## **COMMITMENT CONFIRMATION**

Recognizing that soccer is a demanding sport, and that playing competitive-level soccer requires commitment and dedication, we hereby choose to accept a spot on a North Port Fusion FC Competitive Team and understand that we are expected to make soccer our priority sport throughout the competitive season. The competitive season runs approximately as follows:

- **Senior Division (U15-U19):** June - October; January - April
- **Junior Division (U9-U14):** July - April

This means that other sports should be secondary to soccer training sessions, games and tournaments during this time. We understand our coaches dedicate a tremendous amount of time to creating a challenging and fun experience that will provide for the individual player's development and the team's success. By accepting an offer to play on a team, we promise to give our best effort to assist in achieving these goals.

## **PARTICIPATION RESPONSIBILITY**

Soccer, like any other sport, requires commitment and dedication to become a good player. Just being rostered on a team will not make me a better player. I can maximize my improvement as a soccer player and a teammate by being an active, focused participant. I can do this by:

- Being on-time to all practices, games, and other team events
- Communicating frequently with my coaches and being an active listener
- Focusing on working hard at all team events
- Playing hard to maximize my enjoyment of the game
- Providing the best support possible to my teammates to help them improve.

## FUSION FC PROVIDED BENEFITS

- A comprehensive soccer program designed to maximize each player's full potential
- FYSA registration fees
- Team entry into league play
- Registration fee and referee fees to 1 state level tournament per season per team. This benefit is contingent on each team participating in the Club-wide fundraiser used to fund the numerous scholarships the Club awards each season. This participation requirement is met when U9-U12 teams raise at least \$1000.00, and U13 -U19 teams at least \$1250.00 for the Club to fund scholarships and coach stipends.

## TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

Each North Port Fusion FC Competitive Team is required to participate in one Club-wide fundraiser, and is permitted to participate in as many team-specific fundraisers it obtains approval from the Fundraising Director to undertake.

- The funds raised by each team for the Club-wide fundraiser will be split 75% to the Club and 25% to the team
- All team fundraisers must be approved prior their start
- Team funds follow the team from year to year.
- Teams that do not have the **majority** of players returning – funds will be reallocated to the Club for scholarships and coaching stipends.
- Disbanded/non-returning teams - funds will be reallocated to the Club for scholarships and coaching stipends.

**Payment Two:** \$120.00 Due July 15<sup>th</sup>

**Payment Three:** \$120.00 Due August 15<sup>th</sup>

**Payment Four:** \$120.00 Due September 15<sup>th</sup>

**Payment Five:** \$120.00 Due October 15<sup>th</sup>

**Payment Six:** \$120.00 Due November 15<sup>th</sup>

#### **U13 – U19 (\$800.00)**

**Payment One/Commitment Payment:** \$125.00 Due at registration

**Payment Two:** \$135.00 Due July 15<sup>th</sup>

**Payment Three:** \$135.00 Due August 15<sup>th</sup>

**Payment Four:** \$135.00 Due September 15<sup>th</sup>

**Payment Five:** \$135.00 Due October 15<sup>th</sup>

**Payment Six:** \$135.00 Due on November 15<sup>th</sup>

\*A late fee of \$25.00 will apply to any payment received past the due date, which will be added on a additional invoice.

\*Club fees are to be paid in full by January 1, 2024.

\* Failure to fulfill the financial obligation will result in the suspension of eligibility to play with North Port Fusion FC until made current.

### **Refund/Account Credits:**

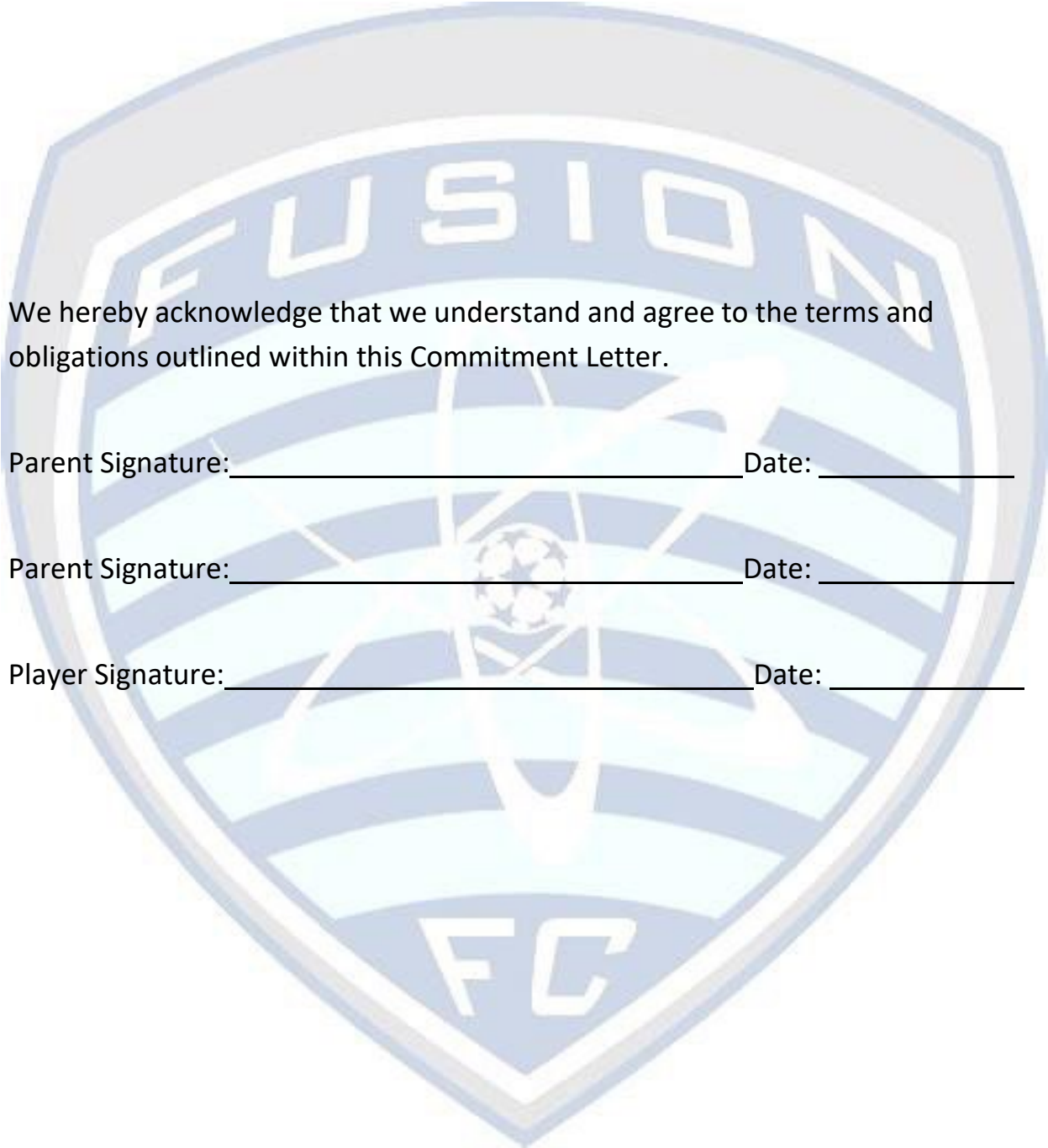
As policy, the Club does not issue refunds to players who choose not to, or are unable to, complete the season. For injuries, or other extenuating circumstances that prevent a player from completing the season, the Board of Directors, in its sole and absolute discretion, may authorize prorated credits toward the next season's registration fees. Requests to be released from the team or club after August 1, 2023 will be decided and voted upon by the NPYS Board of Directors.

### **EXPECTATIONS**

All players should be courteous and respectful at all times to teammates, coaches, referees, and opponents. We encourage our players to be supportive and helpful to their fellow teammates, coaches and all those involved in the sport we love. We follow all guidelines set forth by FYSA in matters of discipline. Each situation is viewed on a case by case basis.
