



WHAT'S THAT **SIREN**???



■ **WAIL**;



A “standard” siren, similar to what has been used in the past, **will be designated exclusively for use as a city fire warning.**

■ **AIR HORN**;

The ‘Air Horn’ siren, a growl or buzzed sounded in short bursts, **will be used as an ‘all clear’ after weather emergencies pass.**



■ **HI-LOW**;



A siren that incorporates high and low-pitched sounds, often described as an ‘English’ or European sounding siren, **will be used to designate county fires.**

■ **WHOOOP**;



This self-descriptive siren, very different from standard siren sounds, **will be used as a tornado warning.**

■ **ALERT**;



A “steady” blaring sound, the ‘Alert’ siren **will be used as a severe weather warning.**

■ **ATTACK**;



A steady ‘blare’ sound **will be used for terrorist attack or imminent bomb blast effect from a nuclear, conventional, or chemical weapon detonation.**
