(A checklist is attached with the items you will need to bring with you.)
- You are welcome to pick your apartment from our available rooms. You are welcome to pop in and take measurements or to plan how you want it set up. ***We ask that for security reasons you do not bring any belongings ahead of your scheduled move-in date.***
- Lastly, please read the Moab House Resident Handbook. We will have you sign an acknowledgement form on your first day at Moab House. This is a great time to ask any questions you may have.

Document Checklist for Move-In Day

*****Please have these items ready with you on your move-in day*****

- State ID or Driver's License (Required)
- Social Security Card (Required)
- Birth Certificate (Required)
- School Attendance Records (last 30 days, if you are in school)
- Paystubs (last 30 days, if you have worked)
- Medical Card (if you currently have one)
- Bank Account Login Information and Other various login credentials (these are not shared with Moab House, but we highly recommend that you collect all of your usernames and passwords that have been created and/or used on your behalf.)

During your meeting we will make copies of your documentation and provide your originals back to you. We recommend you have a lockbox for your apartment that you can keep all of your sensitive documents, cards, cash, and if you have been prescribed psychotropic drugs.

If you are missing any of the above documentation, and please contact your Caseworker ASAP to retrieve them. We must have all documentation!
