

Equestrian Swap Meet Rules and Terms & Conditions

- 1. Event Information:
- Event Name: 1st Annual Equestrian Swap Meet
- Date: Sunday June 2, 2024
- Location: Indoor Arena, HighPointe Farm and Training Center, 4600 Stone River Dr., La Grange, KY 40031
- Hours: 9am 4pm. Set up from 7am 8.45am. Tear down no earlier than 3:30pm until 6pm

2. Registration and Fees:

- All vendors must register in advance to secure a booth at the swap meet.
- Booth fees must be paid in full at the time of registration.
- Registration deadline: Friday, May 10, 2024

3. Booth Assignments:

- Booth spaces will be assigned by the event organizer based on availability and the type of merchandise being sold.
- Booth assignments are final, non-refundable and non-transferable.

4. Setup and Teardown:

- Vendors must adhere to designated setup and teardown times provided by the event organizer.
- Vendors must set up and dismantle their booths within the specified timeframes to avoid disrupting the event.

5. Merchandise Restrictions:

- Vendors may only sell equestrian-related merchandise, including but not limited to tack, equipment, apparel, and accessories. No live sales are permitted.
- Prohibited items include counterfeit goods, weapons, illegal substances, and items deemed inappropriate or unsafe by the event organizer.

6. Booth Display Requirements:

- Booth displays must be clean, organized, and free of clutter.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables, chairs, and display materials.
- Booth displays must not obstruct aisles or neighboring booths.
- Booths do not have electricity provided.

7. Sales Transactions:

- Vendors are responsible for conducting sales transactions at their booths.
- Accepted forms of payment include cash, credit/debit cards, and other electronic payment methods. Vendors are responsible for ensuring that they are able to take electronic payments. No WiFi will be provided
- Vendors must provide receipts or invoices for all purchases. Please label anything non-refundable "sold as is"

8. Attendance and Behavior:

- All attendees and vendors must conduct themselves in a respectful and courteous manner.
- Harassment, discrimination, or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- The event organizer reserves the right to remove individuals who violate these rules or engage in misconduct.

9. Safety and Security:

- The safety and security of all participants are paramount.
- Vendors must comply with all safety regulations and guidelines provided by the event organizer.
- Security personnel will be present to ensure a safe and secure environment for everyone.

10. Cleanliness and Waste Management:

- Vendors are responsible for maintaining clean and tidy booth spaces throughout the event.
- Trash and recycling bins will be provided for vendors and attendees to dispose of waste responsibly.

11. Compliance with Local Regulations:

- Vendors must comply with all applicable local laws, regulations, and permits governing swap meets or outdoor events.
- The event organizer will obtain necessary permits or licenses as required by local authorities.

12. Agreement and Terms:

- By participating in the equestrian swap meet, vendors agree to abide by these rules and terms and conditions.
- The event organizer reserves the right to amend or modify these rules as necessary.
- Failure to comply with these rules may result in removal from the event without refund.
