rheumatism and said Rose was
by reason of said disease unable to
do military duty. and remained so
until he was discharged. That
I have known said Rose since he
came out of the army. and know
that he has been troubled with the
rheumatism ever since. and in
my judgment said Rose is unable to do
physical labor.
