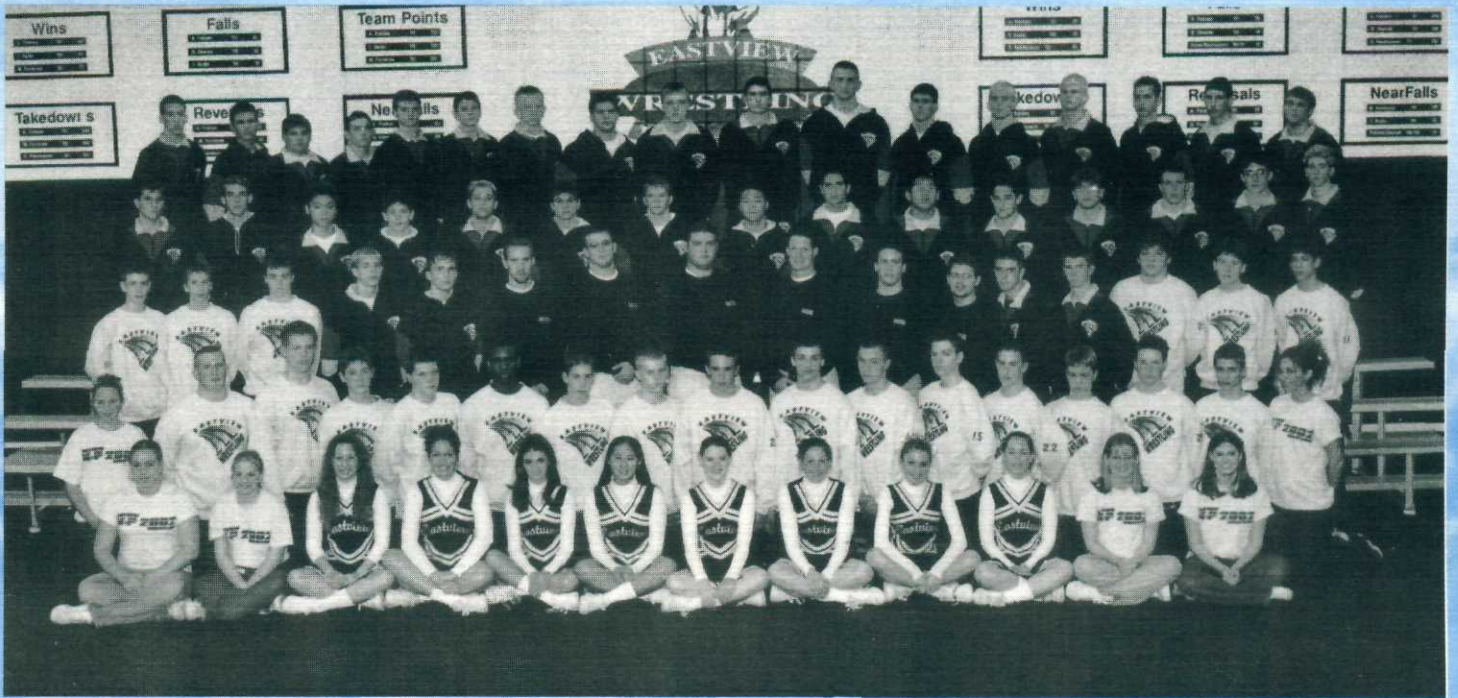

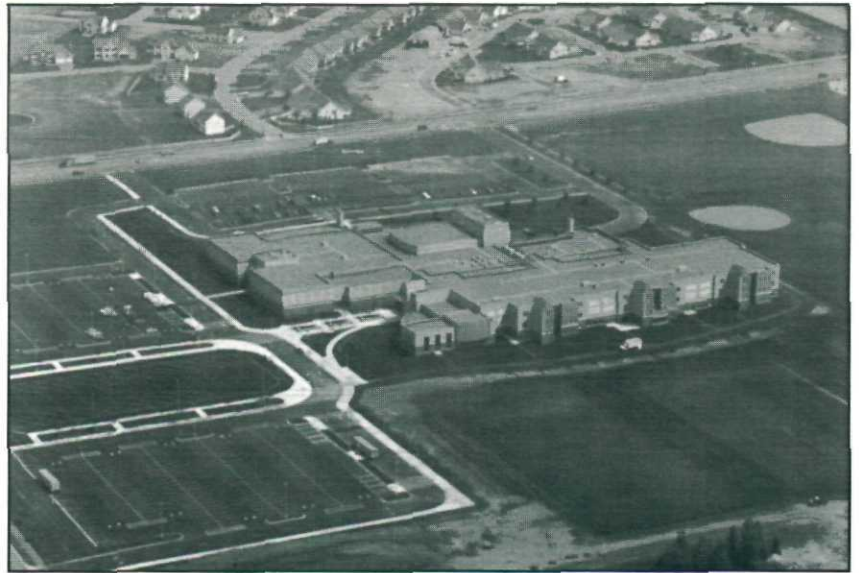
# Eastview High School

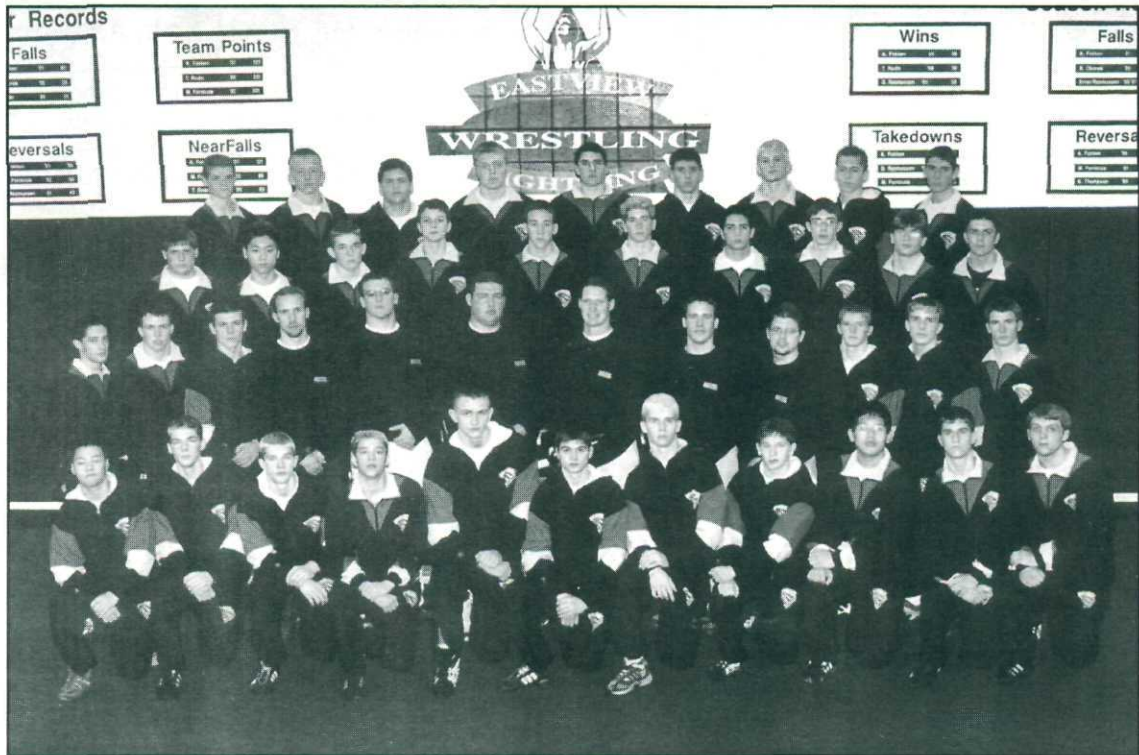

**Possible:** In order to accomplish your mission to be the best you can be you need to make it possible. The way to make it possible is through hard work, goal setting, and doing the little things.

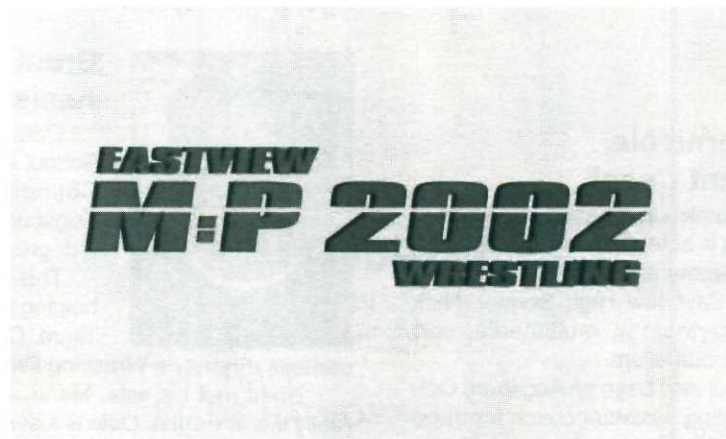
Working hard everyday will make your mission possible. You need to work hard even when you don't feel like it.

## Kurt Habeck, Head Coach

Kurt was a graduate of Augsburg College where he competed in wrestling and was a captain on the NCAA III National Championship Team. Individually, Kurt was a two-time MIAC Conference Champ and a NCAA III All-American and

an Academic All-American. He was a varsity starter all four years as Augsburg placed eighth, third, second, and first nationally.

## Travis Lee, Assistant Coach

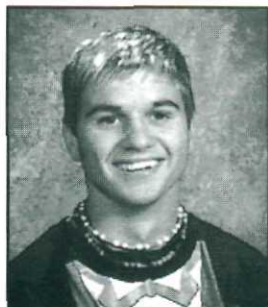

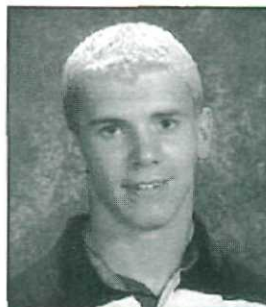
## CAPTAINS

Mikey, a 2X captain, is entering his 4<sup>th</sup> year of varsity wrestling for the Lightning. Last season was a very successful

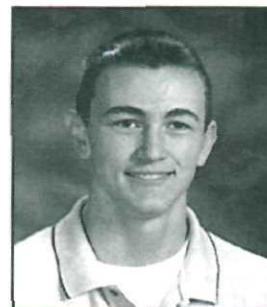
year for Mikey. He earned All-Conference honors and while winning 28 matches.

the upcoming season. John was also a state qualifier last year in the pole volt event.

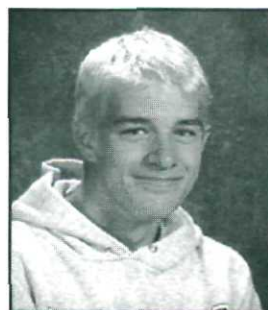


### Eric Lemm

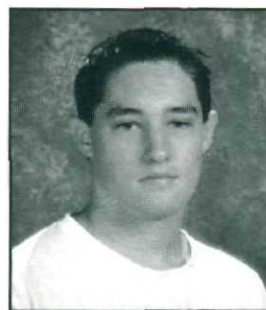
qualified for the 9<sup>th</sup> grade league state tournament.

Mention honors, and placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in sections which qualified him for the State Tournament.



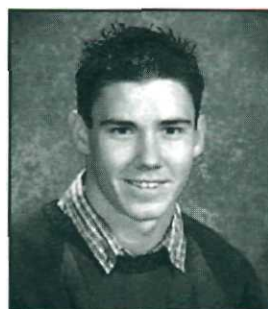
### Kurt McCue

### Chris Shuck

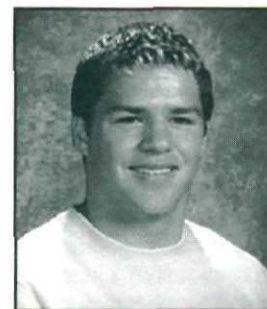
Chris, a junior, wrestled on varsity at 160lbs most of the season and earned 14 hard fought victories. Chris also earned All-Conference

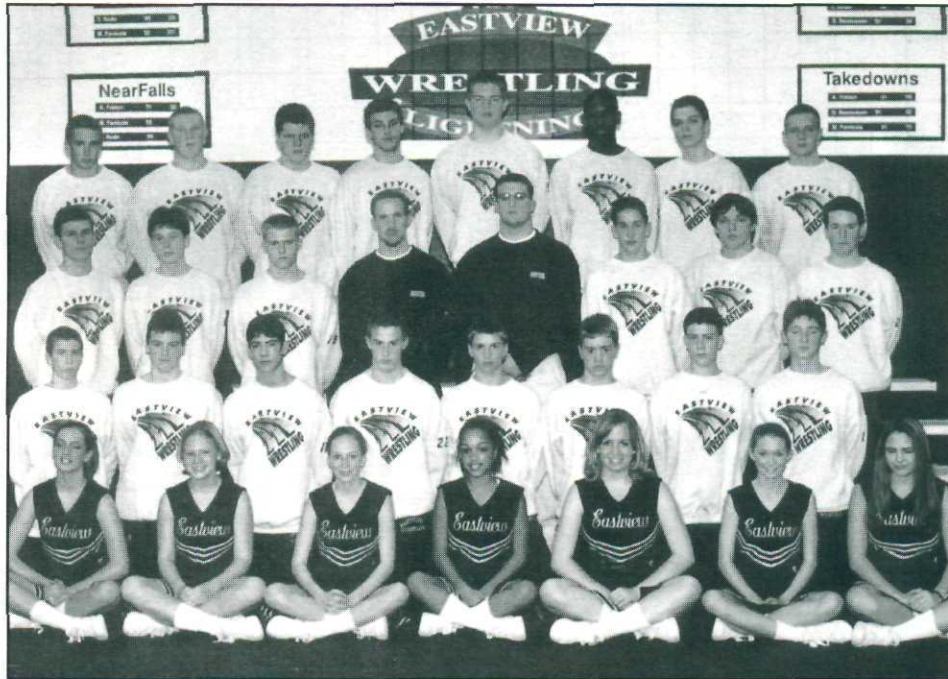
James wrestled on the Junior Varsity team last year earning a team high 26 wins. James, a letter winner, also had the opportunity to wrestle on varsity. James

Jordan retired after that season going out on top. Now, many reporters and naysayers believe he will tarnish his image if he isn't as great as he once was. A reporter asked him: "Some people think it will be a shame if you comeback and fail." To which Jordan responded: "If I fall, I'll get back up. I'm not afraid to fall. It wouldn't be a shame if I failed, but it would be a shame if I didn't try and give it 100 percent."

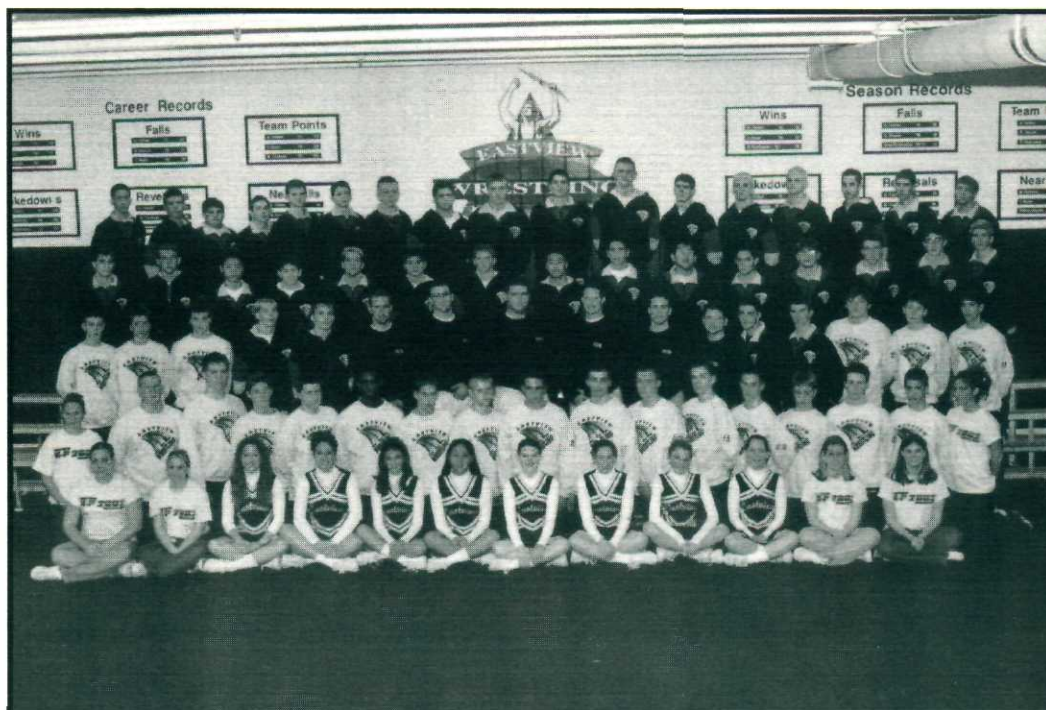
The thing I think I admired most about Jordan
