From the President

Dear Members,

August marked the Fifth Annual Meeting of Harsens Island St. Clair Flats Historical Society. It is truly amazing how time flies when you are doing good things...and it is good things The Society has done in these past five short years. From getting organized to opening a museum to bringing new cultural and educational events to the Island and Flats. The Society has been a ‘net-positive’ and making a difference.

The 2014 Annual Meeting was marked by two noteworthy items: First, a ***Commemorative Wall*** has been installed in the Museum to recognize Major Donors whose significant contributions were instrumental in making the Museum a reality. The Annual Meeting was preceded by a *private reception at the Museum for Major Donors* to ***Celebrate the Reality***. With the assistance of these Major Donors in August 2013, The Society was able to secure the building on a ‘land contract’. As each month passes, The Society gets even closer to full ownership. (We are approximately \$40K shy of full ownership.)

Second, the Annual Meeting was moved to the Schoolhouse Grille. Election results for two new directors were announced by Denne Osgood...and the two new directors are: Susan Wrobel and Nancy Licata. Discussion of Tashmoo Days was a ‘main topic’. Attendees were pleased to be informed that Tashmoo Days 2014 was a financial success in spite of the weather conditions. The recommendation of the membership in attendance was overwhelmingly in favor and recommended the board proceed in planning Tashmoo Days 2015. Susan and Bob Bryson announced that Tashmoo Marina would be available to The Society for Tashmoo Days 2015. With these recommendations and approval, the new board will place this item at the top of the list for a consideration at their next meeting. At the conclusion of the meeting dinner was served and entertainment was provided by the Barbershop Quartet who performed at Tashmoo Days.

After the meeting and prior to dinner the required special meeting of the board was convened to elect officers for the upcoming year. The officers for the upcoming year are listed in The Pages ‘credits’.

On to ‘other news’ and upcoming events and activities:

A noteworthy donation to the Museum was the collection of photos and documentation on the Four Winns from its early days to its demise, Cletus Karamon was pleased to see this history exhibited in the Museum. (c. pg 2)


