Ryan from Choice One said they are currently reviewing the existing well structure to see if big enough for the compacity it will need and submit to the village council for review. Hoping to put the bid out for this project in October. Had second reading Resolution 9-23-735: To participate in the Wood County Park District Grant.

Vandersall moved and Gross second to approve the financial report for August 31, 2023. All yeah, M/C. Vandersall brought up to council about Richard Teeple, former Bradner, OH Mayor, has passed away. Council agreed to do a donation, or plant a tree, etc. up to \$100 in memory for him. Fiscal Officer will check the obituary and see what was listed to donate to and get everything taken care of.
