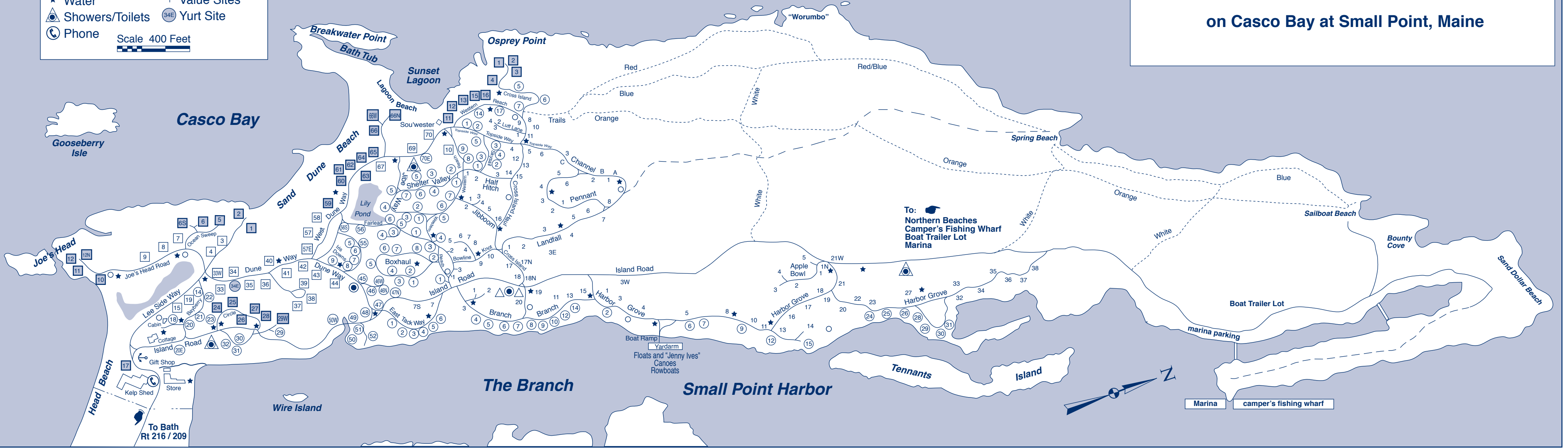

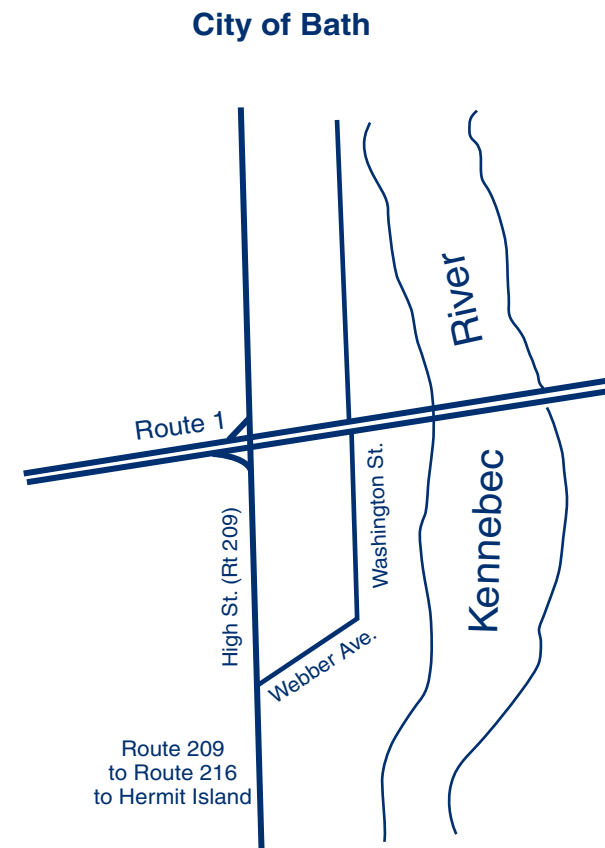
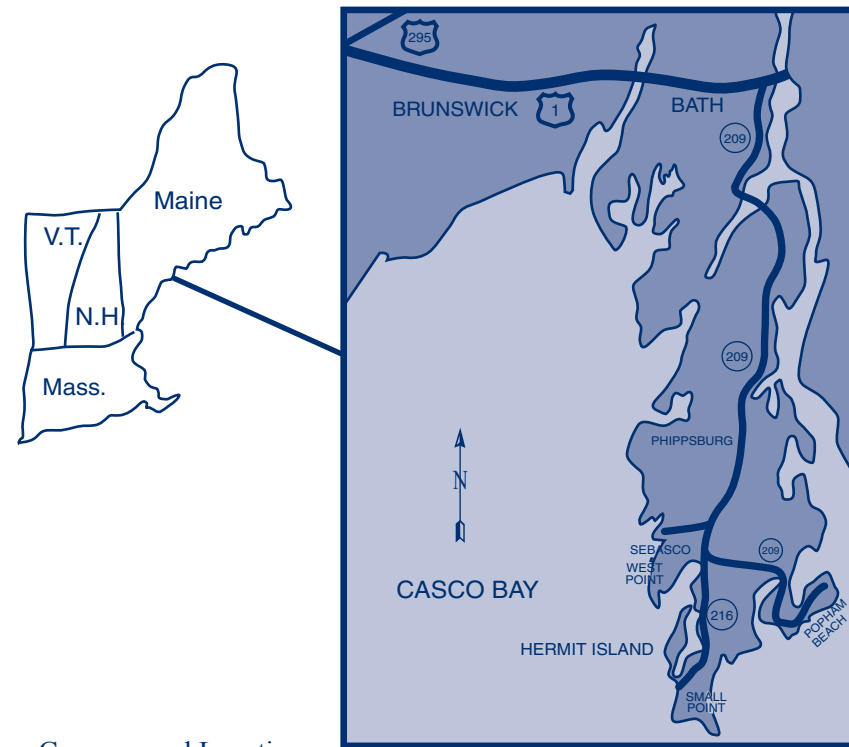

Directions:

Northbound – From 95 North (Maine Turnpike) take Exit 52 (Falmouth) to 295, then Exit 28 (Brunswick) to U.S. Route 1 North, until Bath, then take Routes 209 and 216 to Hermit Island.

Southbound – From 95 South (Maine Turnpike) get onto Rt. 295 at Exit 103 (Gardiner). Take Exit 31 (Topsham) to Route 1 North until Bath, then take Route 209 to Route 216 to Hermit Island.

Hermit Island is located in the town of Phippsburg (Small Point), Maine.

In Case of Emergency ...

For Fire or Emergency Services **DIAL 911** Telephone located to the right of the kelp shed entrance. Cellphone service is only sporadically available. 24 Hour Emergency services are available in Brunswick, 35 minutes from the campground. Mid Coast Hospital, 123 Medical Center Drive - Telephone 729-0181. From Bath, take Route 1 South to New Meadows Exit, turn left on to New Meadows Road, follow to intersection of State Rd (Old Route 1), turn right, 1.8 miles to Hospital entrance on left.

Checking In & Out

- **Check-in is from 2pm-9pm.** Please do not arrive before the 2pm as we do not have parking for early arrivals.
- **Check-out is at 10am.** Please vacate your site and the campground (including the beaches and the trails) and place your car pass in the box at the gatehouse as you leave.

Campers and Visitors

- Only registered campers are allowed on the Island.
- **No visitors.** Please inform your friends and relatives of our no visitor policy. If you are expecting visitors please plan an off-Island visit.
- **Pets may not camp with us.**
- You must be at least 21 years old to rent a site.
- Each campsite may have one vehicle and 1 or 2 adults with up to 3 children per site. A maximum of 3 additional children will be accepted for a fee of \$5 per child per night.

Cars and Parking

- Please display your car pass facing out on your rear view mirror at all times.
- In order to preserve the natural setting of the Island and each campsite, we have a **1 car per site** policy.

Waste

- Please place all rubbish in the green 55 gallon barrels located at road intersections and toilet/shower facilities. Please separate out your garbage and place redeemable cans and bottles in the blue barrels.
- There are no trash barrels on the beaches. Please pack out your trash.

Fire and Emergency Service

- Dial 911 Emergency service telephone located to the right of the kelp shed entrance.
- Cell phone service is only sporadically available.

Safety & Courtesy

- **THE CAMPGROUND SPEED LIMIT IS 10 MPH.**
- **All children 12 years old and younger must wear a bike helmet.**
- **No radios or generators Please!** In order to preserve the natural character and quiet of the Island, we ask that you limit the use of audio devices (radios, cd players, iPods, etc.) to headphones only.
- **Quiet Hours are between 10pm and 8am.**
- **Fireworks, Firearms and Drones are not allowed.**
- **Motorized pocket bikes, atvs and jet skis are not allowed.**
- Children under 18 must return to their campsite by 11pm. A minor may not stay at a campsite without an adult.
- Camp fires must be attended at all times and fully extinguished before leaving your site.
- We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please lock up your valuables when you are away from your campsite.
- Please respect the privacy of others by not walking through their campsite.

Services & Facilities

- The Kelp Shed operates as a service center for all activities on Hermit Island. It is open daily from 9am to 10pm. Arrangements for camping, rowboat and canoe rentals, or boat space can be made here. Rental boats and canoes are located at the Yardarm Floats on Harbor Grove. We do not allow small outboard motors on rental rowboats.
- The Snack Bar is located in the Kelp Shed.
- The Store sells ice, firewood, lobsters, beer, wine, and groceries from 8am to 9pm daily. We no longer accept personal checks at the store, nor do we accept personal checks for off-season campsite payments.
- The Gift Shop carries post cards, t-shirts, and other items to remind you of your visit.
- An ATM is located in the Store. We accept Visa and Mastercard for payment at the Store and Gift Shop.
