


STATEMENT OF COOPERATION

This Statement of Cooperation is to acknowledge the relationship and mutual commitment of the North Bow Community Facility Board (NBCFB) and the Langdon Recreation Center (LRC) to collaborate in the development of operationally sustainable cultural and recreational amenities (the "Amenities") within the community of Langdon. NBCFB and LRC agree that the various studies conducted for the Langdon and North Bow Recreation area should be used as a guiding framework for the Amenities. These studies may include the Randall Conrad Recreation Facility Needs Assessment and Feasibility Study (2006), the aodbt Recreation Facility Feasibility Study (2014), and the Rocky View County Recreation Master Plan (2014).

The NBCFB and LRC recognize the importance of communication, transparency, and strategy support based on trust and respect. The NBCFB and the LRC will work in partnership with the Rocky View County and the Rocky View School Division to create a business case that will define, assess and evaluate the approach to proceed in the development of the Amenities. The NBCFB and the LRC will take a leading position in the community in respect of the agreement, development, planning, and fundraising initiatives of the Amenities for recommendation to the community residents, the Bow North Recreation Board, Rocky View County Administration and Council, and the Joint Use Langdon Facility Planning Committee.
