

Where to go paddle boarding



- Loweswater – A permit is needed and is £5 per day per paddleboard. Permits are available from Lanthwaite wood car park CA13 0RT or Buttermere CA13 9UZ Cash only.
Car parking can be found along the waters shore, but please park sensibly.
- Crummock Water - A permit is needed and is £5 per day per paddleboard. Permits are available from Lanthwaite wood car park CA13 0RT or Buttermere CA13 9UZ Cash only.
Car parking can be found at Lanthwaite wood or Hause point.
- Buttermere – A permit is needed and is £5 per day per paddleboard. Permits are available from Lanthwaite wood car park CA13 0RT or Buttermere CA13 9UZ Cash only.
Car parking can be found in the village or a small car park at Gatesgarth Farm.

Each craft permit lasts all day and can be used on all 3 lakes.

- Wastwater – No permit is needed, and car parking can be found at the lakes shore. Please do not park in passing places and respect others around you. Eg: Emergency services.
- Bassenthwaite Lake – A permit is needed and can be purchased online at <https://www.lakedistrict.gov.uk/visiting/things-to-do/water/bassenthwaite-permits/boat-permits>. Day permits are £7 per paddleboard.
Car parking can be found at Hursthole point and Peel wyke which are located on the A66
- Derwent Water – No permit is needed, and car parking can be found at Kettlewell carpark Borrowdale, Ashness gate and the theatre by the lake (this is about a 200m walk to launch into the water).

Permits are the responsibility of the hirer and not Explore the Lakes.
