Kurt Habeck, Head Coach

Kurt Habeck, a native of Winona, Minnesota, has been a social studies teacher, wrestling and football coach, and weight room instructor for 8 years.

Kurt was a graduate of Augsburg College where he competed in wrestling and was a captain on the NCAA III National Championship Team. Individually, Kurt was a two-time MIAC Confer-

ence Champ and a NCAA III All-American and an Academic All-American. He was a varsity starter all four years as Augsburg placed eighth, third, second, and first nationally.

Matt is in his second year serving as captain for the Lightning. Last year Matt had 14 wins and

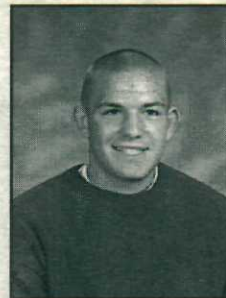
earned All Conference Honorable Mention honors. Matt placed 6th in last years sectional tournament.

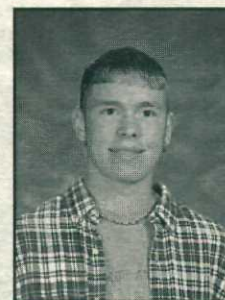
David Rasmussen

Matt, a junior, wrestled at 119 lbs. last year earning 13 wins with 7 pins. Matt is expecting to improve on these statistics this season.



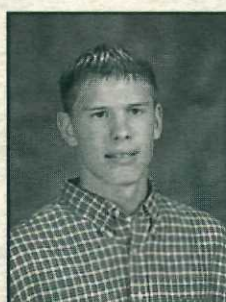
Nate Ernst

Sean Richards

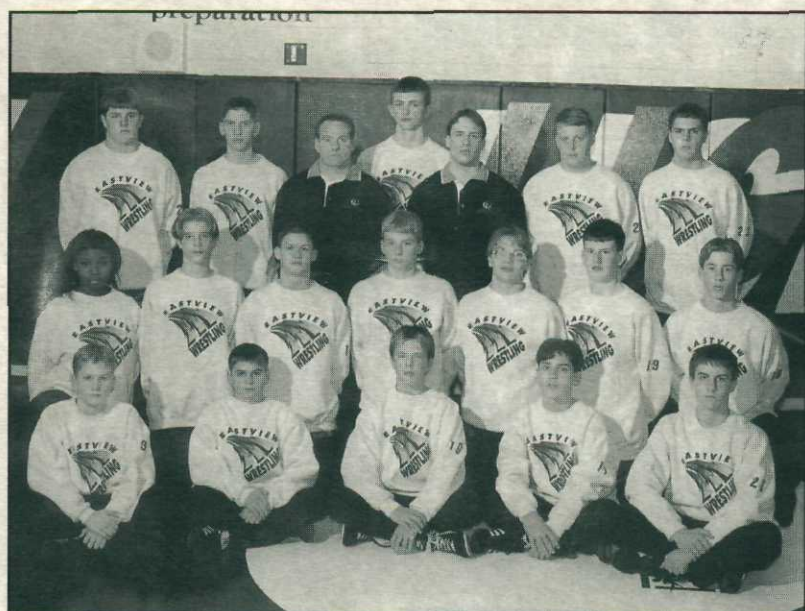
Sean is in his 3rd year of wrestling. As a letterwinner last year, Sean earned 9 victories on varsity.
