## TEAM 2015: PAIN IS TEMPORARY, PRIDE IS FOREVER!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for a very successful wrestling season for the Eastview Lightning! Team 2015's season motto was: **Pain is Temporary, Pride is Forever!** Wrestlers on this year's team set goals and quickly realized they could not simply wish for their goals to come true. In athletics, like life, you must work hard to achieve your goals. Wishing won't win, working will! Team 2015 committed to several off-season training programs including attending freestyle practices; participating in wrestling summer training sessions, and traveling to the Oklahoma State University for team camp. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the leadership of our seniors motivated by knowing that "**Pride is Forever**"!

Reflecting on this past season brings back many **Positive Memories**. Commitment Night led by the captains and seniors allowed each wrestler to come together, build relationships, set goals, and begin making a commitment to the upcoming season. The seniors did a great job leading by example, promoting a solid work ethic, and encouraging each wrestler to "**Train Like Superman**". Below are a few highlights of the 2015 season.

### The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 17 freshmen and 7+ middle school wrestlers learn the sport and complete the season.
- ◆ Earned 7 dual meet victories including 6 wins within Section 4.
- ◆ Competed in (4) JV Tournaments – Northfield, Eastview, Armstrong, and Lakeville South.
- ◆ Had two wrestlers qualify for the State Individual Tournament.
- ◆ Earned 144 match wins, 751 team points, 67 falls, and 153 takedowns.

### The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 12 wins and placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in the South Suburban Conference.
- ◆ Placed 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Eastview Duals and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Gold Division at the Lakeville South Tournament.
- ◆ Participated in varsity tournaments at Northfield & Mound-Westonka.
- ◆ Earned 464 match wins, 1498 team points, 210 falls, and 448 takedowns.
- ◆ Had 10+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.

### The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.62.
- ◆ Earned 18 hard fought victories placing 1<sup>st</sup> at the Mounds View & Armstrong Duals.
- ◆ Had 2 wrestlers earn All-Conference Honors and 5 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed all 14 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals and earned 2<sup>nd</sup> place honors in team points.
- ◆ Had 2 Section Champs, 7 State Qualifiers, and 3 All-State Wrestlers earning 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 5<sup>th</sup> place honors.
- ◆ Had 30 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 12 wrestlers earn at least 18 wins.
- ◆ Earned 393 match wins, 1828 team points, 199 falls, and 733 takedowns.

The **Class of 2015** includes 15 wrestlers, many whom were highly dedicated, that helped lead the team with a single minded focus. The senior class will leave having earned 355 wins, 223 falls, and 2195 team points. To each of the seniors, we thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. We wish you the best of luck in your future endeavors and we hope that the Lightning Pride you developed over the past 4 years stays with you forever.

As we begin preparing for next season, the **Senior Class of 2016** must ask themselves - How good do I want our team to be? The leadership of the seniors and others over the next 12 months will ultimately determine Team 2016's success! **Being the Best** is a common goal that championship teams work together toward! If teammates are not putting forth consistent effort, we need to pick them up and encourage them to carry on! 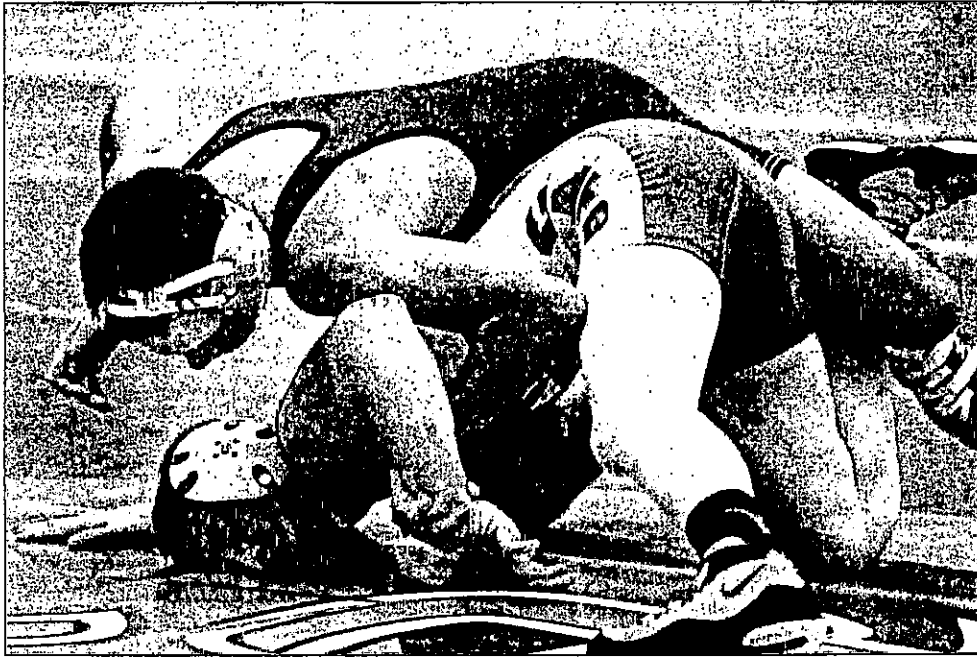

# Eastview wrestlers earn invite to Christmas tourney

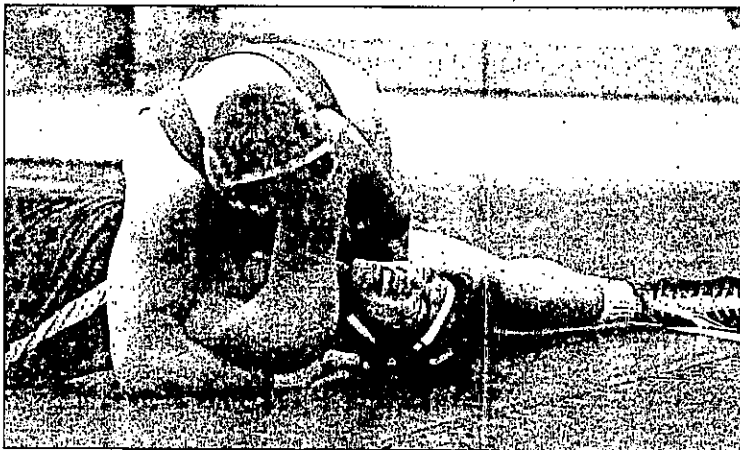
Lightning lineup, when healthy, could be strong

There's a carrot-and-stick thing going at the Minnesota Christmas Tournament, one of the state's top high school regular-season wrestling events.

Teams that build their programs to the point where they're having consistent success get invited to the tournament. One of those is Eastview, which will compete in the Minnesota Christmas Tournament for the first time Friday and Saturday at University Center in Rochester.

There's also a little pressure involved, Lightning coach Kurt Habeck said, because teams that don't perform well at the tournament have been known to not be asked back. This year's event includes eight of the top 10 teams in the Minnesota Class 3A rankings, including defending Christmas Tournament champion Apple Valley.

Two other South Suburban Conference teams, Prior Lake and Farmington, also will participate.

If healthy, the Lightning can give a good account of itself at this weekend's tourney, Habeck said.

"If healthy" are the operative words. "We've had kind of a strange start," the coach said. "We weren't 100 percent

healthy when the season started. Our lineup wasn't where we wanted it to be.

"When we're healthy, our lineup's pretty strong up top and down below."

Eastview started the season just outside the top 12 in theguilotine.com preseason Class 3A team rankings, but a 1-3 start moved the Lightning off the radar. Last week, however, the Lightning defeat-

ed Rosemount 51-27 at the District 196 TakeDown Cancer Duals at Eastview High School. Apple Valley defeated Eagan in the other match. Plans are for the TakeDown Cancer Duals to be an annual event with Eastview, Apple Valley, Eagan and Rosemount taking turns as host.

Eastview's lineup is led by two returnees with state tournament experi-

ence, George Farmah and Luke Dodd. Farmah was 35-6 last season and finished third at state at 126 pounds. Dodd (32-13) reached the state tourney at 182. Dodd also finished fifth at 182 in the USA Wrestling state junior freestyle tournament and qualified for the national competition last summer in Fargo, N.D.

"Both of them have high expectations, not only for themselves, but for our team," Habeck said. "They're multi-sport athletes, and both have been with us for four years."

Supporting them is a group of athletes who placed in last season's Section 3 tournament, including sophomore Alex Lindstrom, who placed third at 138. Seniors Casey Dravis and Tom Delich were fourth-place finishers at the section tourney. Brendan Formanek, Zach Habeck and Eric Stumpf also placed in the top six in their weight classes at sections.

Mike Delich, a sophomore who won a ninth-grade state championship last season, is expected to settle into the lineup at

195. The South Suburban Conference already was competitive in wrestling with Apple Valley and Prior Lake, who met for the state Class 3A team championship last March, but it has become even stronger with the addition of Farmington and Shakopee, formerly of the Minnesota Conference. Shakopee is ranked fourth in Class 3A and is in the top 50 nationally. Farmington is ranked 11th in Class 3A.

Developing programs at places such as Eagan, Lakeville North and Lakeville South also make the South Suburban a deep wrestling conference. It will be a challenge to keep pace, but Kurt Habeck said he believes Eastview has the roster to do just that.

"We have 60 kids out, which is good, and we have 14 seniors," he said. "We have a number of kids who have been in the program for several years, which is something we're really proud of."

# He's a natural on the mat

Eastview senior George Farmah, a native of Liberia, is hoping for another shot at state title.

From Day 1, Kurt Habeck could see George Farmah's unique style.

Habeck, the Eastview wrestling coach, had talked Farmah onto the mat after the then-freshman had been cut from the basketball team. Albeit raw, Farmah was strong, athletic, quick and, Habeck said, a natural.

"He has this uncanny strong grip that allows him to just latch on to [opponents] and they can't do much about it," Habeck said. "It's just all strength and athleticism. Everyone could see that at his first practice."

More than anything, though, Habeck said Farmah simply

has a knack for adapting to situations — whether as a 12-year-old moving with his siblings from Liberia to Minnesota, as a novice at his first wrestling practice, or as a first-timer to the state meet last year.

Now a senior, Farmah is among the state's best wrestlers in the 132-pound weight class. The last six years have been a whirlwind, he said, but he's handled adversity the same way he approaches every match on the mats.

"I just try to only worry about what [is in front] of me," he said. "I try not to get caught up in everything else, and just [control] what I can."

#### Quick learner

Farmah grew up playing

soccer in Liberia, living with extended family as his mother worked in the U.S. to bring her three children stateside.

Farmah said the move, particularly dealing with the cold, was a big adjustment but sports played a large role in his transition. "It helped a lot with making friends and getting to know people," he said, and it made him more comfortable around his classmates.

He quickly became comfortable on the mat, too.

In his first year, Farmah wrestled mostly with Eastview's freshmen team. But toward the end of the season, Habeck started putting him in varsity matches.

"He was like a sponge," Habeck said, "just trying to learn

as much as he could, and I think he really started to like it a lot."

After a strong campaign as a sophomore, Farmah broke out last year, making a late-season run that culminated with reaching the state championship match at the Xcel Energy Center.

He finished second and ended the year 38-7.

#### Picking up steam

Farmah had offseason shoulder surgery and then suffered a concussion early this winter. He didn't get into a match until winter break, but has gone 13-3 since, and is ranked No. 4 in Class 3A at his weight.

Habeck said Farmah is just now getting back to normal and

should be primed for another postseason run. The goal is a state title, something Farmah only sheepishly admits.

"He's a really humble kid," Habeck said. "He's just one of those guys that everyone on the team loves and really gravitates to. He always has a smile on his face, he's always working hard."

"It's pretty special as a coach when you get kids like him. And he has to be special to accomplish some of the things he has."

"He just appreciates all the things he has going for him. He has that same attitude as he did on Day 1 when he first got on the mat. He's just a unique kid, and it's rewarding as a coach to have him."

## Section individual wrestling is this weekend

Apple Valley defeated Eastview 52-24 for the Class 3A, Section 3 team wrestling championship last Friday, but by the time the match was over both teams had accomplished something meaningful.

For Apple Valley, it was a 33rd consecutive trip to the state team competition where the Eagles will seek a 10th straight team championship. Eastview, the section tournament's No. 3 seed, reached a section championship match for the first time and closed one of its best dual meet seasons ever at 18-7.

The Eagles led 25-24 with five matches remaining in Friday's section final at Eastview. But the top of the Apple Valley lineup is formidable — it includes three wrestlers ranked first in the state — and it swept those final five matches.

"Eastview has some tough kids and a good team overall," Apple Valley coach Dalen Wasmund said. "We tried to move up one kid in the lower weights and it didn't work out well for us. But at 170 (pounds) we moved up Andrew Walock, who had to wrestle well to win this match."

That led Apple Valley into the strength of its lineup with No. 1-ranked wrestlers Mark Hall, Bobby Steveson and Gable Steveson wrestling consecutive matches.

The Eagles' Nate Larson and Kyle Rathman won the first two matches by fall, putting the Eagles into the lead.

In years past, Apple Valley's goal has been to have a state qualifier at every weight class. That could be tougher to achieve this year because the section seems to be deeper, Wasmund said.

"At 106, there are three ranked kids in our section," Wasmund said. "At 126, there are five kids who look to be awfully close."

Seedings for the section individual tournament were scheduled to be done Wednesday night, after this edition went to press. Apple Valley has three wrestlers ranked No. 1 in their weight classes by theuiltime.com — Mark Hall (170), Bobby Steveson (195) and Gable Steveson (220). Rathman is ranked second at 113 and Brock Morgan is ranked third at 145.

Eastview's George Farmah was state runner-up at 126 last season and is ranked third this year. The Lightning's Luke Dodd is ranked second at 182. Mike Delich is fourth at 195 and Tim Duffy is seventh at 285.

Rosemount's Adam Hedin is ranked first in Class 3A at 132. The Irish's Reuben Cephas is ranked third at 106, but will have to negotiate a section bracket that could include fifth-ranked Nate Larson of Apple Valley and seventh-ranked Soden Ka of Eagan.

Kaden Gage (ranked sixth at 113) and Joe Dubbels (ninth at 152) also are state tournament contenders for Eagan.

The state individual competition is Friday, Feb. 27, and Saturday, Feb. 28, also at the Xcel Energy Center. In 2014, seven South Suburban Conference wrestlers, including four from Apple Valley, won Class 3A championship.

Eastview won four matches in the section final, all by fall. Gavin Greenlee, George Farmah, Alex Lindstrom and Colin Dolfe earned the pins.

In earlier rounds of the section tourney, Apple Valley defeated Burnsville 82-0 and Rosemount 63-9. Eastview defeated Henry Sibley 61-9 and Eagan 36-25 to reach the championship match.

Apple Valley (19-2), whose only two losses this season are to teams from outside Minnesota, is the No. 1 seed in the state Class 3A team tournament Feb. 26 at Xcel Energy Center. If the Eagles get by White Bear Lake (20-7) in the first round, they'll see a familiar opponent in the semifinals. South Suburban Conference teams Farmington and Prior Lake are matched in another quarterfinal, with the winner likely getting Apple Valley.

Wasmund expressed mild disappointment that the three South Suburban teams that qualified for state are in the same half of the bracket, but added that the seedings made sense. No. 2 seed St. Michael-Albertville has been ranked second in the state most of the season, and third-seeded Willmar is undefeated. Those teams are in the other half of the state bracket.

"It's just one of those things," Wasmund said. "I would have liked to see the South Suburban have a chance to get two teams in the championship match."

Apple Valley High School will be host of the Section 3 individual tournament beginning at 4 p.m. Friday. Action resumes at 11 a.m. Saturday and continues until there are two state qualifiers in each of 14 weight classes.

### Dodd on a tear

Eastview senior Luke Dodd is 32-3 and ranked second in Class 3A at 182 pounds. He's been on a particularly good run lately, Lightning coach Kurt Habeck said.

# Two Lightning wrestlers place 2nd at state

Seven qualifiers  
is a school record

Sending seven wrestlers to the state tournament is something Eastview can look back on with pride, but the Lightning doesn't want to wait a decade or more before it happens again.

"The expectation will be to have at least seven kids at state next year, and the year after that," coach Kurt Habeck said.

It was a season of firsts for Eastview. The Lightning reached a section team championship match for the first time and finished the season ranked 10th in the state. The seven state qualifiers is a school record. George Farmah became the school's first two-time section individual champion.

But the Lightning fell short of doing something for a second time—namely, having a state champion. Farmah and Luke Dodd wrestled in championship matches at the Class 3A individual finals Saturday at Xcel Energy Center, but both lost to St. Michael-Albertville wrestlers who repeated as state champions.

Farmah (32-5) reached the finals at 126 pounds for the second consecutive year. Last season he lost to Tommy Thorn of St. Michael-Albertville, who completed an undefeated season. Saturday, he drew STMA's Mitchell McKee, the state champion at 120 last season and a four-time USA Wrestling national champion.

McKee got Farmah in a headlock early in the first period and threw him on his back. Farmah was able to avoid being pinned, but was playing catch-up the rest of the way. McKee (44-2) eventually won 11-6.

Eastview senior Luke Dodd, who was ranked second in Class 3A at 182, met top-ranked Jordan Joseph of St. Michael-Albertville in the champion-

ship match. Joseph, a state champion at 170 two years ago, managed to avoid being taken down and won 11-5. Dodd, who earned his first state medal, finished 41-5.

Both are products of an Eastview program that encourages wrestlers to be in more than one sport. Farmah didn't join the wrestling program until he was a ninth-grader—and only then because he was cut from the basketball team. Dodd, a football lineman, "has been with us since he was little," Habeck said. "But he's come a long way since then.

"All seven of our state qualifiers are multi-sport athletes, which is something we're proud of and have tried to encourage."

Despite the credentials of the St. Michael-Albertville wrestlers, Habeck said he felt good about Farmah's and Dodd's chances. "We really felt we had an opportunity to win both of those matches," he said.

In earlier rounds, Farmah defeated Karl Keeler of Mounds View 12-0, pinned Riley Habisch of Buffalo in 3 minutes, 41 seconds and decided Tanner Cole of Owatonna 6-4.
