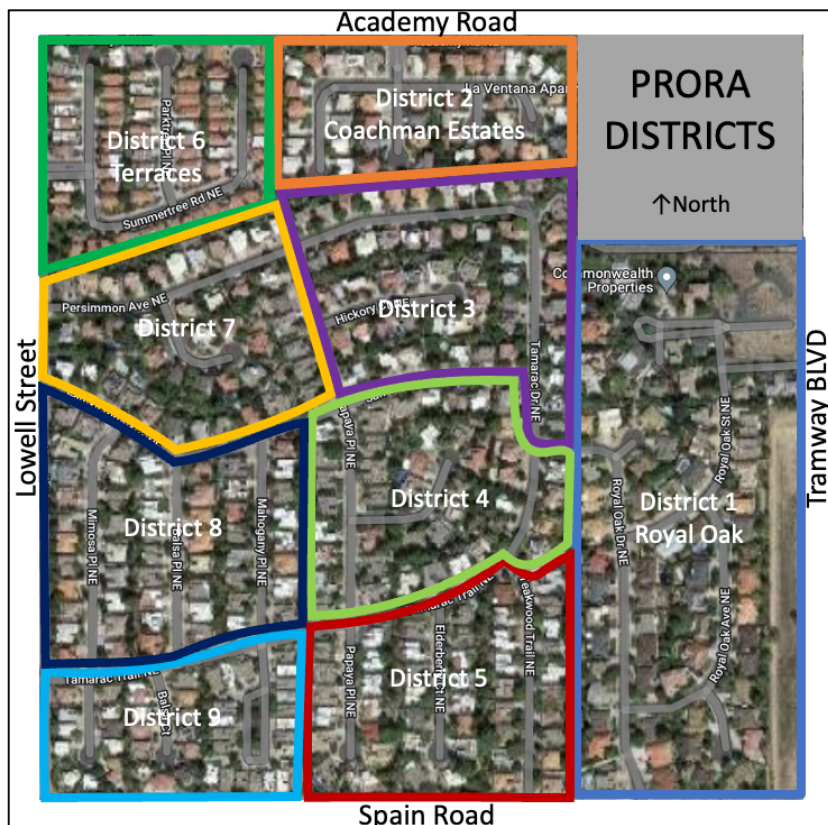
HAPPY NEW YEAR TO ALL RESIDENTS!
