### **Department Updates:**

- Linda Frye reported she is working with James Santistevan on Cyber Security Grants to help with Cyber Security that is required by insurance. She stated WAM sends out emails and suggested that each Council member get on their email list. Legislation is coming up. Some key items are the Governor submitted his request for the budget asking for additional funds of \$26.5 million for Direct Distribution and requested \$10 million be put back into the Mineral Royalty Grant. Other bills are being presented. One is trying to bring back governments paying property tax.
- Chief Krein gave a report on Police Department statistics for November. Two officers completed Radar Certification training. The PD has a radar down. A new radar was included in the new vehicle budget. Working on policy updates and force trainings. Juvenile Services Board is up and going. A part-time role is available through WyoHelp out of Goshen County.
- Desirae LeLeux reported they have been shorthanded in the office. One employee has been out but should be returning next week. Finishing up the Audit and preparing for tax season coming up.
- Todd Skrukrud reported they finished winterizing the golf course and put fungicide down. Fired up the hot line and won't top dress until after January when they get more sand. Working on finishing up lease agreement with PBS. They have been sanding and sweeping. Recycling has a load ready but can't get a load out. Electric Contractors have completed their work. They changed out 18 poles. Infrastructure Project is working in allies and will be wrapping up by end of week and then possibly laying off for the winter. Meeting this Friday. Transfer Station had a company here to clean but they have not finished. Still working with the insurance company on that. Not happy with the job the cleanup crew is doing. Insurance approved an electrical bid. They have been working on the electrical at the transfer station. Have temp power and the doors are operating.
