





#### Exhibitor Access Wednesday through Sunday:

PROOF OF ENTRY WILL BE REQUIRED FOR EXHIBITOR BUILDING ACCESS WEDNESDAY THROUGH SUNDAY OF THE EVENT. Exhibitor identification (wristbands) will be distributed to all exhibitors, which will be good for all days of the event FOR ACCESS TO THE BUILDING AND TO THE SHOW FLOOR WHERE THE RINGS ARE LOCATED (one entry does NOT allow admittance to multiple family members and/or friends). Exhibitor identification may be picked up at the Information Table located next to the Superintendent area in Main Hall on any day with proof of entry. Do not ask for multiple wristbands – only one will be distributed per person at the Information Table for security and health reasons. Please put your Exhibitor identification in a place where you can locate it easily to wear at all times when going in and out of the building – do not lose it Security guards and show officials will be checking for your Exhibitor identification – if you do not have it, you will be stopped and required to show proof of entry even if you have a dog with you. This will be strictly enforced and is in place for the safety of both you and your dogs.

ANY EXHIBITOR ARGUING WITH OR IGNORING LONE STAR STATE CLASSIC SHOW OFFICIALS OR SECURITY GUARDS, EXHIBITING UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOR, OR VIOLATING ANY SHOW OR AKC RULE WILL BE SUBJECT TO EVENT COMMITTEE JURISDICTION.

#### **Preferred Grooming Space:**

In order to provide better comfort and protection for you and your dogs, the Lone Star State Classic will offer preferred crating and grooming space. This will allow you to unload dogs at your leisure, when the building is fully temperature controlled. For exhibitors who do not show until Saturday, you can save on hotel bills, and still be assured of having a space.

Reservations close on Wednesday, January 24, 2024 or until limit is reached.

- SOFT-SIDED CRATES WILL BE ALLOWED in the building but are not allowed to be stacked.
- The show committee reserves the right to request the relocation. removal, or restriction of any chairs, crates, or other equipment
  anywhere in or around the building it deems necessary.
- RINGSIDE CRATING & SMALL TOY BREED TABLES will be allowed around their respective breed rings no earlier than 10 minutes
  prior to scheduled breed judging & MUST be removed immediately following completion of breed judging.
- NO GROOMING TABLES OF ANY SIZE WILL BE ALLOWED RINGSIDE. Foldable Toy Breed tables only, & only for time of breed
  judging.
- Crates and/or Toy Breed tables must not be left overnight in Main Hall around any of the rings. Each evening, the Show Committee
  will remove & discard all crates, and other equipment left around the rings.
- Do not remove the chairs provided by the LSSC from around or within the rings or in Club or Superintendent Areas. Any
  violation is subject to discipline.

#### Site Availability:

- 1. a. Exhibitors can drive in to unload from 6:30 P.M. to 8:30 P.M. on Wednesday, February 7, 2024. This is subject to change by the event committee so check the LSSC website for any updates. All vehicles must be removed by 9:00 P.M. Wednesday. Unloading after 9:00 P.M. will be done from the loading dock area.
  - Drag in unloading times are 6:30 P.M. to 11:00 P.M. on Wednesday, February 7, 2024.
- c. The LSSC reserves the right to deny any vehicle access to drive into the building due to size of vehicle and/or safety considerations.
- 2. All engines and generators must be turned off during unloading and loading.
- 3. The building will be locked at 11:00 P.M. on Wednesday. The building hours other days of the event are: Thursday 6:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M., Friday 6:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M., Saturday 6:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M., Sunday 6:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.
- Exhibitors are required to unload and remove their vehicles as quickly as possible. You can set up your equipment after your vehicle is removed.
- 5. All dogs and equipment must be removed immediately following BIS on Sunday, February 11, 2024. The building is fully temperature controlled except during hours of vehicle access. Please plan accordingly.

#### Access and Parking:

- All loading and unloading must be done through the <u>designated</u> Loading Doors in the North Hall and Freeway Hall. No crates, dollies, pens, or other equipment can be transported through other doors or entrances to the building.
- 2. Absolutely no cones allowed in parking areas
- 3. NEW! Two types of RV Parking will be offered at our February, 2024 Event Free NON-RESERVED RV PARKING in the normal RV Parking area and RESERVED RV PARKING in an area closer to the North Hall. Reservations are required for the RESERVED RV PARKING LOT. Please see the RV Parking Reservation form and maps of the RV parking lots in the Premium List. Deadline for reservations for the Reserved Lot is January 24, 2024. No reservation is necessary for the Non-Reserved RV Lot. Locations are on a first come, first park basis in both areas starting no earlier than Wednesday, February 7th, at 12 Noon.
- Absolutely no dumping of holding tanks on the grounds Any unit suspected of a gray water or sewage leakage will be asked to leave the parking lot.

The Main (Spectator) Entrance will be at the North West Entrance to the Main Hall (Main entrance). No dogs or equipment are allowed through the North West (Main) Entrance.

#### All Crating and Grooming Space:

- Crating and Grooming Space will be reserved, although space will be provided for exhibitors without reservations (non-reserved) and for day crating. ALL CRATES MUST BE MARKED WITH EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION.
- Soft-sided crates will be allowed in the building BUT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT WITH A DOG IN THEM UNSUPERVISED OR OVERNIGHT. Soft-sided crates are not allowed to be stacked.
- The Show Committee will mark all crating and grooming space. Only approved crating and grooming space may be used. ROPING OFF OF OR OTHERWISE RESERVING UNUSED CRATING AND GROOMING SPACE IS NOT ALLOWED.
- 4. The Show Committee reserves the right to remove exercise pens anywhere in or around the building.
- 5. There will be space provided somewhere in the building for private exercise pens for those in non-reserved grooming with a limit of two ex-pens per set-up. THIS LIMITED SPACE PROVIDED FOR THESE PENS ARE FOR NON-RESERVED GROOMING ONLY Reserved spaces should have enough room for the exhibitor's ex-pens and they should not use the non-reserved pen space. Any pens set up in the non-reserved area that belong to a holder of a reserved space will be moved by the Show Committee.
- 6. POSITIVELY NO EXERCISING WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE BUILDING EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS. Dogs are not allowed in the landscape area around Dallas Market Hall, in the lawn or shrubs around the complex, or on the landscape area (lawn or shrubs) around the Renaissance Dallas Hotel across the street. This will be monitored. Outdoor exercise pens will be provided. IN CASE OF ACCIDENTS, POOP BAGS ARE AVAILABLE AT MULTIPLE LOCATIONS BOTH INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE BUILDING. Exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs on all occasions. This will help retain the show site for future events. Any disregard of the above policy may result in an Event Committee Hearing.
- 7. NO PLASTIC ALLOWED ON FLOORS UNDER ANY EXERCISE PENS ANYWHERE IN THE BUILDING. Plastic is allowed on the sides of exercise pens. Please use sawdust (shavings) in pens & change daily. Sawdust (shavings) will be provided for a fee by the Lone Star State Classic if you have forgotten to bring your own, and is located at the Information Table in the Main Hall. NO ELECTRICAL CORDS allowed in the aisles. No sod allowed in the building.
- 8. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning his set-up each day. REMEMBER TO BRING A BROOM
- 9. Public exercise pens will be provided & must be attended by owner or handler while in use.
- 10. No tents are allowed in Non-Reserved grooming space. Pop-ups will be allowed in Reserved grooming space, but may not have sides, or tent walls (canopies only). This must be within the allotted reserved space with no encroachment on other spaces or aisles. Be a good neighbor.

#### Reserved Grooming Area:

- Sawdust (shavings) and/or paper are allowed in or under ex-pens in Reserved Grooming. No plastic is allowed under pens anywhere
  in the building.
- 2. Breathable mats are allowed in Reserved Grooming areas.
- 3. There will be space provided somewhere in the building for private exercise pens for those in non-reserved grooming. <u>Reserved spaces should have enough room for the exhibitor's ex-pens and they should not use the non-reserved pen space.</u> Any pens set up in the non-reserved area that belong to a holder of a reserved space will be removed by the Show Committee.

#### Non-Reserved Grooming Area:

- 1. Please stack crates (with the exception of soft-sided crates).
- The Show Committee reserves the right to require the stacking of crates, limiting the use of exercise pens, and any other remedies it may deem necessary for space in non-reserved spaces on a case by case basis at their discretion.
- 3. No rugs or mats allowed in non-reserved grooming areas. No plastic is allowed under pens anywhere in the building.
- 4. THERE WILL BE NO EXERCISE PENS ALLOWED IN NON-RESERVED GROOMING. There will be space provided somewhere in the building for private exercise pens for those in non-reserved grooming with a limit of 2 ex-pens per set-up. Ex-pens must be labeled and kept clean. SAWDUST AND/OR PAPER ONLY must be used in the ex-pens and must be changed daily. THIS LIMITED SPACE PROVIDED FOR THESE PENS ARE FOR NON-RESERVED GROOMING ONLY.

#### Day Crating Area:

Space will be provided for exhibitors who want to "Show and Go". Crates & grooming tables will be allowed. No exercise pens or drop pens in Day Crating. Everything must be removed immediately following Best in Show judging each day or the Show Committee will remove & discard same.

#### Security:

24-hour security will be provided inside and outside the building.

#### **Building Rules:**

- 1. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE BUILDING. SMOKING AND/OR USING TOBACCO PRODUCTS ARE PROHIBITED IN ANY SPACE IN DALLAS MARKET HALL.

#### **Extension Cord Requirements**

The City of Dallas enforces the 1996 national Electrical Code to ensure the public is not exposed to electrical hazards. This Code has specific requirements for the type of extension cord that may be used and how they are used.

If extension cords are used, Ground Fault Circuit Interrupt Protection (GFCI) is required. This cord is sold at most building or electrical supply stores. These cords are easily recognized as they have a test and a reset button on the cord. Most of these cords have the words "GFCI protected" printed on the cord.

All 120-volt extension cords shall be three wire grounding type cords (recognized by the three-prong plug on the end of the cord). Frayed or damaged cords may not be used. Extension cords may not be placed through doorways or across aisles.

These requirements will help eliminate harmful or fatal electrical hazards to you and/or your animals. City staff, including Fire Inspectors, will check the premises from time to time for your compliance. Your cooperation is appreciated.


