

WHAT'S THAT SIREN???



WAIL;



A "standard" siren, similar to what has been used in the past, will be designated exclusively for use as a city fire warning.

•WHOOP;

This self-descriptive siren, very different from standard siren sounds, will be used as a tornado warning.

AIR HORN;

The 'Air Horn' siren, a growl or buzzed sounded in short bursts, will be used as an 'all clear' after weather emergencies pass.

ALERT;



A "steady" blaring sound, the 'Alert' siren will be used as a severe weather warning.

HI-LOW;



A siren that incorporates high and low-pitched sounds, often described as an 'English' or European sounding siren, will be used to designate county fires.

ATTACK;



A steady 'blare' sound will be used for terrorist attack or imminent bomb blast effect from a nuclear, conventional, or chemical weapon detonation.
