

STRUCTURE

- Posted learning objective
- Classroom routines are in place
- Students know what to do when they are unsure or do not understand
- The lesson has a clear beginning and clear end
- Less teacher talk than student talk
- Teacher movement is occurring
- Student movement is occurring
- Evidence of student learning

CONTENT

- Content is taught through engaging and high quality strategies
- High quality questioning is occurring
- Students have opportunities to discuss their thinking with peers
- Past and new learning is accessible to students
- Real world connections are occurring
- Connections are being made within the subjects content
- Connections are being made cross curricular

DIFFERENTIATION

- Different strategies or methods to learn the topic are offered to everyone
- Students are able to show or share their thinking in different ways
- Students have access to work on their level of need
- Extensions are provided when appropriate
- Remediation is provided when appropriate

STUDENT SUCCESS

- Students are aware of their learning expectations or learning targets
- Students are aware of their learning and/or academic strengths
- Students are aware of their learning and/or academic needs of improvement
