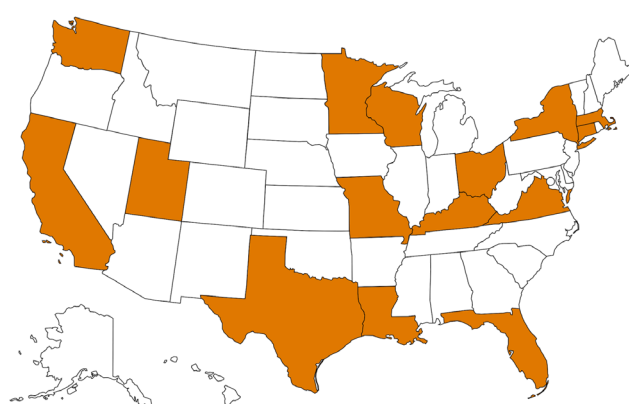
CoSEF in Chicago
