





Note from the Director

I am extremely proud of this production, especially with the set and creativity that was put into this show. Dramatically Incorrect is moving from stage to screen and each person who is taking on a new role both on and off the stage. The quality of the cast and crew is outstanding, and I thank each of you.

This hilarious show has more self production than what is seen on the screen; Noises Off by Michael Frayn does a great job showing how much an audience doesn't get to see. While our show did not have the personal drama like they do in Noises Off, they always were stepping up (sometimes falling) and helping out wherever they could. One example of this is our own Devin Provencher (portrayed the sultan in Twisted: The Untold Story of a Royal Vizier). This was the first set Devin Provencher designed for a Dramatically Incorrect production and I couldn't have asked for more; thank you Devin for the long days/ nights you and I spent building/ moving the set.

When the covid-19 pandemic hit, it was just before Dramatically Incorrect was to perform Twisted: An Untold Story of a Royal Vizier. Everyone was perplexed on how to perform in the future. Dramatically Incorrect is nothing if not persistent and driven to bring arts to the community. Dramatically Incorrect did virtual cabarets, original one-acts, and even rehearsals for future shows. Over time and with testing, a few DITGDC members were able to begin to see each other at the studio with masks, enhanced sanitization, and proper distancing.

The health risks associated with Covid-19 are no joke, and we do not take it lightly. Because of that, the cast has gone through self-quarantining, being tested, symptom monitoring, wearing masks until performance, using copious amounts of sanitizer, and most importantly being forthright with plans to travel out of quarantine.
