From Genesis to Exodus: The God of Order and Patterns

1. Adam in the Garden: Gen. 2:8 And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.

Eze. 28:13; 31:9,16,18

Gen. 2:10 And a River went out of Eden to water the Garden; and from thence it was parted, and became into Four Heads (Four Pillars, Four Living Creature, Four Major Prophets and Four Gospels).

Gen. 2:15 And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the Garden of Eden *to dress it and to keep it*. (The Table of Shew-Bread and the Seven Branch Candlestick-The Almond Tree).

The Voice of God from between the Cherubims above the Mercy Seat: Gen. 2:16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat:

17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

## 2. The Fallen Man/Adam:

Ge 3:21 Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

Gen. 3:24 So he drove out the man; and he placed at the *East of the Garden* of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the Tree of Life (Sacrifice: The Two Blood: Altars The Brazen and Golden Altar of Incense, then the Vail).

Isa. 51:3 For the LORD shall comfort Zion: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her *Wilderness like Eden*, and her desert like the

Garden of the LORD; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody (The Tabernacle in the Wilderness).

## 3. Enoch Pleased God by Faith:

Ge 5:21 And Enoch lived *sixty and five years*, and begat Methuselah. 22 And *Enoch walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years*, and begat sons and daughters.

- 23 And all the days of Enoch were three hundred sixty and five years:
- 24 And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him. Heb 11:5 By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. (The Vail was opened for Enoch to enter in.) 6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
- 4. Establish Faith: Heb 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. (All of Hebrews 11 were all the man and women of Faith were previewing the New Testament, just like the High Priest would once a year enter the Holy of Holies for just for a moment.)
