Applicant's Affidavit.

In the matter of the application of Archibald Rose for increase of pension under said Act of May 11th, 1912, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public, duly qualified to administer oaths, the said soldier, Archibald Rose, who being by me duly sworn according to law, declares in relation to the aforesaid claim, as Follows:-- I enlisted as a private in Co. C/ 3rd Regt. Minnesota Inf.Vols., at Saint Paul, Minnesota on the 1st day of September, A.D. 1864, to serve one year, -and was discharged at Jacksonport, Arkansas on the 28th day of July, 1865, by reason of close of War of Rebellion.

I was born near Chatham, Canada on the 1st day of January, 1836, and I have heretofore furnished the Pension department with the "family record" in this behalf. My discharge states my age at 29 years, at enlistment, when, as a matter of fact I was then 31 years of age.
I have had rheumatism ever since about February, 1865, -when I fell into icy water, and was confined to hospital for at least one month, and I have been afflicted with rheumatism, schlerosis, and heart trouble ever since, to a small degree until within the past 12 to 15 years, -since which time I have been totally disabled by reason of said afflictions.
Where I fell into water was near Duval's Bluffs, Arkansas, 1865.
My regimental Surgeon's name was Dr. Wedge.
