On this 12 day of March A.D. 1909, personally appeared before me a Notary Public, within and for the County and State aforesaid, Archibald Rose, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 76 years of age, and a resident of the Village of Mazeppa, in the County of Mazeppa in the County of Wabasha, and State of Minnesota, and that he is the identical person who was Enrolled at St. Paul, Minnesota, under the name of Archibald Rose, on the 1st. day of September 1864, as a private in Co. C. 3rd. Regt, Minn. Inf. Vol. in the service of the United States, in the Civil War, and was Honorably Discharged at Jacksonport, Arkansas, on the 28th. day of July 1865, his height 5 feet and 7 inches, complexion fair, color of eyes blue, color of hair dark, that his occupation was a farmer, that he was born on the first day of January 1833, in Canada, of which I herewith attached a Photograph of the family bible were all the births were recorded, I was mistaken when I said in my former Application that I did not know of any family record, when I arrived home I informed my wife of the Application and she informed me that all the births were recorded in the family bible of which a copy is hereto attached, my memory is not what it use to be 30 or 40 years ago, and that I have not seen the bible since we moved to Mazeppa, which was in 1902,

That his place of residence since leaving the service has been in the Town of Hay Creek, Goodhue County, Minnesota, 36 years, and then moved to Mazeppa Wabasha County Minnesota, in the year 1902, and have lived there ever since up to the presence day,

That he was not employed in the Military or Naval service of the United States otherwise as stated above;

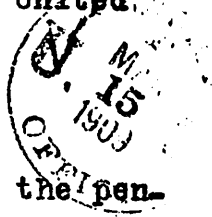
That he is a pensioner under certificate No. 283487

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of act of Feb. 6th. 1907.
