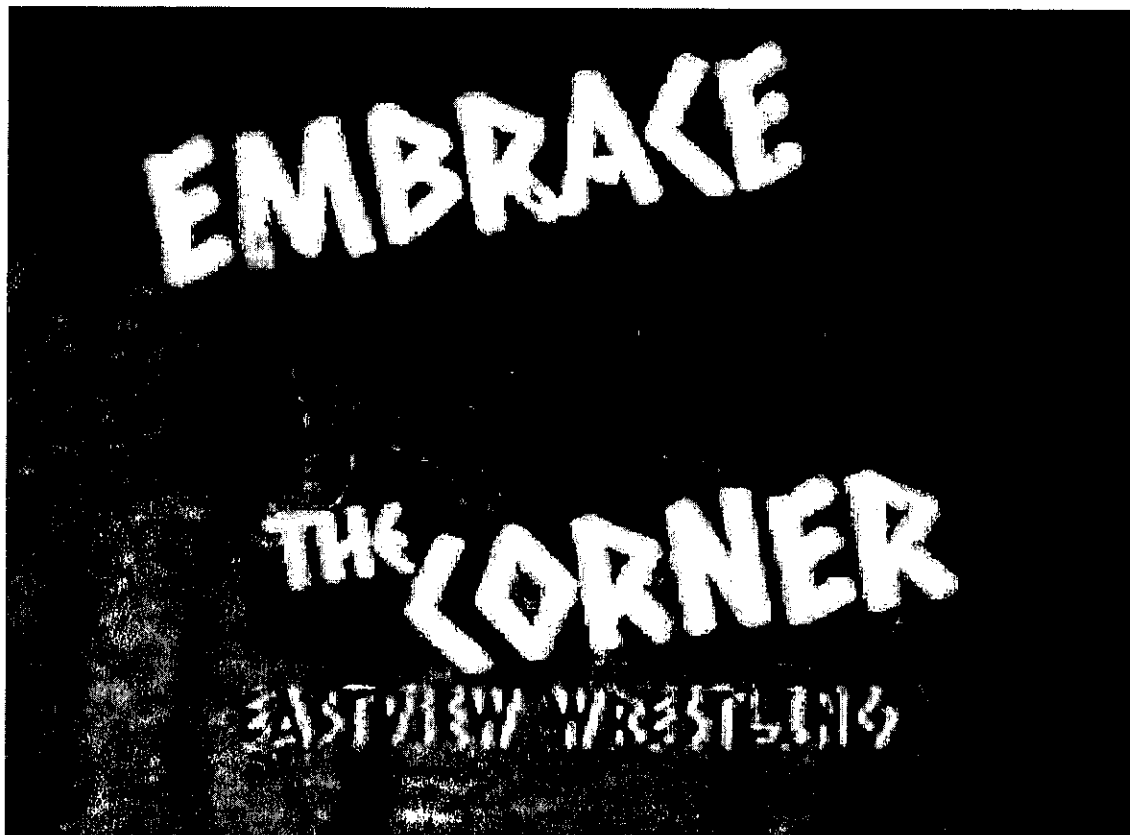

TEAM 2022: EMBRACE THE CORNER!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for successfully completing the season. Eastview Wrestling season's motto was: **Embrace the Corner**. Team 2022 experienced an unbelievable amount of adversity while successfully demonstrating a great amount of flexibility, agility and resilience throughout the season. Maximizing the limited amount of off-season training programs, Team 2022 participated in wrestling training sessions, super group, attending the Augsburg Technique /Team Camps and traveled to Colorado to train at the US Air Force Academy. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the leadership by the seniors and the ability to **Embrace the Corner!**

The Eastview wrestling team worked hard to establish a **Competitive Mindset** and participated in mental skill development throughout the season. Each wrestler was encouraged to Take Risks, don't be afraid to Fail, Learn, and Repeat until Successful! Physical and mental training allowed the wrestlers to develop a Predator Mindset and focus on W.I.N. (What's Important Now). Below are a few highlights of the 2022 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 13 freshman and 6 middle school wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Earned 2 dual meet victories including a 2nd place finish in the Section 4 Dual Schedule.
- ◆ Earned 2nd place at the Eastview Duals and Qualified for the 9th Grade State Team Tournament.
- ◆ Had 9 wrestlers place at individual regions, 4 wrestlers qualify for 9th Grade State with 2 place winners.
- ◆ Earned 120 match wins, 208 team points, 22 falls, and 65 takedowns.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 15 dual meet wins and placed 2nd in the South Suburban Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Placed 1st at the Eastview Duals and had 18 wrestlers place at the SSC Tournament.
- ◆ Several wrestlers were able to participate in varsity tournaments and competitions during the season.
- ◆ Had 10+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.
- ◆ Earned 224 match wins, 976 team points, 135 falls, and 239 takedowns.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.72.
- ◆ Earned 18 hard fought victories competing at the highest level including 6 conference wins.
- ◆ Had 4 wrestlers earn All-Conference and 6 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed 13 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals with 9 placing in the top four & 12 earn Academic Recognition.
- ◆ Had 4 boys and 2 girl State Qualifiers with 4 earning All-State honors at the State Championships.
- ◆ Had 27 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 12 wrestlers earn at least 10 wins.
- ◆ Earned 330 match wins, 1776 team points, 174 falls, and 443 takedowns.

The **Class of 2022** includes 7 wrestlers who lead the team with a single-minded focus it takes to be successful in wrestling. The senior class will leave having earned 174 wins, 105 falls, and 929 team points. To each of the seniors, we thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. We wish you the best of luck in your future endeavors and we hope that the Lightning Pride you developed over the past 4 years stays with you forever.

As we begin preparing for next season, the **Senior Class of 2023** must ask themselves - How good do I want our team to be? The leadership the seniors provide over the next 11 months will ultimately determine Team 2023's success! **Being the Best** is a common goal that championship teams work together toward! If teammates are not putting forth consistent effort, we need to pick them up and encourage them to carry on! If teammates are having poor attitudes, we'll be there to pump them up and give our support. **Section 2AAA** is consistently the top achieving section in the state. In order for Eastview to raise the bar and achieve more, each of us must commit to make the need changes. The **Coaching Staff** must provide opportunities and inspire those involved to make the improvements needed. **Wrestlers** need to motivate teammates to work harder, make greater sacrifices, and do all the little things needed to become a champion. **Parents** must continue their commitment and work with the wrestlers and coaching staff to raise expectations. 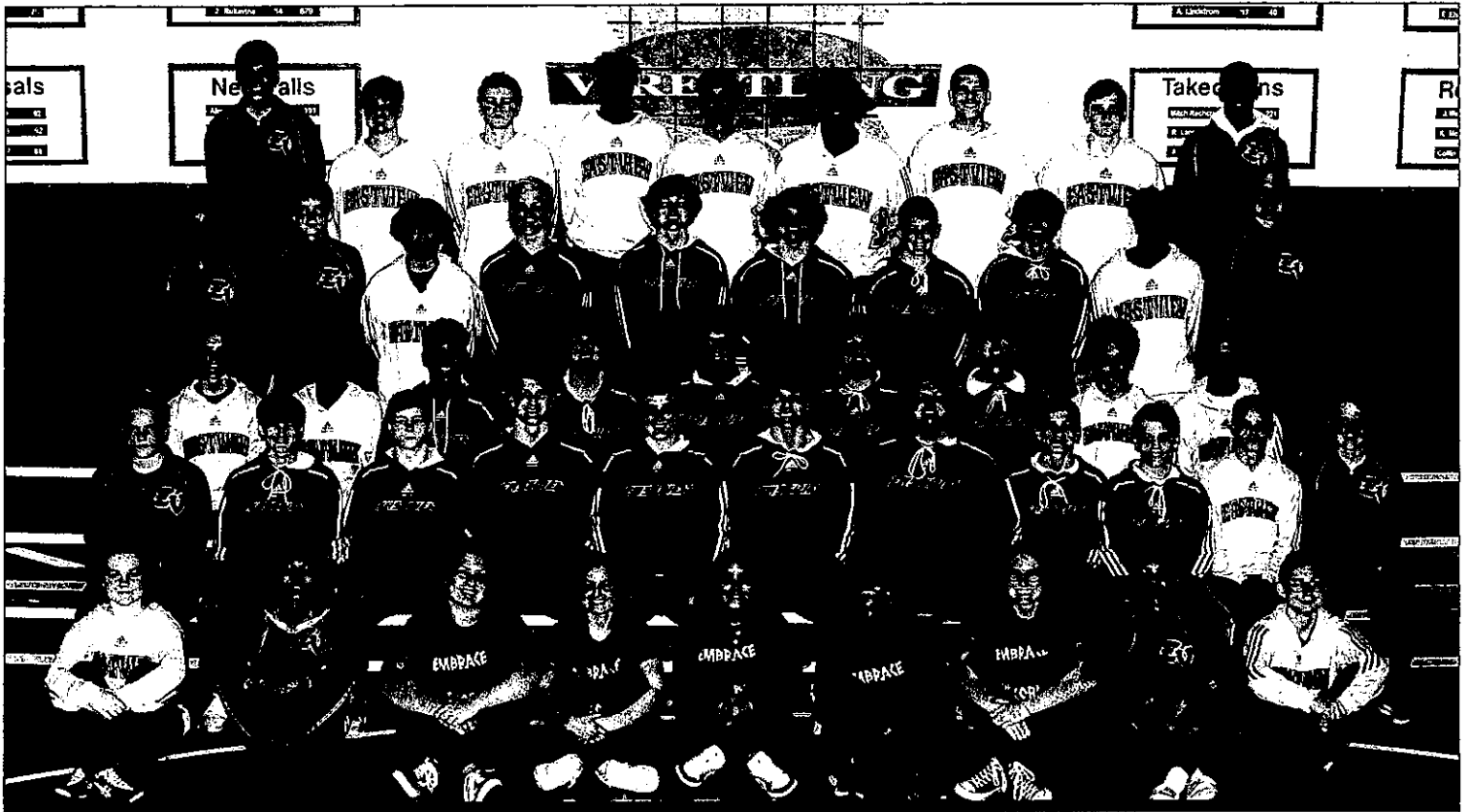

Embrace the Corner

2021-2022 Eastview Wrestling



What in the world does this season's motto mean to our program and wrestlers?

In short, it means to embrace the tough situations in life. If one is backed into a corner, we don't fold and quit. We take

on what whatever is holding us back and perform; to grow, to fight.

Many of us have been there; be it having a tough day at school or work, then going to practice and not feeling 100 percent mentally. What do we do? Do we mentally quit? No! Here at Eastview, we **Embrace the Corner** and change our entire day by having a great practice.

One of the United States' most exciting and celebrated wrestlers, David Taylor, is a fine example of **Embracing the Corner**.

David Taylor, a 2X National Champion from Penn State started his International Freestyle Career behind a couple of great athletes: Jordan Burroughs and Kyle Dake, whom he could not beat to make a World team. David decided to go up in weight where he lit the international scene on fire! In 2018 at the World Championships, he defeated a stacked field at 86kg

(189.5lbs) In that tournament he defeated Hassan Yazdani from Iran (Reigning World Champion and Olympic Gold medalist) 11-6. What a tournament for Taylor. He was named 2018 International Freestyle Wrestler of the Year.

Then things changed for Taylor. He suffered a knee injury. He was inactive for one full year. He came back, ready to compete for the US Olympic Trials, but due to the Covid pandemic that tournament was postponed. He could have quit. He could have let his mind take over and throw in the towel, but he fought hard with his training and took every opportunity he had to compete. In fact, he finally beat Jordan Burroughs in a Flow wrestling event in 2020.

At the 2020 Olympics, Taylor truly **Embraced the Corner**—all the setbacks due to injury and the pandemic, protocols and unknowns—he won Gold at 86kg, outscoring his opponents 35-5.

Wrestlers, many times in our lives we will face challenging moments—injury, school, home life, etc. How we react to said moments in our lives starts with embracing those times. Do we fold, or do we fight and move forward?

Here at Eastview, we are moving forward, making 2021-2022 the best season yet, by **Embracing the Corner**.

Realignment brings new dynamic to Section 2 wrestling tournament

Lightning-Eagles match will play heavily into postseason seeding

Wrestlers and coaches in Class 3A, Section 2 were understandably curious last spring when the Minnesota State High School League announced new section assignments — and now are preparing for a section tournament that will have a much different dynamic.

Shakopee had won the Section 2 team championship the last four years, often in dominating fashion. The Sabers were sent to Class 3A, Section 6 in the most recent section realignment, and now that section is top-heavy with No. 2-ranked Waconia and third-ranked Shakopee.

Apple Valley, Eastview, Burnsville, Rosemount, Lakeville North, Lakeville South and Prior Lake are holdovers from the previous Section 2 alignment, and the section added Farmington, which moved from Section 1.

An all-South Suburban Conference section makes conference matches such as Thursday's dual between Apple Valley and Eastview even more important because the results likely will play into section team and individual seedings. The Eagles-Lightning match is at Apple Valley High School at 7 p.m.

"We want our kids to wrestle the best competition they can, but our new section opens up more

opportunities for wrestlers to have success in the section and possibly reach the state tournament," Eastview coach Kurt Habeck said. "That's good for the sport."

Apple Valley currently is the only Section 2 team ranked in the Class 3A top 12 by theguillotine.com (the Eagles are ninth). Eastview, while unranked, has had one of its best starts in recent years, with a 9-1 overall record. The Lightning won their first three South Suburban Conference matches.

"We've had a very good start," Habeck said. "I think the competition level will increase as we go through the season. One thing that's helped our program is we have a group of young wrestlers who trained with us last summer and got some good experience. We have 50 wrestlers, which has helped us as we've made lineup changes."

Some lineup changes were necessary because of illness and injury, but Habeck said he also likes to give varsity matches to as many wrestlers as are ready for it. This year as many as 23 or 24 Lightning wrestlers have seen varsity competition in a given week.

Last week the Lightning defeated Eden Prairie 63-12 and Chaska/Chanhassen 63-15 in non-conference matches. In South Suburban Conference action, Eastview downed Eagan 67-11 and Lakeville North 52-26.

Eastview junior Ezra Formanek reached the state tournament preliminary rounds in 2021 and is 12-3 this season at 170 pounds. Formanek, a top baseball prospect in the class of 2023, is one of several Eastview athletes who believed it would benefit them to wrestle even though they might not pursue the sport beyond high school.

Nolan Enderlein is 16-2 at 113 pounds and earned his 50th career varsity victory last week. Other Lightning wrestlers who have reached double digits in victories include Cole Frost (11-3 at 160), Luke Habeck (10-2) and Ethan Dupont (14-3).

There are 12 seniors on the Eastview roster, but a rise in junior high participation during the 2021 season is expected to put the varsity program in good shape for the 2022-23 season and beyond.

As for 2021-22, the Apple Valley match will tell the Lightning a lot about their prospects for success in the section tournament. The Eagles' program is rebounding after having its 35-year streak of section team championships broken in 2018. Apple Valley has a strong lineup in the lower weights, led by junior Austin Laudenbach, who won a national 16U Greco-Roman championship last summer. Laudenbach is ranked fourth in Class 3A at 113 pounds.

Local place-winners included Dylan St. Germain of Eagan (seventh at 94 pounds), Tyler Reed of Apple Valley (sixth at 106), Noah Trotter of Apple Valley (fifth at 113), Carter Harris of Eastview (fourth at 120), Jameson Joubert of Burnsville (seventh at 152), Landon Odgaard of Eastview (fifth at 160) and Cole Will of Eagan (third at 285).

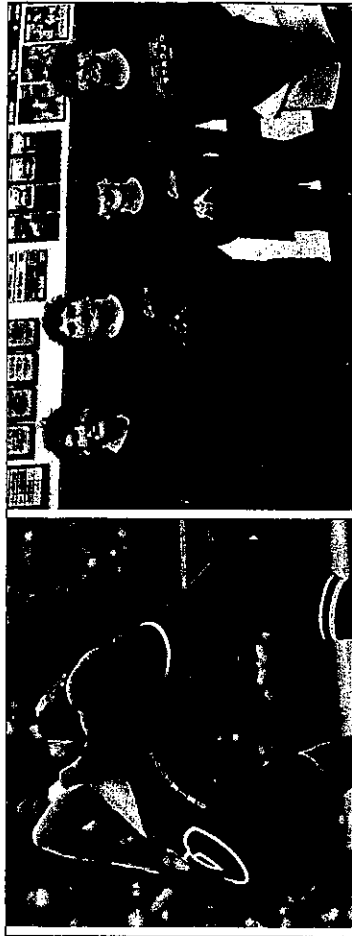

Large SSC contingent heading for state wrestling

28 individual qualifiers come through Section 2 boys tourney

In how many wrestling sections can all 28 state individual qualifiers come from the same conference? At least one, for sure. Wrestlers from eight South Suburban Conference schools put on a show at Eastview High School last weekend, battling for championships in the Class 3A, Section 2 boys individual tournament.

Champions and runners-up advance to the state individual tournament starting at 9 a.m. Friday at Xcel Energy Center. Medal rounds start at 4 p.m. Saturday with third- and fifth-place matches in all classes, with championship matches to follow.

The qualifiers from Section 2 include two reigning state champions (Jore Volk of Lakeville North and Alan Koehler of Prior Lake), two runners-up from the 2021 state tourney (Zach Hanson of Lakeville North and Cole Han-Lindemyer of Farmington), two sets of brothers (Austin and Tyler Laudenbach, and Jayden and Ian Haueter, all of Apple Valley), and Burnsville's first state qualifier in a decade (Xavier Ripplinger).

Apple Valley, Burnsville, Eastview, Farmington, Lakeville North, Lakeville South, Rosemount and Prior Lake competed in the Section 2 tourney. Two SSC teams were not in the section — league champion Shakopee sent nine to state through the Section 6 tournament, while Eagan competed in Section 3, where the Wildcats had one qualifier.

There will be a strong South Suburban Conference presence at the state tournament with Shakopee and Apple Valley sending teams to the Class 3A tournament. Thirty-eight wrestlers from the conference will be in the individual tournament.

The all-SSC Section 2 came into being last spring when the Minnesota State High School League realigned sections in all sports. The old Class 3A, Section 2 for wrestling had nine teams, eight from the South Suburban along with New Prague from the Metro West Conference. Shakopee and New Prague were moved to other sections while Farmington was brought in from Section 1, giving Section 2 eight teams from the same conference.

Even without Shakopee, Section 2 proved to be tough to get through, with wrestlers often battling familiar opponents for one of the top two spots in each weight class. "It was great competition. Eight teams, all very well coached, so you know kids are going to come in prepared. You just hope for the best," said Eastview coach Kurt Habeck, who had four runners-up in the section tourney.

Volk, who won the Class 3A championship at 106 pounds two years ago and the 120 title last year, powered through the Section 2 132-pound bracket, defeating Apple Valley's Jayden Haueter 17-6 in the final. Koehler, the 2021 Class 3A champion at 106, pinned Kong of Apple Valley in the second period in the championship match at 120. Hanson (145) and Han-Lindemyer (170) won their section finals by technical fall as both seek to return to the state finals and get gold medals. Hanson is a two-time state runner-up.

Apple Valley's Austin Laudenbach is looking for his first medal at the high school tournament but has succeeded on other big stages. He won a Greco-Roman national champion in the 16U 113-pound division in the USA Wrestling nationals last summer in Fargo, N.D. Hanson swept 16U freestyle and Greco-Roman championships at 132 pounds in the 2021 nationals.

Eastview's Ezra Formanek, the Section 2 runner-up at 170, said he and his three teammates going to state know they have to be ready. And they believe they are ready. "I think we're all wrestling kids who are seeded in the first round," he said at practice earlier this week. Habeck said anybody who got through the Section 2 tournament should have his eyes on medaling at the state meet.

"What's on paper, in the rankings and in the seedings, really doesn't mean anything," Habeck said. "It's about how you perform in those six minutes. If your goal is not to be a state place-winner, you need to readjust because that's what it should be. They've competed at a high level all year long, and there's no reason to think they can't be state place-winners."

It's their chance to step into the arena

First state high school girls wrestling tourney is Saturday

Riley Myers and Elsie Olson are too busy getting ready for a tournament this weekend to spend much time thinking about their roles in getting an emerging sport off the ground.

"What do you mean by 'trailblazer'?" Myers said when asked if she considered herself one.

The two Eastview High School students are among 46 wrestlers from across the state who will compete for championships in the inaugural Minnesota State High School League girls tournament Saturday at Xcel Energy Center. The girls matches will take place during the traditional final day of the boys individual tourney, with semifinals during the 9 a.m. session and championship matches at or after 6 p.m.

Myers and Olson have grown up around the sport, started at an early age, and were willing to deal with the obstacles associated with being girls in a male-centric sport. They want to treat state as just another tournament but are aware of the historical ramifications.

"It's going to be really cool later on when there are so many more girls wrestling and we're out of high school, knowing we were part of the first state tournament," Myers said. "We have seen the growth in other states, have

along. The wrestling room has been a part of her life ever since. Eventually, she got over the fact most of the rest of the people in the room were male.

"Starting at such a young age, you've wrestled up with boys the whole time, so at this point it's normal," Myers said.

Eastview has had other girls in the wrestling program, but last year Myers became the first one to make it to the end of the season. Habeck said it has helped Myers and Olson together in the room to serve as training partners and offer support. Hopefully, he said, more will follow.

Myers, who will wrestle at 138 at state, is 15-10 this season. Olson is 9-17. Most of their matches this season have been against boys. Myers could recall having only one match against a girl outside of girls-only tournaments.

Even if they're the only two girls in the wrestling room, Olson and Myers said the support system is valuable.

"I consider my team another family," Olson said. "I've gotten pretty used to being surrounded by guys. I have two older brothers at home, so it's not that much different.

"Healthy people develop healthy habits. I can definitely say I've improved because of my team."

Also qualifying for the state girls tourney are two wrestlers from Apple Valley - ninth-grader Hannah Schuster (12-0), who will wrestle at 107, and sophomore Grace Alagbo (13-1), who's at 145.

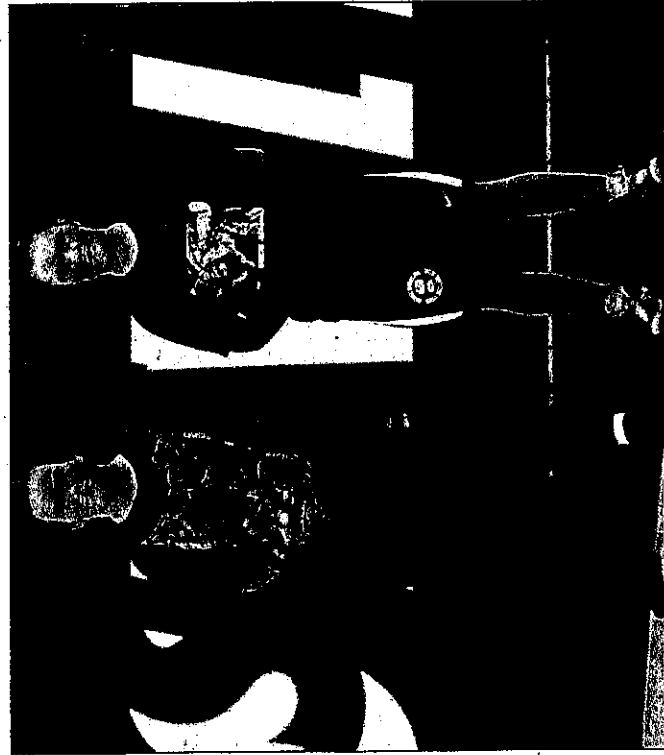

been allowed to compete once they added the tournament for girls," Eastview head coach Kurt Habeck said. "When you give those opportunities, it will increase participation levels."

More than 28,000 girls participated in high school wrestling in 2019-20, according to USA Wrestling, including almost 7,000 in California alone. Last year Minnesota joined more than 30 other states where the high school athletic association sponsors girls wrestling. About 70 colleges have women's wrestling programs, most in Division II, Division III and the NAIA.

Myers' father wrestled in California during his youth. Riley, an Eastview sophomore, recalled her brother going to a wrestling tryout. She was a third-grader and tagged

Minnesota remains a long way from girls wrestling being its own high school team sport. But it has to start somewhere, and once Myers and Olson have had a chance to reflect, they believe they'll be proud of getting in on the ground floor.

"It'll be an interesting story to tell my kids someday, that I was in the first-ever girls wrestling tournament," Olson said. "But

from here, and I'm excited to see what that looks like."

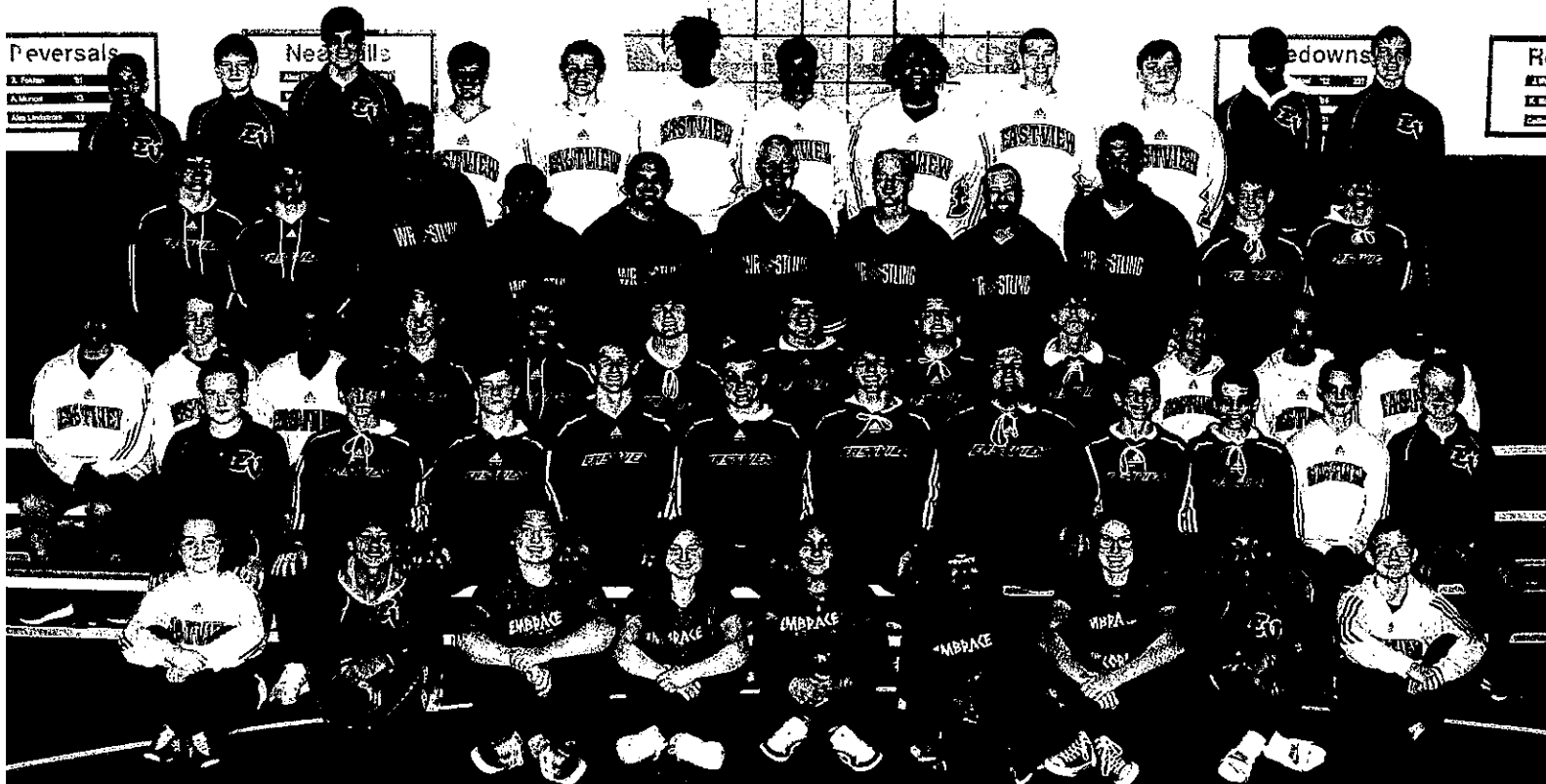

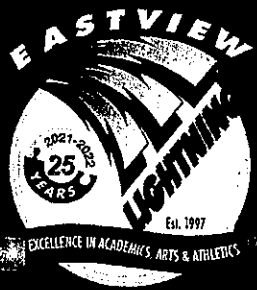
