



# A Year of Contributions



During 2023 Hope Coalition received a total of \$241,708.35 from generous community members. This number does not include all events or grants.

An influx of contributions were received in May, correlating with the opening of The Buzz. Through crowdfunding, peer to peer, and other soliciting efforts, we raised \$52,941.67 in May alone.

## What's Next?

Looking Ahead to 2024: Hope Coalition's Plans for the Future

Hope Coalition is gearing up for another fantastic year in 2024. We're excited to announce that we are expanding, launching new programs, and building on our past successes. Our team is dedicated to ensuring that we achieve our mission.

Plans to open a youth connection center is currently underway.

This center will house expanded programs, including Hope Rising (youth diversion) and alternatives to suspension initiatives. The goal is to provide wrap around support services for at risk youth in Henderson County.

Another exciting new initiative is Adult Recovery Court. Hope Coalition is part of the interdisciplinary team and chosen to oversee and provide support services for the court.

The team will provide the court system with valuable support to address the needs of non-violent offenders struggling with chemical dependence. Our dedicated efforts will enable coordinated approaches to help these individuals regain control of their lives.

# Love Always - Sarah A 'Hope'ful Story

In September 2022, 34 year old Sarah was referred to Hope Coalition's Recovery Community Center (RCC). At first, she arrived to the RCC hung out, ate snacks, and took classes. Soon she knew she needed to take the next steps in her recovery journey. She had been desperately trying to get accepted into a recovery program in Charlotte, NC to no avail. It wasn't until Beth, a Peer Support Specialist, stepped in.

"[Beth] knew one of the support team members at the program I wanted," said Sarah. "I was finally able to get the information I needed to secure my spot. Without Beth, I wouldn't have been successful, Their peer support team at Hope is amazing!" Sarah arrived in Charlotte in October of 2022 and graduated from the program March 10th, 2023. Today Sarah is living recovery and is enrolled in Community Health Worker online courses. Not only has she gained independence, she is able to see her children again unsupervised.

"This is only the beginning of my story," said Sarah. "I truly believe this could not have been possible without the help of Hope Coalition. From the bottom of my heart...I will forever be greateful."
