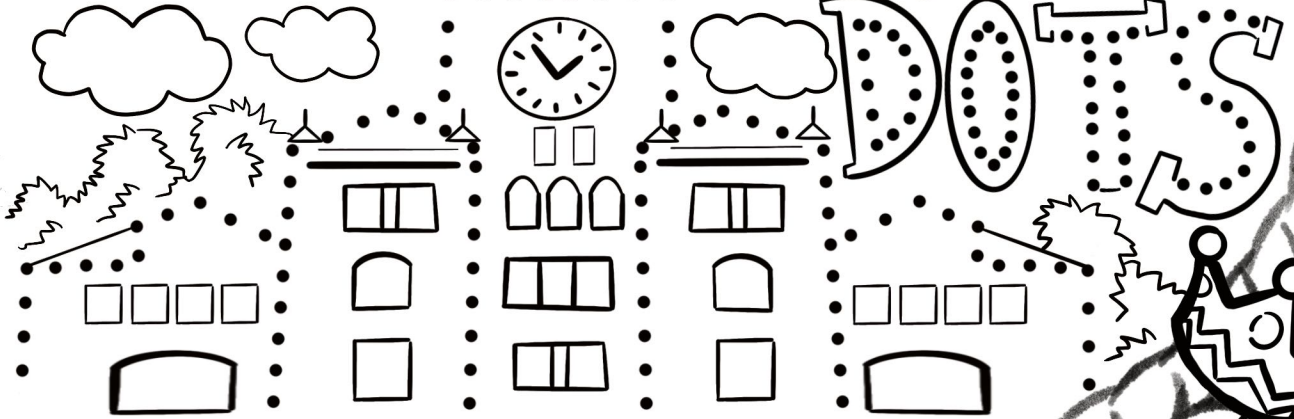

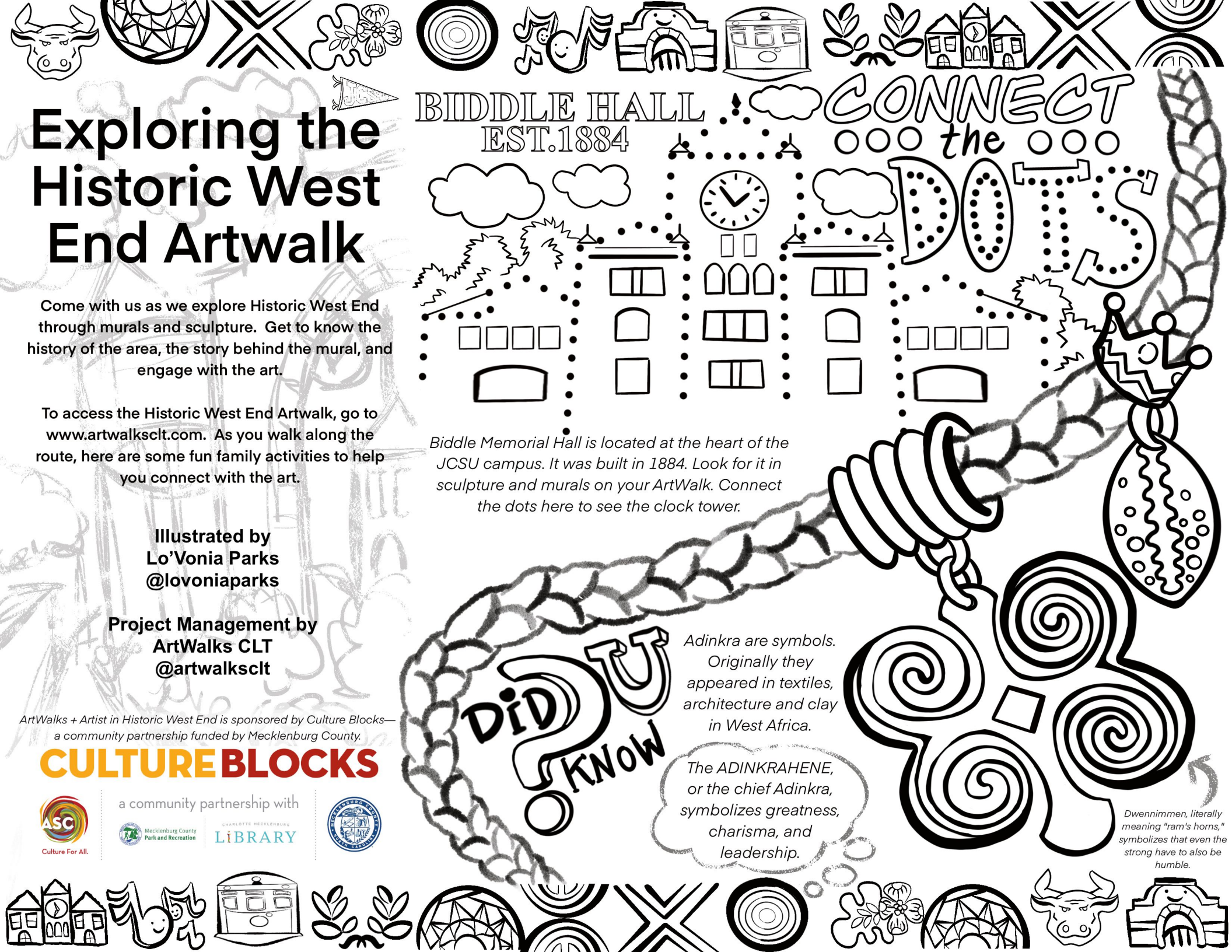

Adinkra are symbols. Originally they appeared in textiles, architecture and clay in West Africa.

The ADINKRAHENE, or the chief Adinkra, symbolizes greatness, charisma, and leadership.

Dwennimmen, literally meaning "ram's horns," symbolizes that even the strong have to also be humble.

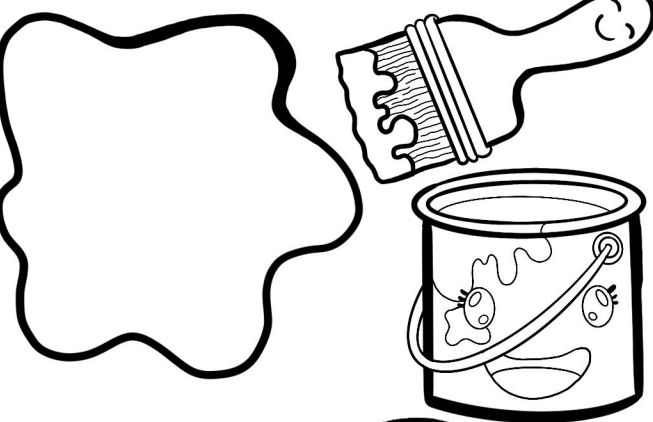
