they would win...and they did.

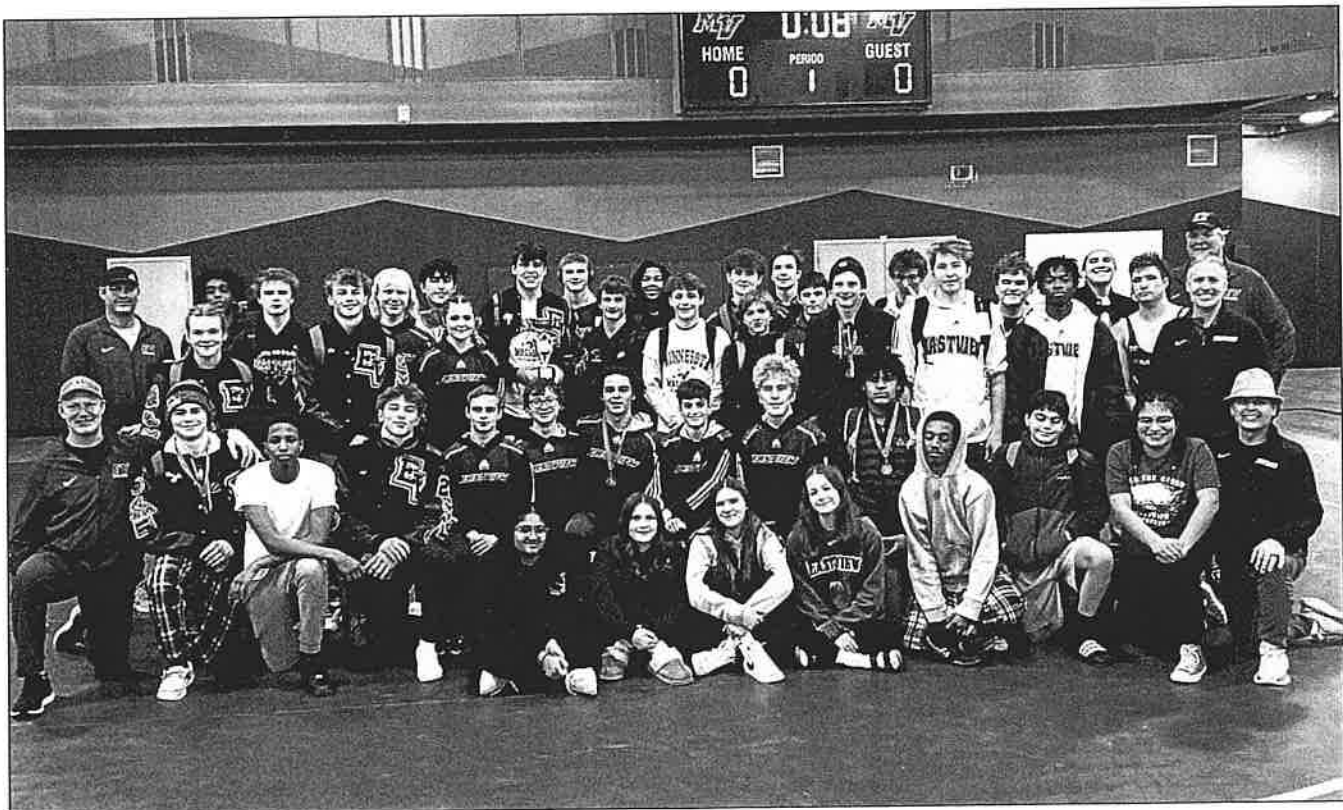
