Cecelia is a native Delawarean (Sussex County), born in Millsboro, to the late William D. and Sarah Adkins-Burton. She attended Millsboro Elementary School #204 until the sixth grade. The family moved to Georgetown and she began her high school journey at the Williams C. Jason Comprehensive High School and will cherish the memories of this experience forever. She completed grades 7 through

11 at Jason and then transferred to Sussex Central High School for her senior year when the doors of Jason closed due to desegregation. She went on to earn an A.A. Degree from Delaware Technical and Community College in Georgetown, Delaware and later a Bachelor's Degree from Delaware State University.

Cecelia began working at Delaware State College in July 1970 and spent the next 43 years working in the Office of the Dean/Provost (under the leadership of several different Administrators). She held the positions of Stenographer, Secretary, Senior Secretary, Administrative Secretary and Financial Data Analyst. During her years at the University, she made many lifelong friends among both faculty and staff members.

She is the wife of Richard M. Dunning, mother of two sons, Troy and Kyle, and grandmother of Jadyn, (the sunshine of her life).

She is a member of the Kent County Chapter of the DSUAA as well as a Life Member of the National Alumni Association. She has served in the capacity of Recording Secretary for the Kent County Chapter and is presently the Amenities Committee Chairperson.



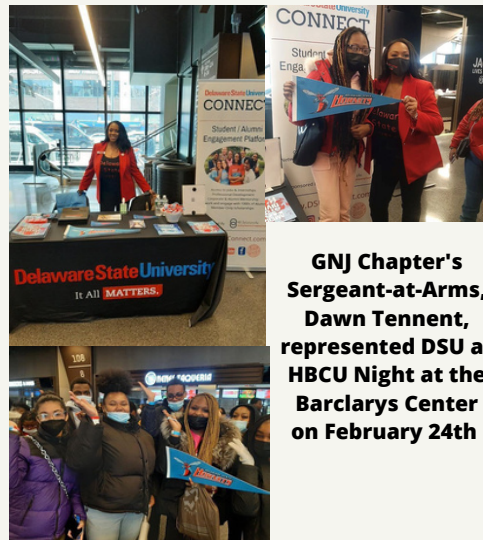

The fiscal year shall be July 1 to June 30. Membership dues are to be paid during each fiscal year. More information on the types of Memberships, Rights and Benefits of Membership, and the link to pay your Membership dues is listed below.



Types of Membership

CLASS A (REGULAR)

Any person who received a degree from Delaware State University or who was in attendance for one or more years shall be eligible for Class A membership in the Association

Class A Membership dues are \$50 per year.

Class A Membership Dues are active from July 1 to June 30th of the current fiscal year.

CLASS B (ASSOCIATE)

Husbands, wives, parents of alumni members and Delaware State University faculty and staff members shall be eligible for Class B membership in the Association

Class B Membership dues are \$25.00 per year.

Class B Membership Dues are active from July 1 to June 30th of the current fiscal year.

LIFE MEMBERS

Class A and Class B members shall be eligible to be Life Members in the Association upon payment of Life Membership dues.

Class A Life membership dues are \$1,000. Class B Life membership dues are \$500. Payments of any amount can be made to complete the life membership dues, as long as the dues amount is paid in full within the three year time period.

Life Membership dues do not expire.
