DONALD R. LE CLAIR LEADER OF THE YEAR AWARD – NOMINATION FORM

The Donald R. Le Clair Leader of the Year Award is given to a Knight who has done an exemplary job as a leader in his Council and the Order. The Award is named for Donald R. Le Clair (1939 – 1983), a long-time member of Rev. John F. Murphy Council 1943 and Nina Assembly 127, in Mystic. Brother Le Clair was the State Leadership Coordinator, and was known as a committed Knight who consistently lead his Council and could always be counted on. A worthy nominee is a Knight who is known for:

- (c) helping his council to attain awards (Star Council, Columbian, McGivney or Founders).
