Using innovative microsuspension technology, MST, a practitioner is instantly able to lift aging skin in the mid-face area and gradually renew the body's natural collagen for a visibly more youthful appearance. The procedure takes approximately 45-60 minutes and requires minimal downtime for results that last up to 2 full years.

1. What is Silhouette InstaLift®?

Silhouette InstaLift® is a 45-minute dual-action cosmetic rejuvenation device that restores your younger appearance by:

- Immediately lifting sagging, aging skin in the mid-face area
- Gradually restoring volume and repositioning skin by stimulating new collagen production

2. What are the results of Silhouette InstaLift®?

Changes in the shape and appearance of the face happen gradually over time. These changes occur as skin strength and elasticity decrease with age, as well as due to the gradual loss of fat, bone, and cartilage. 8. How much downtime is needed following the procedure?

Following treatment with Silhouette InstaLift[®], patients may experience minor pain, swelling, and bruising. Recovery time is minimal, with most patients returning to normal activities within 2-4 days.

10. Is general anesthesia required?

No. A local anesthetic is all that is required.

14. What are the side effects associated with Silhouette InstaLift®?

After the procedure there may be some minor pain, swelling, and bruising. Silhouette InstaLift[®] is technique- sensitive, so you should speak with the practitioner to see if you are the type of person best suited to receive the treatment based on skin type, age, facial structure and medical history.

15. How much does Silhouette InstaLift cost?

The number of threads recommended for your lift will depend on the areas that you want to cover and the degree of lifting you require. The cost per thread is \$600, and typically patients require 2-3 threads per side.

16. Does insurance cover the procedure?

Silhouette InstaLift[®] is a cosmetic treatment so insurance does not cover the procedure. Clients may be interested in financial support through MediCard Canada. Medicard provides patient financing for elective medical procedures (1 888-689-9876

The Silhouette InstaLift[®] device is indicated for use in mid-face suspension surgery to temporarily fixate the cheek sub dermis in an elevated position.

Important Safety Consideration

Patients should not receive the Silhouette InstaLift® procedure if they have a known allergy or foreign body sensitivities to plastic biomaterial or if an infection is present.

Following treatment with Silhouette InstaLift[®], patients may experience minor pain, swelling and bruising. Other side effects may include sensory nerve injury, asymmetry, or banding. Individual results may vary.
