Applicant's Affidavit.

In the matter of the application of Archibald Rose for increase of pension under said Act of May 11th, 1912, personally appeared before me ,a Notarp Public, duly qualified to administer oaths, the said soldier, Archibald Rose, who being by me duly sworn according to law, declares in relation to the aforesiad claim, as Follows: -- I enlisted as a private in Co. c/ 3rd Rest. Minnessota Inf. Vols., at Saint Paul, Minnessota on the 1st day of September, A.D. 1864, to serve one year, -and was discharged at Jacksonsport, Arkansas on the 28th day of July, 1865, by reason of close of War of Rebellion.

I was born near Chatham, Canada on the 1st day of January, 1833, and I have heretofore furnished the Pension pepartment with the "pamily Record# in this behalf. My discharge states my age at 29 years, at enlistment, when, as a matter of fact I was then 31 years of age.

I have had rheumatism ever since about February, 1865, when I fell into icy water, and was confined to hospital for at least one month, and I have been afflicted with rheumatism, schlerosis, and heart trouble ever since, to a small degree until within the past 12 to 15 years, -since which time I have been totally disabled by reason of said afflictions.

Where I fell into water was near Duval's Bluffs, Arkansas, 1865.

My regimental Surgeon's name was pr.Wedge.
