Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at Faith Lutheran Church,

A couple of weeks ago, a member described life to me in a way I hadn't thought of before. He said it is a lot like a roll of toilet paper, the closer you get to the end, the faster it goes! While this might not be the most elegant description I have come across, it made me smile and I thought it might make you smile too.

There is truth to this observation. We all tend to describe life this way. That it seems to go faster and faster every year, even though the same number of minutes, days, weeks, and months are in it. Part of this, I have always thought, is because of perspective. When you are five, one year is 20% of your life. When you are 80, five years is only 6% of your life. By comparison it goes faster because it is a smaller amount of the time you have live.

With summer coming to an end, we become acutely aware of how quickly time has passed because of all the things we haven't done with our summer or because it just wasn't like the long, lazy summers of our childhood. I am acutely aware of this passage of time because, all of a sudden, I have a child starting catechism! Of all the milestones we have hit as a family, this one strikes me as the most impactful measure of time. When I began ministry, it was without children, and now, my oldest is 11 and is going to catechism camp with me. Where has time gone? I am finding it hard to believe he is this old already. But he is, and for the next 12 years, we will have at least one of our children in catechism classes. One can only imagine how much time will seem to have passed during this portion of our lives.

So why spend time pondering the passage of time? There are two answers to that question, and both reveal a truth about God to us. First, pondering the passage of time inevitably causes us to consider what has happened in the past, the time that has brought us to now. When we look back, we can see the joys and the challenges of life, and because we are Children of God, we can also see him at work in the ways he has blessed and preserved us along the way. This prepares us for the second reason we ponder the passage of time, it is to contemplate the future. As God's children, this contemplation is not met with fear or despair, but hope and promise. Because we can look back and see the mercy of God always present in our lives, we can also look forward and know that God will be consistent with who he is and what he has done for his people. As the Psalmist says, "his steadfast love endures forever."

In other words, it doesn't matter if your roll is at the beginning or rapidly spinning towards its end, the promise of God remains the same, His love endures forever. It precedes time and will outlast our lives as it extends into the life eternal. He is the same yesterday, today, and always. What a promise this is.

Take time, in these last days of summer, to give thanks for what God has done and rejoice in what he has promised to do. Time may be passing around you, but God is always with you.

Our softball team had an amazing season! They played hard, worked together, and had fun while winning almost all of their games. Way to go Fireballs!



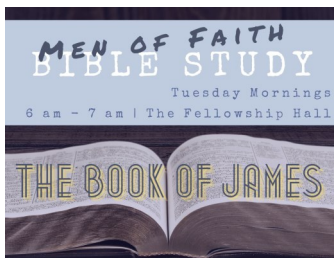

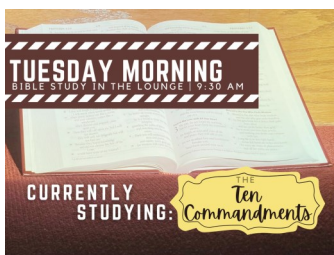
Men's Bible Study Tuesdays at 6:00 am in the Fellowship Hall

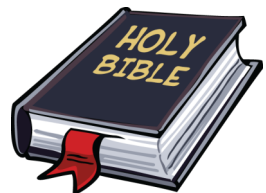

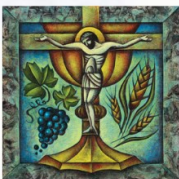

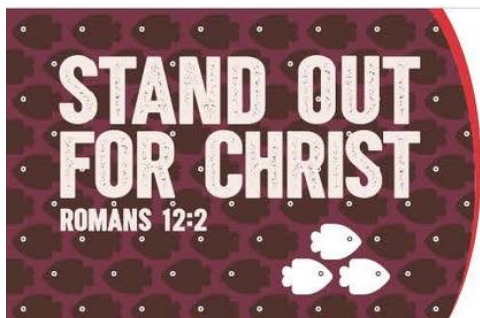
