#### Advent Zone

#### Advent Ring-week 2

The Second Sunday of Advent

**Voice 1:** Last Sunday, we lit the first candle in our Advent wreath, the candle of hope. Let us light it again, as a symbol of our desire for healing and wholeness for our world. Our hope is in God's way of Shalom. *(First candle is lit.)* 

**Voice 2:** John the Baptist called on the people of his day to get ready for the coming of the Messiah. They were to repent—turn around—change their focus. The peace—the Shalom we seek, grows out of a will-ingness to repent and change direction.

**Voice 1:** We light this second candle to remind us that Jesus is the Prince of Peace. His life has shown us ways to share God's peace with others. *(The second candle is lit.)* 

**Voice 2:** Let us join together in a prayer for peace for ourselves and our world using the words of the International Peace Prayer.

**Congregation:** 

Lead me from death to life, from falsehood to truth.

Lead me from despair to hope, from fear to trust.

Lead me from hate to love, from war to peace.

Let peace fill our hearts, our world, our universe. Amen










## **Activity Zone**

#### **Dove Tree Trim**



- 1. Cut out template
- 2.Fold a piece of fabric in half
- 3. Lay template on felt or fabric
- 4. Pin and cut out doves (2)
- 5. Sew the 2 doves together
- 6. Leave an opening for filling
- 7.fill with stuffing and sew up
- 8. decorate with sequins or buttons
- 9. Add thread or ribbon to hang







## Craft Zone

#### Advent Ring crown



1.Cut a strip of card to fit around your head

2. Cut 4 small strips for candles and add to the large strip, equally distanced

3. Use word stickers or write Love, Joy, Peace, hope on each strip

4. Add a flame and decorate

5. measure the band to fit around the head, glue the edge and join the card together.


