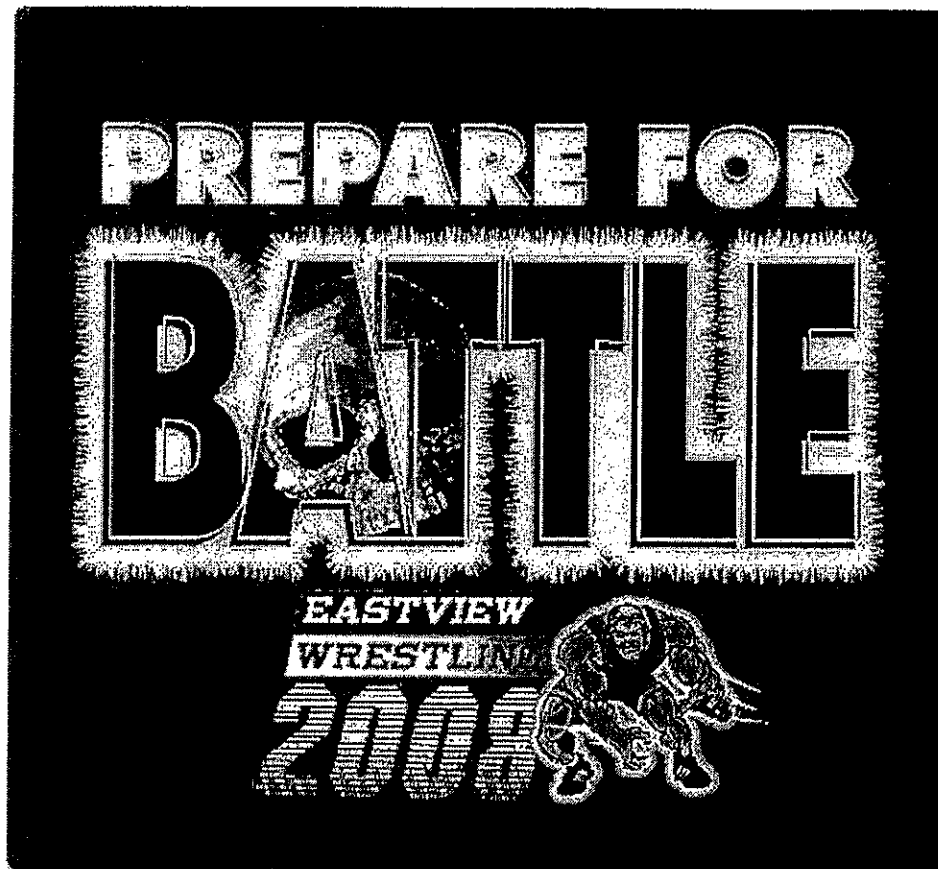

TEAM 2008: PREPARE FOR BATTLE!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for completing the season. This past spring, Team 2008 began their *PREPARTION* for the upcoming season's *BATTLES!* The season was filled with many highlights for each team and the wrestling program as a whole. At last year's banquet, we said good-bye to 6 quality seniors. The senior class of 2008 was determined to achieve high standards set by previous teams. Team 2008 committed to several off-season training programs including participating in another sport, wrestling freestyle, strength training in Super Group, and traveling to Nebraska for a team camp. The success that each team had this year was directly related to the leadership provided by the seniors and by each individual making a commitment to the team.

Reflecting on this past season brings back many **positive memories**. Commitment Night led by the seniors allowed each wrestler to come together, build relationships, set goals, and begin making a commitment to the upcoming season. The seniors did a great job leading by example, promoting a solid work ethic, and encouraging each wrestler to maximize their efforts. Below is a recap of the 2008 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 13 freshman & 10 middle school wrestlers work hard & complete the season.
- ◆ Improved throughout the season and had 6 wrestlers place at Regions with 2 State Qualifiers.
- ◆ Brad Hogan became a 9th grade state finalist earning 2nd place honors.
- ◆ Earned 83 match wins, 390 team points, 27 falls, and 104 takedowns.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 13 dual meet wins and a 3rd place finish in the Lake Conference.
- ◆ Competed in the 2nd Annual Lake Conference JV Tourney and earned 3rd place honors.
- ◆ Earned 48 individual tournament championships.
- ◆ Earned 389 match wins, 1533 team points, 236 falls, and 582 takedowns.
- ◆ Had 17 wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned an Academic State Championship with a team GPA of 3.84.
- ◆ Earned 14 hard fought victories including two individual tournament runner-up finishes.
- ◆ Had 8 wrestlers earn All Conference Honorable Mention and 2 earn All Conference Honors.
- ◆ Participated in Super Section 3AAA and had 10 individual section place winners.
- ◆ Had 36 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 10 wrestlers earning at least 15 wins.
- ◆ Earned 324 match wins, 1526 team points, 135 falls, and 553 takedowns.

The **Class of 2008** includes 8 highly dedicated seniors who together **PREPARED FOR BATTLE!** The senior class will leave having earned 173 wins, 99 falls, and 913 team points. To each of the seniors, we thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. We wish you the best of luck in your future endeavors and we hope that the Lightning Pride you developed over the past 4 years will be with you forever.

I want to share with you some final thoughts about the **Future of Eastview Wrestling**. The Super Section that we have been placed in is something we cannot change. We can choose to spend our energy talking about the unfairness, or, we can spend our energy making the necessary sacrifices to be able to *Raise the Bar*. The **Coaching Staff** is more committed than ever to make improvements needed to the overall program. We have many goals that have yet to be achieved. **Wrestlers** need to challenge themselves even more than those before them, inspire teammates to work harder, make greater sacrifices, and do all the little things needed to become a champion. The *Pain of Preparation* is much easier than the *Pain of Defeat*. **Parents** must continue to offer their support and work with the wrestlers and coaching staff. 19 letter-winners return

Nineteen letter-winners, including a half-dozen who earned All-Lake Conference honorable mention, return to Eastview's wrestling team this winter.

The roster also includes 10 who placed in last year's Class 3A, Section 6 tournament. Eastview began its season with a dual-meet tournament Saturday. The Lightning will face Bloomington Kennedy at home at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 6.

Eastview senior Will Jackson is ranked fourth in Class 3A at 215 pounds after finishing fourth at that weight in the 2007 state tournament. He finished 14-5 after missing part of last season with an injury. Jackson is a three-time letter-winner.

Scott Hogan had 31 victories last year, more than any Eastview returnee, and took third in the section at 125. He began this season ranked seventh in the state at 125. Bryan Okonek, a senior captain along with Jackson, won 19 matches and placed fourth in the section tourney at 145. He is projected to wrestle at 160 this year.

Two other returnees won 20 matches last season: junior Ty Groskreutz and his brother Cody, a sophomore. Both placed fourth in the section tournament. Ty is projected to wrestle in the middle weights, with Cody at 119.

Senior Trever Sutherland (145) and junior Dijon Sanders (215) won 18 and 17

matches, respectively, last season.

Other key returnees include seniors Dion Blundetto (160), Scott Kenning (189), Josh Larson (152), James Lenz (171) and David Ly (130) and James Pudwill (215); junior Cole Bechly (135) and sophomore Ben Bowar (171).

Ninth-grader Brad Hogan is not a returning letter-winner, but The Guillotine, a state wrestling publication, put him at sixth in its Class 3A state rankings at 103.

Lightning coach Kurt Habeck said this year's team is balanced and athletic. It's also deep, with wrestlers coming up from a junior varsity team that won 13 matches. Eastview also three wrestlers place at last year's ninth-grade state tourney.

Some lineup shuffling is likely because there are weights where Eastview has not just one returning wrestler, but several. Habeck projected Jackson, Pudwill and Sanders to be at 215, for example. In last year's section meet, however, Sanders wrestled at 189 and Pudwill was the Lightning's heavyweight.

Eastview could be short on experience at the lighter end of the lineup, with its wrestlers at 103 and 112 likely to be varsity rookies. The Lightning's next tournament is the Coon Rapids Duals at 9 a.m. Saturday, Dec. 8. Eastview returns to Lake Conference action Dec. 13 at home against Burnsville.

If you have a true commitment to excellence you will give up anything that does not help you become better as an athlete or a person. Don't be content with mediocrity- strive to live up to the greatness within you.

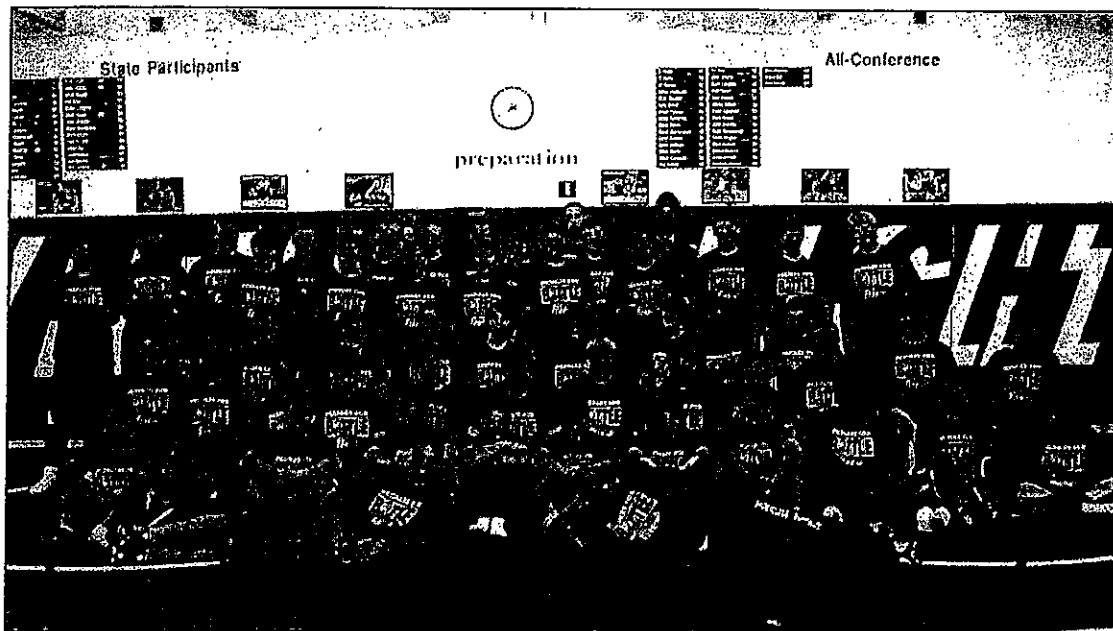

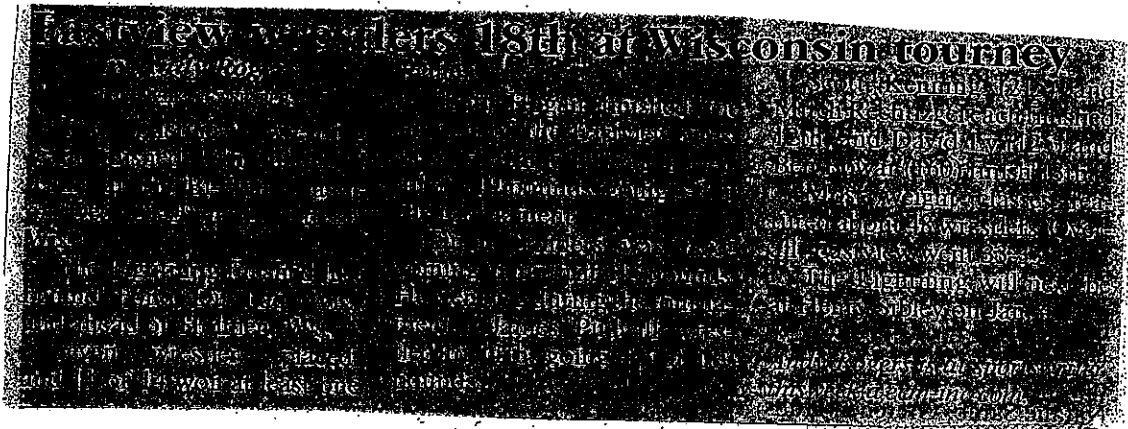
