

Steve Dudek studied classical music in his native Poland, and jazz composition at Berkley College of Music in Boston Massachusetts.

As a jazz musician, Steve has been performing and recording with such eclectic jazz artists and groups as the Lionel Hampton, B.B. King, Sylvain Sylvain from New York Dolls, Vistula River Brass Band, Ron Wood from Rolling Stones, Cuban jazz pianist- Donald Vega, Polish jazz-rock all stars group - Swiadectwo Dojrzalosci, Canadian River Street Band, Polish Diva - Violetta Villas, and playing in many prestigious jazz festivals throughout the world including Jazz Jamboree in Warsaw, Bern Jazz Festival in Switzerland, Helsinki Jazz Festival in Finland, Toronto Jazz Festival in Canada, and New Orleans Jazz & Heritage Festival.

In 2010, Steve was invited by Dr. Sydney Mufamadi - President of South Africa 2010 FIFA WORLD CUP to perform at the Opening Ceremony event in Johannesburg South Africa, along side with others artists like Alicia Keys, Shakira, Black Eyed Peas.

Steve Dudek has composed music for film and television in Poland, CBC-Canada,, and for PBS, NBC, and has received numerous awards at the Music City Song Festival in Nashville Tennessee, the world's largest songwriting competition. At the ninth annual MCSF Steve's song "His Love" was placed second in gospel category. Recently, in 2020 Steve's composition "Space Odyssey" was presented on Coast2Coast AM- #1 rated night time radio show in USA.

After moving to Los Angeles from Canada, Steve has been performing and recording with Steve Dudek Project, and as music producer is running his successful Sedona Productions, and writing classical compositions for piano and chamber orchestra. Recently, Steve has been composing music to the work of the two. world renowned poets, Lebanese - American Khalil Gibran (1883-1931) The PROPHET and the Persian mystic poet RUMI. (1207-1273)

Steve's favorite composers are Claude Debussy (1862-1918), Edvard Grieg (1843-1907) and Frederic Chopin (1810-1849)
