<u>Podium Pandemonium! Pande-podium?</u>

Are you tired of hearing about that ridiculous \$20k podium? Me too. But you really can't afford to not keep up to date on it, especially now that there is (admittedly, weak) bipartisan support for an audit to be conducted in order to trace those shadowy funds.

Now, despite the fact that the ARGOP has reimbursed the state for the exorbitant purchase (which raises its own questions about ethical spending as well), Republican Senator Jimmy Hickey is now calling for a legislative audit to be conducted, saying "where we're at with this particular thing is we need to allow legislative audit to go in." Republican Rep. Jimmy Gazaway, co-chair of the Legislative Joint Auditing Executive Committee, has expressed support for Sen. Hickey's request for an audit.

Now, pop on the tinfoil hats for the newest theory to come out of this dumpster fire of a governorship: were those funds spent to discreetly promote a potential run at Washington by Sanders as the running mate for Virginia Governor Glenn Youngkin. I know, I know: how does this make any sense?
