TEAM 2020: GRIT-DETERMINATION-TRIUMPH!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for successfully completing the season. Eastview Wrestling season's motto was: **Grit-Determination-Triumph**. Team 2020 committed to several off-season training programs including attending freestyle practices, participating in wrestling training sessions, super group, attending the Augsburg Technique Camp and Nebraska Team Camp. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the leadership by the seniors and the Grit-Determination-Triumph they displayed!

The Eastview wrestling team worked hard to establish a **Competitive Mindset**. Eastview wrestlers participated in 4 mental training workshops with Ashley from Mentally Strong Consulting. Topics in these workshops included Teamwork, Communication, Confidence, Self-Talk, Focus, and W.I.N. – What's Important Now! These workshops allowed the wrestlers to develop a Predator Mindset and establish a tunnel vision to attack their opponents. Below are a few highlights of the 2020 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 14 freshman and 6 middle school wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Earned 5 dual meet victories including a 3rd place finish in the Section 4 Dual Schedule.
- ◆ Earned 2nd place at the Eastview Duals & Qualified for the 9th Grade State Team Tourney
- ◆ Had 5 wrestlers place at individual regions and 3 wrestlers qualify for 9th Grade League State.
- ◆ Earned 83 match wins, 421 team points, 55 falls, and 115 takedowns.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 14 dual meet wins and placed near the top in the South Suburban Conference.
- ◆ Placed 2nd at the Eastview Duals and 13 wrestlers placed at the JV Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Several individuals were able to participate in varsity tournaments during the season.
- ◆ Earned 185 match wins, 984 team points, 141 falls, and 244 takedowns.
- ◆ Had 7+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.74.
- ◆ Earned 16 hard fought victories placing 1st at the Eastview Duals & 1st at the Trinity Invitational.
- ◆ Had 5 wrestlers earn All-Conference and 5 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed 12 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals with 6 placing in the top four & 8 earn Academic Recognition.
- ◆ Had 2 State Qualifiers with 1 All-State Wrestler earning 3rd place honors,
- ◆ Had 24 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 13 wrestlers earn at least 10 wins.
- ◆ Earned 331 match wins, 1705 team points, 186 falls, and 533 takedowns.

The **Class of 2020** includes 4 wrestlers who lead the team with a single-minded focus it takes to be successful in wrestling. The senior class will leave having earned 282 wins, 140 falls, and 1341 team points. To each of the seniors, we thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. We wish you the best of luck in your future endeavors and we hope that the Lightning Pride you developed over the past 4 years stays with you forever.

As we begin preparing for next season, the **Senior Class of 2021** must ask themselves - How good do I want our team to be? The leadership the seniors provide over the next 12 months will ultimately determine Team 2021's success! **Being the Best** is a common goal that championship teams work together toward! If teammates are not putting forth consistent effort, we need to pick them up and encourage them to carry on! If teammates are having poor attitudes, we'll be there to pump them up and give our support. **Section 2AAA** is consistently the top achieving section in the state. In order for Eastview to raise the bar and achieve more, each of us must commit to make the need changes. The **Coaching Staff** must provide opportunities and inspire those involved to make the improvements needed. **Wrestlers** need to motivate teammates to work harder, make greater sacrifices, and do all the little things needed to become a champion. **Parents** must continue their commitment and work with the wrestlers and coaching staff to raise expectations. Grit-Determination-Triumph

2019-2020 Eastview Wrestling



Wrestling is a unique sport. It is the oldest combat sport dating back to 3000BC and becoming an Olympic Sport in 708BC. It takes a certain type of individual to be a wrestler. One needs to be physically tough, have a willingness to make sacrifices, and be mentally tough. The amount of time in the practice

room perfecting technique, in the weight room getting strong, on the track working on endurance, and just as important—working on the mental aspects of our sport—our mindset.

We can memorize the words, anyone can do that. Here at Eastview Wrestling, we take those words and apply them to not only our sport, but to our lives.

Let's dig deeper into the 2019-2020 Eastview Wrestling Team Motto:

The definition of GRIT is the courage and resolve; strength of character; the ability to persist after setbacks. Many people have things they think are holding them back from greatness. Athletes who have ever suffered a serious injury and are working their way back to form fully understand this part of our motto. Fear of re-injury can hinder some, but not athletes with GRIT. They will work and follow treatment plans to get back to form. At Eastview, we have several wrestlers who are rehabbing injuries, and are working each day—GRIT!

DETERMINATION means having the desire to get the job done, and includes such characteristics as initiative, persistence and drive; having the perseverance in the face of obstacles. Hand in hand with *grit*, DETERMINATION goes farther in that our athletes will continue down a certain path until goals are reached.

TRIUMPH—simply, *triumph* means earning a great victory or achievement. *Triumph* is the destination following the

GRIT-DETERMINATION path our wrestlers are on this season. It's more than getting one's arm raised after a match, it is more than standing on the podium after a tournament. It is the culmination of early morning workouts, sprints, weights, drilling, and live go's in the wrestling room. It is about buying into persisting and preserving to reach team and individual goals.

One example of GRIT-DETERMINATION-TRIUMPH would be the story of Lee Kemp. Lee Kemp is one of the greatest wrestlers to ever lace up a pair of shoes.

Kemp was born in Cleveland, Ohio and was given up at birth. He spent time in multiple foster homes until he was adopted by a family and raised on a farm. Lee started to get into trouble, and this adoption and the move helped him a great deal. Lee started wrestling in ninth grade, and six years later he would win his first world championship! Kemp stated that he was just an average wrestler his first season and understood wrestling/athletics was a way he could better himself and stay out of trouble. He worked his craft so well, that he was an undefeated state champion his junior and senior years of high school. Lee would take his GRIT-DETERMINATION to the University of Wisconsin where he was a 4-time NCAA finalist, winning three of those finals. Lee Kemp would continue to wrestle internationally, becoming one of the greatest of all time. He learned at a young age that GRIT-DETERMINATION would lead to his TRIUMPH, both athletically and personally.

We all can learn a great deal about ourselves by following the 2019-2020 Eastview Wrestling Motto! Let's get it, men!

Wrestling preview: South Suburban loaded once again

The favorite in South Suburban Conference wrestling already was clear — and if you needed more evidence, look no further than Shakopee's 65-5 victory over Farmington last week.

The Sabers, who are defending state Class 3A champions, won 13 of 14 matches against eighth-ranked Farmington. Tigers standout Luke Peterson, a fourth-place finisher in the 2019 state tournament, didn't wrestle in the Dec. 5 match but even if he had it probably wouldn't have prevented a Shakopee run-away.

Shakopee had five wrestlers occupying No. 1 spots in last week's Class 3A individual rankings released by the guillotine.com. But the South Suburban can make an argument for being the

top wrestling conference in Class 3A with four teams ranked in the top nine, along with a number of returning individuals with state meet experience.

How they rate

In addition to No. 1 Shakopee, other ranked teams from the South Suburban include No. 7 Apple Valley, No. 8 Farmington and No. 9 Prior Lake.

Eight of the 10 South Suburban Conference schools, including Shakopee, Apple Valley and Prior Lake, are assigned to Class 3A. Section 2 for the postseason. The only Section 2 team not in the SSC is New Prague, which is ranked fifth in the state. By February, it's entirely possible that two of the 10 best teams in Class 3A won't make it to the Section 2 championship match.

South Suburban teams not in Section 2 are Farm-

ington, which wrestles in Section 1, and Eagan, which was runner-up to Hastings in last year's Section 3 team tourney.

Shakopee's emergence as a wrestling power — and its move to Class 3A, Section 2 — were key factors in ending Apple Valley's 35-year streak of sectional championships in 2017. This year's Apple Valley team is building but still formidable. The Eagles' top wrestler is senior Tony Anger, who is ranked second in Class 3A at 285 pounds but is light enough to wrestle at 220, which he did in a pinfall victory in Apple Valley's season opener at Burnsville on Dec. 5. Anger is one of just four seniors on the 2019-20 Apple Valley team.

Six of the 2019 Class 3A individual champions were underclassmen, including Lakeville South's Willie Bastyr, the reigning

state champ at 152. Bastyr, who went 41-3 last season, opened this season ranked third in Class 3A at 160.

Lakeville North sophomore Jore Volk was runner-up at 106 in the 2019 state tournament, then over the summer won freestyle and Greco-Roman U16 national championships in Fargo, N.D. Volk begins this season ranked first at 106. Volk's teammate, ninth-grader Zach Hanson, won freestyle, Greco and folk-style national titles in the U14 age group. Hanson is ranked fifth at 120 by the guillotine.com.

Returning medalists from the 2019 state meet include Eagan senior Ty Gage, a sixth-place finisher at 130, and Dylan Anderson of Apple Valley, fifth at 152.

Other local wrestlers appearing in the state individual rankings include Hunter Frost of Farmington

(seventh at 113), Christian Lopez of Burnsville (ninth at 132), Michael Murphy of Eagan (seventh at 138), Brice Bischof of Lakeville South (10th at 145), Austin Hamel of Farmington (eighth at 160), Gavin Osterhaus of Burnsville (sixth at 170), Luke Weierke of Farmington (seventh at 195) and Jaden Dukes of Lakeville South (10th at 195).

Early results

Farmington regrouped after its loss to Shakopee and won the Edina Invitational on Saturday, finishing 31 points in front of runner-up Lake City. The Tigers' Ryan Sullivan (106), Frost (113), Peterson (145), Hamel (160) and Weierke (195) won their weight classes.

Burnsville finished ninth in the 17-team Edina tourney. Xavier Ripplinger's second place at

138 was the Blaze's highest individual finish.

Scott West, the ninth-ranked team in Class 2A, won the Lakeville North Panther Invite on Saturday. Lakeville South and Lakeville North placed third and fourth. Bischof (152) and Dukes (170) were individual champions for South, and Volk (113) and Hanson (120) won their brackets for North.

The Class 3A opening round starts at 9 a.m. Friday at Xcel Energy Center. The state individual tourney runs through Saturday, with medal rounds beginning at 4 p.m.

No. 1-ranked Shak-

opee and No. 4 New Prague dominated the Section 2 individual tournament last Friday and Saturday at Apple Valley High School, with their wrestlers taking half of the available state qualifying spots. Lakeville North and Lakeville South each had three qualifiers, Eastview had two and Apple Valley one.

Lakeville South senior Jaden Dukes also won a Section 2 championship, defeating Shakopee senior Connor Raines 3-2 in the finals at 170. Dukes, 25-5, is ranked fifth in Class 3A.

Also advancing for Lakeville South was senior Ryan Cripe, who defeated Eastview's Mason Enderlein 9-4 in a match for true second at 138. Cripe, 38-9, lost to Nick Novak of New Prague 3-2 in the championship match.

Three Lakeville North wrestlers finished second in their weight classes. Panthers sophomore Jore Volk, ranked first in the state at 106, took his first loss of the season in the section final, where New Prague ninth-grader Koy Buetsgens earned a 10-3 decision. Volk (41-1) secured his spot in the state tournament with a 5-2 victory over Alan Koehler of

Prior Lake for true second.

Blake West of Shakopee got an escape to score the only point of the 113-pound final against Lakeville North ninth-grader Zach Hanson. Hanson (40-4) will return to the state tournament as a state runner-up.

Lakeville North's Gavin Roy defeated Lakeville South's Brice Bischof 4-3 in a true second match at 145, with Roy earning a place in the state tournament. Bischof reached the championship match before losing to Max Schefler of New Prague 10-5.

Eastview's Roman Gilbert takes a 36-9 record into the state tournament after finishing second at 132 in Section 2. Gilbert defeated Ryan Wagner of New Prague 8-2 in the semifinals before losing by technical fall to Shakopee's Ben Lunn in the finals. Wagner won the third-place match, which meant Gilbert was not required to wrestle again for true second.

Also qualifying for the Lightning was junior Kellen Stewart at 285. He pinned Evan Anderson of New Prague with 10 seconds left in their semifinal

match, then lost to Jade Trelstad of Shakopee by fall in the final. Stewart takes a 25-13 record to the state tournament.

Apple Valley senior Dylan Anderson returns to the state tournament after finishing second at 160 in the Section 2 finals.

Anderson, 36-5, won his first two matches by fall in the opening minute before losing to No. 1-ranked Carson Manville of Shakopee in the championship match. Anderson, who's ranked sixth at 160, placed fifth at 152 in the 2019 state tournament.

Class 3A, Section 1

Six Farmington wrestlers will advance to the state meet after finishing first or second in the Class 3A, Section 1 finals Saturday in Rochester.

Leading the Tigers' contingent is returning state medal winner Luke Peterson, a senior who's ranked second in the state at 145 pounds. Peterson defeated No. 5-ranked Cade Sheehan of Rochester Mayo 1-0 in the Section 1 finals.

Peterson is 37-2 this season after finishing fourth in the state at 145 last season. The top-ranked wres-

Luke Weierke is ranked sixth at 195 and takes a 29-4 record to state after defeating Faribault's Dylan Lippert 8-2 in the Section 1 final.

Farmington sophomore Hunter Frost grabbed a Section 1 championship at 113, defeating Beau Murphy of Northfield 13-4 in the finals. Frost takes a 36-11 record to the state tournament.

Parker Venz breezed through the 182-pound bracket, winning two matches by fall and one by technical fall. Venz, a junior, took a 16-1 lead over Owatonna's Ethan Stockwell before the championship match was ended. Venz, 25-4, is ranked fifth in Class 3A.

Eastview senior medals in first appearance

Farmington's Peterson second in Class 3A tourney

"Getting to the state tournament was an unexpected gift for Eastview senior Roman Gilbert. Competing for a medal and winning on his final day as a high school wrestler? Even better.

Gilbert, a Lightning senior captain, questioned whether he was good enough to wrestle in the state tournament almost until the time he got there. "I'd been third in the section every year. It just sucked," said Gilbert. "And I thought I was going to get third again this year."

But this season he powered through the section tourney and reached state, finishing third in a strong Class 3A 132-pound bracket. The last of his 40 victories was a 14-6 decision over Buffalo's Ryan Scherber in the third-place match Saturday at Xcel Energy Center. It was the second time Gilbert defeated Scherber in the state tourney.

"Not many kids win their final high school match. He wrestled great," Eastview coach Kurt Habeck said. "He's a great kid, motivated, a hard worker and pretty dang athletic. He's also a

kid that didn't have all the confidence in the world and has never been to things like this, so for him to come to a big arena and perform well is amazing for him and his family."

The 132-pound winner was Stillwater's Reid Ballantyne, a four-time state champion.

Second was Ben Lunn of Shakopee, who defeated Gilbert in the Section 2 championship match and state semifinals. Being on the awards podium with wrestlers of that caliber meant a lot, Gilbert said.

"I used to think I was not going to be good enough to place in the state, or even go to state," he said. "I think that changed when I saw my name on the Guillotine (state rankings). That really showed if I worked hard enough I could get up there."

Gilbert's highest regular-season ranking was eighth at 138 pounds. Getting through the section tournament was going to be tough enough, with that section drawing wrestlers from two of the top four teams in the state Class 3A rankings

(Shakopee and New Prague).

"In 10th grade, He kept improving, never gave up. It's a great story," Gilbert, who finished 40-10, said his state tournament goals included beating Wayzata ninth-grader Adam Cherne and Blaine sophomore Luke Studer if he faced them. Cherne defeated Gilbert in the regular season. Gilbert had been scheduled to face Studer once, but Studer forfeited.

At state he defeated Cherne 4-1 and Studer 7-2.

Wrestling at state took some getting used to, considering Gilbert had never done it before.

"It's just a big atmosphere, really loud," he said. "For me, it gives me a ton of nerves, gets in my head. So I have to try to block everything else out and focus on one thing, which is the match I have ahead of me."

Gilbert became the seventh Eastview wrestler to place third or higher in the state tournament. He said he wants to wrestle in college and is looking

at options. Habeck said Gilbert would be a good get for a college program.

"He's a senior captain who just does his work," the coach said. "Kids respect him for his demeanor and how he communicates with everybody. He has zero ego. He's kind of a mat rat. He enjoys good wrestling, and that's really helped him."

Eastview junior Kellen Stewart qualified for state at 285 pounds and lost two close decisions to finish 25-15. Stewart lost 3-1 in the

first round to Chase Smith of Bemidji, the eventual third-place finisher. He was edged 2-1 by Vincent Gladbach of Minneapolis Washburn in the first round of wrestlebacks.
