Our impact in 2022

- Drug takebacks collecting 624.31 pounds of unused medications, which is equivalent to 468,232.50 pills collected.
- 154 Naloxone opioid overdose kits distributed to law enforcement and community members
  - 13 Support and recovery meetings offered at no charge, for parents, families, youth, and those in recovery, as well as MARA (Medication-Assisted Recovery Anonymous) and the Hope Rising juvenile justice diversion program
  - 10 Public schools participated in #WeAreHope week, reaching over 10,000 students; the largest drug education and prevention event for youth in Henderson County
  - 17 Drug misuse education presentations held across the county and state, including NC conferences, service clubs, and local middle and high schools.
    - Youth Council initiatives, including:
      - Closet for Henderson County youth
      - 'YOUth are Not Alone' mental health videos
      - Latino Holiday Food Drive

### **#WeAreHope Week**





# Hope-full beginnings for The Buzz









Across America there is a sober movement changing the way alcohol is perceived. People are finding themselves questioning their relationship with alcohol. Concerns like 'Is it necessary for social lubrication, does it negatively alter conversations and skew clarity, and what is the impact of alcohol consumption on one's health' are all valid questions. Alcoholism affects one in eight adults.

The sober movement is changing the landscape of how one views their relationship with alcohol. Now is the time to break long-lasting cycles and rethink how we, as Americans, perceive social drinking.

At Hope Coalition, we recognize a need in our community to provide a safe nontriggering space to delve deeper into the sober-curious movement. We want to create a place where youth and adults alike can experience an alcohol-free environment for whatever reason. Whether you need a trigger-free space, a quiet place to work remotely, a spot for good conversation with friendly people, or just an escape from the stressors of everyday life, we want to be there for you. That is why we have created The Buzz, a specialty non-alcoholic bar and café.

The Buzz is Henderson County's first fully sober bar and café. It provides a sober space for individuals and families to frequent, allowing the community the option to socialize in a safe and health-centered atmosphere free from alcohol.

In addition, proceeds from The Buzz will directly support programs that provide prevention education from alcohol and substance misuse, as well as recovery support for those seeking services at Hope Coalition.

The normalization of sobriety and a healthier lifestyle are the core values of The Buzz. We encompass the value of health and wellness in our community and believe a sober environment encompasses that vision.
