
RESORT HOTEL BURNS

The hotel was a four-story frame structure. The loss is estimated at \$60,000. Dr. J. D. Kennedy of Detroit is the owner.

"This year we thought it would be fun to have Eliza and Matt Ahern bring their re-purposed fire engine that is outfitted to serve their famous frozen custard to the open house", he continued.

"The kids had the best time, not only eating custard, but getting a chance to sit in the driver's seat, wear a real fireman's helmet and sound the siren. Moms & dads also took them on a tour of the Museum".





Also on display was the fully restored Rescue Vehicle that was used by Harsens Island Firefighters in the early 1960's.

"It was a really great day and the kids had a fun time not only eating frozen custard and hot dogs, but going through the museum and learning," said Nancy Boulton, Founder and Curator of the Museum.

"Our Grand Opening was Memorial Day 2011, this is the start of our fourth year and we're excited about our growth and what the Museum has brought to the community," she said. "This year we have more school groups visiting the Museum and we are planning an Archaeological Dig that local schools are expressing an interest in," she concluded.
