

**709 Village of Wayne**  
Regular Council Meeting  
OCTOBER 7<sup>TH</sup>, 2020

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Bechstein present, Zeigler present, Gross present, Morlock present, Lee present, and Wildman absent. Lee moved and Zeigler second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Lee moved and Bechstein second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Bryan Young (Professor Tinker) purchased the old bank building and presented his plan and phases to the Village Council. The old bank will become a toy store and slogan is "Toys for Boys, Gifts for Girls." Mr. young already has an online store (protinkertoys.com), been to over 2,000 hobby store in 10 years, been selling toys for 20 years, and loves his work. Mr. Young does live broadcast on You Tube, will be doing a soft opening on Halloween, and looking to be fulling open on Black Friday. Mayor and Council Thanked Mr. Young.

Fiscal Officer reported for Joe St Clair that Leaf machine should be here next week. All the trees are planted. Mayor discussed about the online tree auction this year for North Branch nursery. Zeigler moved and Lee second to approver up to \$1,000 for new trees. All yeah, M/C.

The walking trail is complete and looks great. Lee mentioned a possible ribbon cutting. Council mentioned getting with Wayne Welcoming Society for next year. Gross suggested about dog dispenser bags along the trail, possible dog park, and cleaning up the volleyball courts. Gross mentioned passing along to Park Board as well. Lee moved and Gross second to spend up to \$500 for 3 dog dispenser bag stations. All yeah, M/C.

Zeigler reported for Southeast Ambulance Board that Andrew Carter is the new Chief. No update on the Merritt/Tyson subdivision. Mayor reported received a letter back from property owner on Railroad St., sent letter over to solicitor to review, will be responding promptly, and still looking at litigation. Council agreed to set Trick-Or-Treat on Oct. 31, 2020 from 5 p.m. to 7p.m. and to follow CDC guidelines. Fiscal Officer will post on Facebook and have Village Admin. put on the board as well.

Bechstein moved and Gross second to waive third reading rule. All yeah, M/C. Lee moved and Bechstein second to Pass Resolution 10-20-708: Amending 2020 Appropriations for CARES ACT, repairing of catch basins on Rte 281, etc. All yeah, M/C. Bechstein moved and Zeigler second to waive third reading rule. All yeah, M/C. Lee moved and Morlock second to Pass Emergency Resolution 10-20-709: Amending General Fund transfer appropriations for ODNR grant. All yeah, M/C.

Gross moved and Lee second to approve the Financial report for September 30, 2020. All yeah, M/C. Council agreed to accept Round 3 CARES ACT for \$33,188.92. Fiscal Officer will get with a few plumbers to get quotes on touchless faucets, touchless water fountain (bottle stations), hand dryers/touchless paper towel machines, etc. Lee mentioned hanging the flags up town for the

election. Village will put up the flags the Friday prior to election and leave up for a week.

No further business, Bechstein moved and Zeigler second to adjourn. All yeah, M/C.
